Are You a Caregiver of a Family Member with Dementia?

For over a decade, Dr. Jaclene Zauszniewski, an internationally recognized nurse-scientist and Distinguished Faculty Researcher Award recipient of Case Western Reserve University, and her research team, have learned from caregivers and for caregivers. Her research has one common goal: helping family caregivers to better manage stress and stay healthy.

Our current project, funded by the National Institutes of Health, is focused on adult family members of persons experiencing a progressive memory problem or dementia such as Alzheimer's Disease, and who have recently entered a new (within 12 months) caregiving role. This includes:

- caregivers who have started to care for their family member at home,
 - those who have moved their family

member to a long-term care facility, and

• bereaved former caregivers whose family member with dementia has recently died.
