DELNOR POSS: NO TIME OUT

Tumbleweed Smith



Delnor Poss had a 40 year career teaching and coaching sports at Midland College. He grew up playing sports at schools in California, Oklahoma and Texas. Later he coached at high schools. At Midland College he worked his way up to Athletic Director. His teams won 12 National Championships in 5 different sports. His golf teams earned 4 national titles, a world

Tumbleweed Smith championship and later some of his athletes played in The Masters, PGA Championship, Ryder Cup and British open. Delnor is in 6 Halls of Fame. He has written a book about his life before, during and after coaching titled NO TIME OUT! MY NON-STOP LIFE. Presently he works as a sports consultant in New Mexico.

I've known Delnor and his wife Martha for more than 50 years. My son took piano lessons from Martha. Delnor calls her his best friend and adviser and says he couldn't have done anything without her. Martha is a beautiful woman than men admire. Delnor thinks some of the jobs he got were because he took Martha to the interviews. His book praises Martha through all their adventures together.

The book is full of anecdotes and fun stories, some of which show Delnor to do some crazy things. Once when he was changing jobs and driving back and forth between towns before moving in at the new location, Delnor and Martha went to a grocery store and bought lots of meat and produce and put it in the refrigerator where they would be moving. Before he left he turned off the electricity, so all the groceries spoiled. "The odor was terrible. We couldn't stand it," says Delnor.

When he was settling in to his new coaching job at Menard, a town known for its practical jokes, a man in a white pickup drove up as Delnor was unloading his car at the new residence. "He introduced himself and said he lived in a house above us up the hill," says Delnor. "While he was talking to me he kept trying to catch a glimpse of Martha. He told me to watch out for the guy next door, that the guy was a sex deviate and couldn't be trusted. Martha should keep the doors locked all the time." The visitor told Delnor that he was a member of the school board and if he needed anything to let him know. He said goodbye and left in his white pickup. This was about 2 PM.
