SIMPLE PEANUT SAUCE

- 1/2 teaspoons soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon rice vinegar or white vinegar

Optional to add heat: cayenne pepper, chili garlic sauce, hot pepper sauce or siracha to taste

Other optional ingredients:

- 1—2 teaspoons minced garlic and/or ginger

Here's How:

Mix all ingredients in a small bowl. Stir until smooth. There may come a moment when you wail, "Curse you, Patti Diamond!" because it looks like a curdled mess. Keep stirring — I promise it'll get lusciously creamy. Add heat to taste, if desired. Rest for at least 30 minutes to let the flavors marry. Use as a dipping sauce for chicken satay, veggies or noodles, chips or spoons, or just use your fingers.

QUICK CHICKEN SATAY

Yield: approximately 24 skewers

What You'll Need:

- Bamboo or metal skewers
- 2 1/2 — 3 pounds boneless skinless chicken thighs

- 1/2 cup teriyaki sauce
- 2 teaspoons olive or vegetable oil

Optional garnish: green onion and/or cilantro

Optional: cooked noodles or rice for serving

Here's How:

Soak bamboo skewers in water for 20 minutes before using. Slice chicken into thin strips (I got six strips from each thigh). Set aside. Make marinade by mixing teriyaki sauce and vegetable oil in a bowl. Place chicken in bowl with marinade, making sure all the chicken is covered. Marinate for at least 30 minutes or up to overnight. Thread the strips of chicken, filling the skewers halfway. This allows for a "handle" to turn the skewers as they cook. To cook, grill on your BBQ or indoor grill, or under the broiler. These cook quickly, so keep your eye on them. Depending on how thick or thin you sliced your chicken, they will take between 5 and 15 minutes to cook. Serve with peanut sauce garnished with green onion and/or cilantro. Noodles or rice make a perfect accompaniment if desired.

If the idea of threading chicken on skewers doesn't appeal to you, you can simply saute marinated chicken pieces in vegetable oil and serve over rice or noodles topped with peanut sauce.

Whether you prefer crunchy or creamy, we should take every opportunity to celebrate the simple things in life — like peanut butter and jelly sandwiches with a glass of cold milk.

- 4 ounces dried whole-wheat rotini pasta (about 1 1/2 cups)
- nonstick cooking spray
- 16 ounces frozen mixed vegetables, thawed
- 1 pouch (11 ounces) low-sodium chunk light tuna
- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) low-fat, low-sodium condensed cream of chicken soup
- 1/2 cup chopped roasted red bell peppers
- 1/2 cup fat-free half-and-half
- 1 teaspoon all-purpose, salt-free seasoning blend
- 3/4 cup crushed low-sodium, whole-grain crackers
- 1/4 cup shredded or grated Parmesan cheese

Prepare pasta according to package directions, omitting salt. Using colander, drain well. Transfer to large bowl.

- 3/4 tablespoon minced peeled gingerroot or 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger

- 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme, crumbled
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 1/8 teaspoon salt

- 1 cup water
- 2 cans (15 ounces each) solid-pack pumpkin

In large heavy pot, heat oil over medium-high heat, swirling to coat bottom. Cook onion 6-8 minutes, or until soft, stirring occasionally.

Stir in gingerroot, garlic, thyme, cinnamon, pepper and salt. Cook 1 minute, stirring constantly. Stir in flour. Pour in broth and water. Using spatula, scrape bottom of pot to dislodge any browned bits. Stir in pumpkin. Bring mixture to boil. Reduce heat to low and simmer 10 minutes.

Stir in milk. Remove from heat. Ladle soup into bowls. Garnish with sour cream and chives, if desired.

 - 2 tablespoons finely chopped red onion
 - 2 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- Tostadas:**
- nonstick cooking spray
 - 5 corn tortillas (6 inches each)
 - 8 ounces ground skinless turkey breast
 - 2 teaspoons chili powder
 - 1 teaspoon ground cumin
 - 1 teaspoon ground coriander
 - 1 can (15 1/2 ounces) no-salt-added black beans, rinsed and drained
 - 2 tablespoons water

To make salsa: In small bowl, stir tomatoes, avocado, corn, jalapenos, onions and lime juice. Set aside.

Preheat oven to 400 F.

To make tostadas: Line baking sheet with aluminum foil. Lightly spray foil with nonstick cooking spray. Place tortillas on baking sheet. Lightly spray tortillas with nonstick cooking spray. Using fork, pierce tortillas several times to prevent from filling with air.

Bake tortillas 5-6 minutes on each side, or until golden brown.

In medium nonstick saucepan over medium-high heat, cook turkey, chili powder, cumin and coriander 5-6 minutes, or until turkey is no longer pink, stirring occasionally to turn and break up turkey.

Add beans and water. Cook 5 minutes, or until beans are heated through. Using potato masher, coarsely mash beans. Remove from heat.

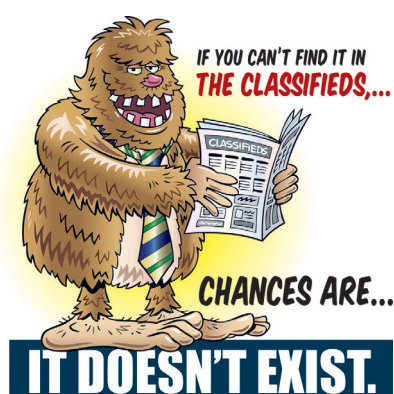

Full Education Housing Benefits Extended

If you're in school and were about to lose half of your VA education housing benefits at the end of last month due to remote classes, you're safe. Congress pushed through the REMOTE (Responsible Education Mitigating Option and Technical Extensions) Act, and it's going to cover you for the next six months.

The problem has been attending classes in person versus taking classes remotely. If you typically attend via remote classes, your housing allowance was always half that of in-person students. The pandemic landed, and with that colleges and schools went remote last year, which threatened to halve the benefit money of in-person students forced into remote classes. Congress saw that and extended the full coverage until December.


They recently stepped in again. Now you'll be covered until summer -- while schools sort out whether they're bringing students back into the classroom for the January-May semester, keeping everyone at home again or a combination of the two. As is typical of the pandemic era, even if you're currently attending in-person classes, your school might shift to remote at any time.

You and the 55,000 other student veterans potentially impacted by those reduced housing benefits can thank Nevada Sen. Catherine Cortez Masto and others for introducing the bill and pushing it to become law.

Not a student? Have you decided to sit out the shaky job market and go back to school or aim for a new trade? Start with an intro to your veterans education benefits: www.va.gov/education. Scroll down and click on the Eligibility link. Then click on the GI Bill Comparison Tool on the right and learn what programs and education benefits are available for you. Different programs have different benefits, so study those first to see which might be the best fit. If you need help sorting it all out, call the GI Bill Hotline at 888-GIBILL-1 (888-442-4551).

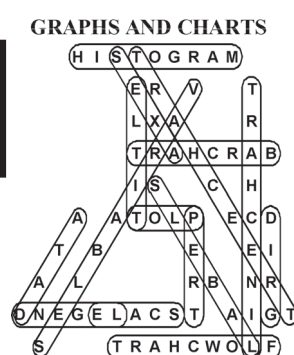
