NW-SCC, Pilgrims Sign Training Agreement

PHIL CAMPBELL -- Northwest-Shoals Community College (NW-SCC) has entered into an agreement with Pilgrim's, a subsidiary of leading global food company JBS, to train its employees for associate degrees and technical certifications.

NW-SCC signed the agreement with Pilgrim's representatives on February 1 to participate in the JBS/Pilgrim's Better Futures program that offers free college tuition to Pilgrim's team members and their child dependents. Pilgrim's offers to pay the remaining tuition balance, often called a last dollar tuition scholarship, for its workers to train in technical programs that help them succeed. The scholarship is

Speaking The *Truth* In Love

Ephesians 4:15

An amazing question was asked in John 18:38 (in the Holy Bible). Pilate, the king, in the judgment hall talking with Jesus, simply asked,

What is truth?

Whether Pilate was seeking to obtain an answer or merely rhetorically speaking since he "found no fault in Him" we may not know. But an examination of TRUTH will produce helpful facts for any today.

First, the Word of God is TRUTH. "Sanctify them through thy word, for thy word is truth" (John 17:17). Earlier in the gospel account according to John he said, "Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free" (8:32).



Second, TRUTH is not situational or determined by external circumstances.


Truth today is the same truth that existed 2,000 years ago, in the day of Christ. Truth is the same to all races, nationalities, and ages. The Truth will one day judge us (John 12:48).

Third, the TRUTH of God is powerful. The gospel (good news, the truth of God) is the "power of God unto salvation" (Romans 1:16). Jesus is THE way, in fact, the ONLY way to the Father in heaven (John 14:6).

Fourth, Each precious soul needs to study and learn the TRUTH. Our journey on earth is brief and will one day come to an end (Hebrews 9:27; John 5:28-29). Jesus spoke of a place of everlasting life and a place of eternal torment (Matthew 7:13-14). Many will go into torment and few will find paradise. The Word of God provides information for all to come to Jesus and be among the chosen few. 2 Timothy 2:15 encourages us to "study to show thyself approved unto God."

Fifth, the TRUTH of God says God wants ALL to be saved (1 Timothy 2:3-4). He gave His Son to die in our place that we might be saved (John 3:16). He invites ALL to come to Him for salvation (Matthew 11:28-30). He has given specific instructions, steps that we must take to be saved from our sins (John 8:24; Luke 13:3; Matthew 10:32-33 and Mark 16:16).

Friends, we are thrilled to examine the Scriptures with you. We would be honored to study with you further on these serious eternity-determining matters.



Keeping the Bond

Writer's note: It's my hope that we will continue to talk about serious matters with our children at young ages. They can comprehend and they will remember at important moments of their lives. Please don't let the world's trends make you give up on teaching your children what is right. Find ways and times to discuss quality of life issues, and let your children know that this is how the people in their family conduct themselves. Recently I re-read a family discussion column that I wrote in September, 2003. I thought that it would be good to share it again, so here it is. Keep teaching!

Try this. Gather the kids and a medium-sized, plastic container of water. You'll also need black pepper and liquid cleanser. While all the kids watch, pour a layer of pepper on top of the water. This experiment is about the bonding property of water. Water forms and collects because of the hydrogen oxygen bond. Water is made when the two become one. The water unit adheres to itself. Talk to your children about these matters. Then on the lighter side, remind them that this experiment also shows why you always tell them to use soap. Soap helps the water break up the dirt to get them clean.



symptoms. With Covid, people are not diagnosed by symptoms, but by frequent testing that appears to be highly inaccurate. Since diseases and viruses usually produce symptoms, one could assume that it is a "false positive" rather

FINAL FOCUS OF CONSTITUTIONAL LAW

Certain cases bring a legal topic into focus. *Snyder v. Phelps* is one of those cases.

The body of the U.S. Constitution gives us a working form of government while the Bill of Rights preserves certain freedoms. Those guarantees of freedom are really, if you think about it, for unpopular freedoms. Freedom from search, freedom from the majority religion, freedom to voice unpopular ideas.

The Westboro Church case - *Snyder v. Phelps* illustrates those rights in a fundamental way.

There is no event in a family like a funeral. We all respect those who are grieving. We pull off the road when a funeral passes.

But not the Westboro Church. They picketed U.S. soldiers' funerals, dragging flags on the ground and carrying signs saying, "Thank God for Dead Soldiers," "Thank God for 911" and other offensive signs stating that God kills soldiers because of homosexuality in the military. The Westboro Church picketed the funeral of Lance Corporal Matthew Snyder who was killed in the line of duty in Iraq in 2006.

His father was understandably upset and sued Phelps, one of the leaders of the protest, as well as the church. A jury in Maryland agreed with Snyder and awarded him 10.9 million dollars.

This verdict was reversed by the U.S. Supreme Court on the grounds that the First Amendment protected the speech of the Westboro Church.

"Westboro may have chosen the picket location to increase publicity for its views, and its speech may have been particularly hurtful to Snyder. That does not mean that its speech should be afforded less than the full First Amendment protection under the circumstances of this case."







per the advertised price. An argument ensued about the advertised price and the actual cost at the pump. The clerk and manager were adamant that it was not their fault. They said the advertised price on the road display could not be fixed by them, so they continued advertising the price as \$2.91(9/10). I told them it was illegal to continue selling fuel at a different price than what was advertised by the road sign. It cost me an additional \$.78 for my fuel. I also explained that everyone who purchased

fuel expecting to pay \$2.91 (9/10) was being ripped off this way.

They reiterated that they couldn't do anything about it, but wouldn't put a sign on the affected pumps alerting the public to a change in pricing from the road sign. They refused and I informed them I was calling the Florence Police. About 10 minutes later the police arrived, but just about 30 seconds before, the clerk came out and changed the price on the road sign to \$2.99 (9/10). I explained to the responding office what had transpired. He said he couldn't do anything about it now because the advertisement was now consistent with the pumps. So, my public service is to alert the public about fuel stations that may be ripping off the public and getting

away with it. I lost only \$.78 this day, but adding up what they may have ripped off the public for would be much higher. I would like to see the division of weights and measures visit them and audit their sales for that week.

With fuel prices so volatile, this is a good reminder for us to take notice of the advertised pricing and pump pricing when we fill-up our vehicles.

“Do coaches still cut kids from teams?”

Dear Athletic Support: My son's not good at sports. He likes to play. Loves basketball, baseball, football. But he's just not any good. Barely even gets to go in the games. He's already in junior high, and it surprised the heck out of me when he made the basketball team. I've got two questions for you: First, do coaches really still cut kids from the school teams? I mean, if my son made it, I just don't think kids still have to "make the team." Second, what can I do to get my kid better at sports?

Dear Making:

Coaches still cut kids from basketball teams. If your son made the team, despite not being the best athlete, then maybe low numbers were his golden ticket.

I'm not going to say what sport because I don't want anyone trying to put this together. I don't want anyone to get in trouble, either. I just want to make sure my daughter is okay. I can remember what it was like in the locker room. Everybody always thinks the guys have it tough. You should try being in a girls' locker room. I'm sure it's changed since I was in school, but I am really worried about my daughter. She's never said anything to me outright about being bullied. It's just a feeling I have in my gut. Should I try and talk to her about it?

Dear Sick: Yes, you should talk to her as soon as possible. Bullying is a very serious issue, especially among teenage girls.

With the advent of

social media, there are many new ways to bully. These cyber-attacks aren't just constrained to the locker room — they're everywhere. For many teenagers, it feels like there's no escape.

That is why you need to talk to your daughter as soon as possible. Try and keep the conversation from becoming accusatory. If she does open up, a good next step would be reaching out to the school counselor.

BE PATIENT, FIND YOUR PATH...AND FORGET ABOUT STUDENT LOANS

Dear Dave,
My husband and I are 30, and we are on Baby Step 2. He wants to go back to school and become a social worker. He currently makes about \$20,000 a year as a teacher's assistant, and he wants to take out student loans to do this. He already has an associate's degree, which wouldn't mean four years of loans, but the idea scares me a lot. I have a good job, so how can I still support him and his desire to further his education without agreeing to go deeper into debt?

Dear Britney,
So, it's kind of a situation where you're working the Baby Steps and he's not. On top of this, he wants to go into debt to do social work. Does he know what social workers make these days? This guy obviously has a heart for helping people. That's a great thing. But I've got to believe there are ways to expand his options. Social work is one path, but there are probably several paths he could follow to get involved in what he loves about the idea of social work. I'm guessing he has a passion for counseling and advocating, too. Finishing

a four-year degree would put him in a position where he could potentially move into a guidance counselor role or something along those lines, considering his background. But taking out loans isn't necessary. He just needs to be patient, and wait a little bit while you two buckle down on the Baby Steps and get out of debt. He could get a second job for a while nights or weekends, and then you'd be able to pay off your debt faster and avoid those stupid loans thanks to the cash you set aside. Plus, there are millions of dollars in scholarships out there for traditional and non-traditional students.

Sometimes when people feel stuck in a job, they automatically default to the idea they need a degree. What your husband really needs right now is a clear idea and direction. Then, you determine if a degree is necessary to get there. Don't misunderstand me. I'm not against social work. But I've talked to so many people who went six-figures into debt, only to wind up making \$38,000 as a social worker for the state. That's crazy!

You two need to sit down together, and talk all this out. Tell him why you're worried, and point out that borrowing a bunch of money isn't the only way—and definitely isn't the smart way—to make this happen. If you really want to support him, Britney, you need to help him see there are steps he can take to pursue his dream without it turning into a financial nightmare for both of you.

Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part A Part 2"

Last week we discussed how Medicare Part A will cover you if you are admitted into the hospital. A hospital, under Medicare, can be acute care hospitals, critical care hospitals, inpatient rehabilitation facilities, long term care hospitals or mental health care.

The one aspect of Medicare Part A we get the most questions about is coverage at a skilled nursing facility (SNF). To be covered by Medicare at a SNF certain criteria has to be met. First, of course, is you must have Medicare Part A. Next your doctor has determined that you need daily skilled care given by, or under the supervision of, skilled nursing or therapy personnel. Your skilled nursing care will have to be in a SNF that is certified by Medicare.

What a lot of people don't know is that you must have a "qualifying" hospital stay to be covered at a SNF. Under Medicare a "qualifying" hospital stay is at least a 3-day inpatient stay prior to being admitted to the SNF. If you go to the ER and are held one day for observation and are admitted into the hospital for two days this does not constitute a "qualifying" hospital stay. If you are admitted on a Monday and discharged the following Wednesday this is not a "qualifying" hospital stay. In the two examples above those are 2-day inpatient stays. A good rule of thumb is you must be admitted as inpatient for at least three midnights.

You also need to know that Medicare Part A will only cover you for 100 days at a SNF and only 20 of those days are at 100%. In other words days 1-20 are covered at 100%. Days 21-100 you will pay the first \$185.50 per day and Medicare pays the rest of the cost. Starting with day 101 you will pay 100% of the bill.







There were 2,500 comments/jokes on the city's Facebook page within 24 hours of the January 25 announcement.

As of last Thursday, 8,700 had signed a petition at Change.org entitled, Bring Back the old Florence Logo!

Some 300 community surveys were distributed to select people FROM select people asking what citizens hoped to convey in a new series of branding elements for the city.

Yet, some people who should have known about such a crucial step were apparently out of the loop until the reveal on January 25, also an invitation-only event.

One would think that input would be sought from a host of areas and diverse perspectives.

The results were questionable and the public was uninformed during the process. It seemed to be more important to surprise everyone with the results than include everyone in the process.

That exclusionary aspect is the crux of the problem.

The exclamation point with the stacked "l" and "o" in question beside the F can also be vaguely interpreted as a guitar. A thin vertical line or two would completely change the perspective.

During a scheduled council meeting last week, with a socially-distanced full room, some tempers flared. Some of the comments from attendees were personal and accusatory.

Live viewership was a constant 1300-1400 on Facebook during most of the meeting.

Some council members said/implied they didn't initially associate the "F!" version of the new branding with any potential vulgarities.

However, It doesn't take one's mind being in the gutter to know that the younger generations and the prevalence of social media would take it in that direction with any of 2 or 3 consonants, F! being the primary one.

Not understanding that is either being very naive or a problematic difference of generations.

The council deadlocked with a 3-3 vote during the meeting on a motion to drop Tatum from the logo design (\$25,000, only \$10K of which has been paid) and to drop them from the remainder of a proposed contract (\$75,000).

The council will take up the issue of Tatum again at next week's meeting. I'm confident they will work together on the solution to this issue.

Regardless, it was good to see such energy by the community. If a fraction of that could be channeled in a positive direction moving forward, citizens of Florence could solve a lot of issues.

SIGNS OF THE PAST

**BURRELL NORMAL SCHOOL
BURRELL HIGH SCHOOL
BURRELL-SLATER HIGH SCHOOL
1903-1969**

This school, named for Burrell Academy, formerly in Selma, Alabama, was given to Florence by the American Missionary Association. In 1903, Burrell Normal School opened and served African-American students in grades 1-12. In 1937, the Florence City Board of Education assumed its operation and changed the name to Burrell High School. In 1951, it was moved to the Slater Elementary School building on South Court Street and its name was changed to Burrell-Slater High School. That building burned in 1958. In 1960, the present building opened on this site and served students until it closed because of integration in 1969.

Location: 34.7961°N, 87.6829°W
corner N. Cherokee & W. College Sts, Florence

Burrell served the African-American community from 1903 till 1969. First it was an elementary school for the training of teachers, hence the name NORMAL School. Then it became a High School in 1937 until desegregation in 1969. Today it serves as the Burrell-Slater Community Education Center and also houses memorabilia for Florence schools.
