



AgState Follows Through on Promises After Merger

Alceco/Ag Partners and First Cooperative Association merged in September 2021 to become AgState, a combined name announced in January. One of the benefits of the merger was the ability to revolve cash to the

ability to revolve cash to the members more quickly. Total cash paid to members over the past 60 days included:

FCA/Alceco cash patronage \$2.2 Million Total revolvement from combined company \$5.6 Million Total of \$7.8 Million

This payout follows through on the promises made to the membership this past summer. "We promised the members we would continue to revolve cash back to members at a faster rate due to the financial strength of the combined company. The \$5.6M would be a highwater mark," said Chuck Specketer, AgState Board Chairman. These payouts were made in November and December of 2021 and reflect a key advantage of working with a local cooperative. This does not factor in the benefit of the DPAD deduction also issued to members for FY21. Specketer also shared - "This is just the start, as we continue to grow and work together as a combined company. Our purpose is simple - Helping Producers Prosper. We are here to help our farmers succeed."





SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES

It's time to vote -- in Ohio

With all the talk about the upcoming *Iowa Rock 'n' Roll Music Association* Hall of Fame nominations and the Labor Day weekend inductions ceremonies, we wondered just how this all compares to that "other" Rock 'n' Roll museum -- the one in Cleveland, where they are currently undergoing a similar exercise with voting underway for their 2022 nominees that were announced about a

Eligibility requirements in Cleveland call for an artist or band to have released its first commercial recording at least 25 years prior to the year of nomination -- which is very similar to the phrasing in Arnold Park. In Cleveland, though, several of the

artists who didn't make the final cut in 2021 are back campaigning for a place this year. Current Cleveland nominees include Dolly Parton, Warwick, Rage Against the Machine, New York Dolls, Kuti, and Devo... (Why wasn't Dolly Parton nominated decades ago?)

While the election is by popular vote in Ohio, the final decisions here are made by the Iowa Rock 'n' Roll Music Association Board of Directors. So far we have made only two nominations -- and we're batting .500, with a fun regional band honored several years back, and a national star who outsold The Beatles back in the day, turned down.

Iowa nominations are accepted at any time, but must be in by midnight on September 15th each year to be considered for the following year. Nominations must include biographic and contact information to be considered. So now's the time to set the stage for your favorite group in 2023. Find more information at: IowaRockNRoll.Com

Molly Shannon's *Tilly the Trickster* will close the season after performances on July 20th, 21st, 22nd and 23rd. It is based on a book by Molly Shannon, and includes a lot of fun music to keep interest high. The Art Center's outdoor stage worked very well for the Bantum shows last year...

Research director RD tells us this week that Barbara Lewis will turn 79 on Wednesday. The Michigan-born singer/songwriter is most famous for her self-penned top five hit *Hello Stranger*, on the Atlantic label. It remained on the charts for 14 weeks in the summer of 1963. More recently it has been covered by Fire and Rain (1972), Yvonne Elliman (1977), and Queen Latifah (2004).

Thursday will mark the anniversary of the day in 1942 that Glenn Miller was awarded the first Gold Record for selling a million copies of Chattanooga Choo Choo. The song was written by Mack Gordon and Harry Warren. With nearly two hundred recorded versions to choose from, one of the most highly acclaimed is featured on Ray Charles' 1960 album, Genius Hits The Road for ABC Records...

And it was on February 11, 1964 that Art Carney won the award for Best Supporting Actor in a series, at the sixth annual Emmy Awards. The award was based on his role as Ed Norton, on The Jackie Gleason Show.

The show's theme song, *Melancholy Serenade*, was written by Gleason, and recorded by his orchestra. Other renditions include those by Les Elgart (1955), Si Zenter (1960) and King Curtis, (1964).

Bob was preceded in death by his wife, Sherry; parents, Freddie and Alta Ahrenstorff.



The Raebel Murder - A Dickinson County "In Cold Blood" Tale

The Dickinson County Historical Society and Museum is pleased to welcome Jim Ladegaard for the next event in the History LIVES! Speaker Series. Ladegaard will be speaking and sharing photos about the Raebel Murder Thursday, February 10, at 7:00pm, at the Museum. The event will be live-streamed on FaceBook and available later on YouTube.

In December of 1944, Okoboji resort owner Robert (Rob) Raebel was murdered and his wife, Esther, savagely beaten in a robbery at their home/office on Lake West Okoboji. A former employee, William Henry Heincy and Heincy's father Phillip (pictured) were arrested, convicted, and hung simultaneously in the only executions ever for a crime committed in Dickinson

Retired Spirit Lake Attorney Jim Ladegaard was a childhood neighbor of Esther, who moved to Spirit Lake after Rob's murder. Ladegaard also later practiced law with K.B. Welty, who was appointed by the court to represent the Heincys. These and other conversations led to an interest in preserving this history. Ladegaard's retirement, together with technology facilitating online research resulted in the creation of this presentation.

One person observed that this story is Dickinson County's own "In Cold Blood" although Ladegaard is quick to make clear that he does not claim any similarity to Truman Capote.

Virtual "Your Money, Your Goals" Offered February 23

Iowa State University Extension and Outreach is offering a virtual "Your Money, Your Goals" program to help frontline workers assist clients who are facing financial challenges. The four-hour program will be held virtually on February 23 from 9:30 to 11:30am and 1:00 to 3:00pm.

When money worries and challenges become overwhelming, many people become unable to see beyond their immediate crisis, and soon other parts of their life begin to fall through the cracks. During this virtual training, frontline workers - service providers, clergy members, volunteers or anyone interested in helping others - will gain resources and tools to help their clients take steps toward financial stability and self-sufficiency.

"This opportunity helps build the capacity to integrate financial empowerment into helping relationships as well as help to improve the overall health and wellbeing of Iowa individuals and families," says Carol Ehlers, a human sciences specialist in family wellbeing with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach.

According to Ehlers, research shows that economic barriers prevent many people, particularly in low-income households, from managing daily tasks and challenges, and can negatively affect their ability to plan for the future. They can become so overwhelmed by their money worries and challenges that they don't have the capacity to perform basic functions.

The "Your Money, Your Goals" sessions feature a toolkit developed by the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau. Participants learn about tools and resources to help others understand their financial values, how to use credit wisely, manage debt effectively and access appropriate community resources.

"We begin the discussion with goal setting and savings and continue through understanding credit reports," Ehlers said. "The ultimate goal is to increase financial well-being and financial security."
