

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before betting help. Symptoms include:

Why breakfast still matters

Many adults recall being told "breakfast is the most important meal of the day" when they were youngsters. Though the accuracy of that phrasing hinges on what people eat during their morning meal, scientific evidence supports the notion that breakfast is important to overall health. A 2017 study published in the Journal of Physiology found that eating breakfast decreased the activity of genes involved in insulin resistance and increased the amount of sugar taken up by the cells. Let's go on an adventure together....to Santa Barbara, CA!

But, I heard some other passengers talking about a different tour that sounded better, so I swapped them out. I'm really glad I did! The tour I ended up taking included a drive through the wine country surrounding Santa Barbara, visits to two estate wineries, and time for lunch and shopping in nearby Solvang - a quaint Dutch Village. It was a fabulous day!

The ports in Santa Barbara can't accommodate large ships, so we had to tender in from the ship on smaller boats. The country side around the Santa Barbara area is just stunning! Lots of rolling hills with vineyards and farms as far as the eye can see and mountains off in the distance. It was a gorgeous warm and breezy spring day in California. We were outside a lot of the day and it felt amazing.

It really makes for a great place to visit. We had lunch "on our own" and lots of time to shop and wander around the unique village.

For lunch I chose a small diner and had a sampling of various Dutch sandwiches on pumpernickel bread and potato salad - so good!!! There were three on the plate, but they were so huge that I was only able to eat one and a half! They were amazing... ...I wished I had left more room so I could finish them!

After lunch, I visited many of the shops and sat on benches enjoying the wonderful day in such a lovely Dutch setting. It was a short day in Santa Barbara, but very memorable. 


