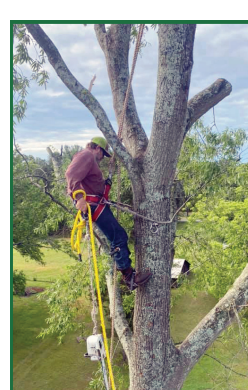

One caller to our answering service gave me his name, number and message and then said, "You know my name. What's yours?"







Through my years with the Danville Area Humane Society, we have dealt with hundreds of cruelty cases and thousands of neglect cases. Some have been the stuff of nightmares. Horrifyingly, several have been because of the actions of children or youth. In each of those cases, the child has been old enough to, as the old folks say, "know better". Last week, we had a report of an older child who suddenly "snapped his guinea pig's neck in two."

Some children are born with a love for animals. They still must be guided and taught appropriate behavior; empathy can be nurtured in that way.

Empathy is the ability to recognize and feel what another living creature (whether human or animal) is feeling, and then to act in an appropriate and compassionate manner. Empathy for living creatures can be developed, with guidance from parents, teachers, and caring adults.

Many children go through a stage of "innocent" cruelty during which they may harm insects or other small animals. However, the well-known anthropologist, Margaret Mead, said, "One of the most dangerous things that can happen to a child is to kill or torture an animal and get away with it."

Albert Schweitzer wrote, "Anyone who has accustomed himself to regard the life of any living creature as worthless is in danger of arriving also at the idea of worthless human lives." Parents and other responsible adults have the primary responsibility of teaching children how to respect animals and how to take care of them. Positive interaction with animals will, hopefully, lead to understanding that animals have feelings. Empathy takes that one step higher to actually caring that animals have feelings.

I have a precious memory of my father helping a baby bird. When we were teenagers, we had moved to Danville and into a house with a basement and

window wells. A baby bird had fallen into a window well and the mother bird nervously stood watch. My father put a broom down into the well and I heard him say, "Come on, little one, I'm trying to help you. Come on, little bird." Finally, the baby bird did figure it out and hopped up on the broom to get to his mother.

If circumstances do not permit a family to have a companion animal, volunteering at a shelter could be a wonderful way to introduce children to a variety of animals. The Gazelle furniture line springs from mid-century modern

Artist Dan Johnson (1918-1979) designed furniture for many companies with the midcentury modern look. He worked in Rome and California, and designed a number of lines of modern furniture, especially chairs and tables, for Danish and U.S. companies.

Johnson often used thin, patinated metal, iron or aluminum for arms, legs and seats, and added caning or fabric upholstery. All of his designs looked lightweight, but a chair with a bronze or iron frame is heavy and hard to shove into place at a dining-room table. One of his most famous designs was the Gazelle line designed in Rome and then sold in the U.S. He used metal parts patinated "Pompeian Verde," a green color that was inspired by the excavations at Pompeii.

The pictured Gazelle bronze and cane chair, made in the 1950s, was estimated to be worth \$4,000-\$6,000 recently. Lines made for other companies were similar, including maple furniture made in 1947, Viscount made in the late 1950s of brass and ivory or nickel and walnut or other combinations, and Satyr made with thin shapely legs. They were made by Arch Industries, Selig and others.

Q. We were given a 10-inch sterling silver "Revere bowl" as a wedding gift in 1948. It's in good condition with a liner (which I added). Can you tell me what it's worth?

A. Revere Silver bowls have been a popular wedding gifts for years. The simple shape with slightly flared lip is based on the "Liberty Bowl," which was made by Paul Revere at his silver shop in Boston in 1768. Revere bowls have been made in silver plate, sterling silver and pewter by many different makers. The value of your bowl depends on the silver content. Solid silver (sterling) is worth at least the price of the silver it contains, the melt-down value. Silver plate is worth less because it contains less silver. A well-known maker adds value. Recent

prices for a 10-inch Revere bowl range from \$600 to \$1,000 for a bowl made by Gorham. Silver plate sells for \$50 to \$300. Your bowl might sell at an auction or consignment shop.

Clarence Monday Installed as Interim County Administrator

With significant experience in local government leadership and transitions, Clarence Monday was officially installed as the Interim Pittsylvania County Administrator on February 1. Monday has spent more than 30 years working in local governments across Virginia, including a stint as Pittsylvania County's Administrator from 2014-2017 and several interim positions across the Commonwealth over the past few years.

"I am excited to come back to Pittsylvania County to help lead County government during this transition," said Interim County Administrator Clarence Monday. "This part of the State will always feel like home to me, so I'm thrilled to be able to join a quality team to help provide the services that citizens expect."

Monday has worked in leadership positions in local government across the Commonwealth. Some of those positions include the Fire Chief and City Manager for the City of Martinsville, County Administrator for Amherst County, and County Administrator for Pittsylvania County. Since retiring from Pittsylvania County in 2017, Monday has served in an interim role in several localities, including the City of Franklin and the Towns of Appomattox and Altavista. Much of this work, as well as Monday's contract with Pittsylvania County, is through the Berkley Group – a local government consulting firm that provides services in a variety of areas, including administration.

In this new role, Monday's primary goals are to catch up on the County's latest projects and initiatives, meet the staff that have been brought on since his retirement, develop a budget for the upcoming fiscal year, and assist the County in any way that he can in the search for a new County Administrator.

The contract with the Berkley Group includes a three-month term with a three month renewal option for Monday's services.

"We believe that Clarence Monday's previous experience leading Pittsylvania County make him the perfect option to serve as our Interim County Administrator," said Vic Ingram, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. "I am confident that Monday will effectively manage the County's business during this transition period."

During Monday's previous tenure with Pittsylvania County, he oversaw several important initiatives, including the re-establishment of the County's Economic Development Department in late 2015 and the groundbreaking of the Pittsylvania Pet Center. In two moves that have positively impacted Pittsylvania County as a workplace, Monday established a Human Resources Department and commissioned a salary study to ensure that employees were compensated fairly. That study led to the County's pay scale, which remains in effect today.

The County's four Middle School parks were developed under Monday's leadership.

Originally from Henry County, Monday has spent the majority of his life in Southside Virginia. Monday holds a bachelor's degree in Business Administration and a Master's in Business Administration from Old Dominion University. In his free time, Monday enjoys running and spending time with his family.

HOLLYWOOD — Wanted: big-name star, must be funny and able to move the highest-rated award show on television at a fast pace and grab enormous ratings. 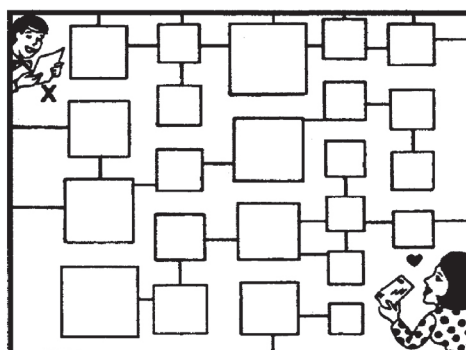

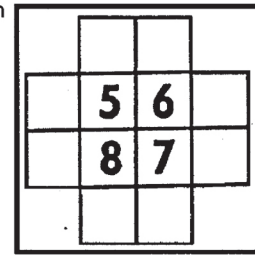

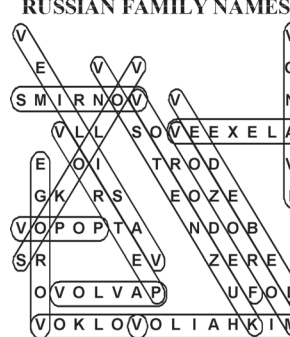

Decadent Valentine's Day Dessert Made DIY

Looking for an impressive sweet for your sweethearts on Valentine's Day? Let's make creme brulee. Most people assume that because it's a staple at swanky restaurants it must be difficult to make. I assure you, restaurant-quality creme brulee can be made at home for a fraction of the cafe cost.

If you're not familiar, creme brulee (krem-broo-lei) literally means "cream burnt." It's a cold vanilla custard with a caramelized sugar topping that hardens into a glasslike surface. The most satisfying part of eating creme brulee is that thwack when you hit the caramel surface with the back of your spoon, and it breaks, revealing the silky-smooth custard within. Divine!

The ingredients to make it are humble, but the result is remarkable. No torch or special equipment required; it's all about technique. In this recipe, we temper eggs, use a bain-marie (ban mah-REE) water bath, and broil or torch sugar to make caramel.

CREME BRULEE

Yield: 6 servings Cook Time: 35 min. Total: 3 hours

What You'll Need:

- 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- Pinch salt
- 5 egg yolks
- 1/2 cup white sugar plus extra for caramelizing
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Here's How:

1. Preheat the oven to 325 F and arrange six (4-ounce) (or four 6-ounce) ramekins in a rimmed baking pan that's at least as deep as the ramekins. Heat a kettle of water for the bain-marie.
2. In a saucepan over medium heat, bring the cream and salt to a simmer, stirring frequently until bubbles form around the edge. Remove from the heat and allow to cool. Meanwhile, in a mixing bowl, combine egg yolks with sugar and whisk briskly for 1-2 minutes.

3. Now, we temper the eggs with the hot cream, by slowly raising the temperature of the eggs so they don't scramble. Whisking constantly, gradually add the cream to the yolks. Then add vanilla and stir. Just in case we have any egg solids, strain the custard through a fine-mesh sieve into a clean container, ideally one with a pour spout.
4. Next, pour or ladle the custard into the ramekins, dividing evenly. Carefully, place the baking pan in the oven and pour enough hot water into the pan to come halfway up the sides of the ramekins, taking care not to slosh hot water onto yourself or into the ramekins. The bain-marie creates

a gentle heat resulting in a uniform cooking process.

5. Bake until the edges are set but the center still jiggles when gently shaken, about 25 to 30 minutes. You want the middle a bit wobbly, as the custard will firm up in the refrigerator. The depth of your ramekin or custard cup determines how long it takes to bake. If you're concerned, a thermometer should register 150 to 155 F in the center.
6. Remove the ramekins from the water bath and let cool on a rack for 30 minutes. Refrigerate for at least two hours. This custard can be made days in advance and refrigerated (that's why it's popular at restaurants). But don't add the caramelized topping until you're ready to serve.

7. To serve, evenly sprinkle the entire surface of each custard with a thin layer of sugar, using 1 to 2 teaspoons per ramekin. If using a kitchen blowtorch, evenly melt and caramelize the sugar. If using the broiler, put the ramekins on a baking sheet and place in cold oven directly under the broiler. Turn the broiler on high and watch closely as they brown. Serve immediately.

Now perhaps you won't think I'm crazy when I say the most romantic Valentine's Day gift I've ever received was a blowtorch. Happy Valentine's Day!
