"Howdy," was a common everyday word where I grew up. Raised on old Stidham, now known as Milo road in rural Appalachia, I spent a lot of time at my Grandpa and Grandma Hinkle's store. People came and went buying gasoline, sandwich meat, snacks or groceries for the week. There were cane bottom chairs in the store. Often people would sit and chat for a while.

Regardless of how many times during the week I walked down the road to that store, the opening salutation was typically, "howdy."

People were in and out of the Hinkle store doing business. A family member was often coming or going because my grandparents had raised ten children and there were many grandchildren who frequented the Hinkle business. Often, family members were buying a soda pop or just stopping in to say "howdy."

We grew up on Milo speaking to most everyone who came and went. When a car drove by, we usually waved even though we didn't always know them. At family or church gatherings we typically talked to everyone for a minute or two and shook hands or hugged a few people.

The only time I can remember our family being speechless was when fifteen or twenty of us were sitting on the porch and a man from New York City pulled up in an older car. My grandpa had received an advertisement in the mail about a great used car he could buy for \$500. He ordered the car to surprise my grandma and we were all really surprised when this man pulled in front of the store in an old beat up looking car. He had driven the car from New York City, which was a long drive on those roads back then. After being drop jaw stunned silent for a few minutes, everyone loosened up and eventually started talking to the man who was just doing a job but now had to get back to New York. By this time, some of us were chuckling just a little. A couple of the family members took the guy over to Kermit, West Virginia to catch a Greyhound bus to begin his long journey back home.

A part of American culture has been hand shaking and embracing those we know. A part of most American religious gatherings has been shaking hands. One church I attended insisted on everybody hugging each other.

Covid-19 has impacted our world with death, sickness and business failures. The distancing for many of us continues to be tough. We wear our masks and seldom know who else is in the grocery store. We're fearful of going to the funeral home to honor and respect the deceased. Shaking hands or embracing anyone anywhere is typically totally unwelcome. Many holiday parties of large gatherings were fewer over the past holidays. People don't want to be

In June of 1992, not long after I started working for the Danville Area Humane Society, a dignified, elderly golden cat was brought to us by his owners because he was too old and they wanted a kitten. I thought then how sad it was that they were willing to turn their backs on such a treasure.

It is sad but true that older animals have a tendency to have more health problems than younger ones, and it breaks our hearts when they die. It is also true that most people want a young animal to adopt because they want to spend as much time with them as possible.

With those truths comes the sad truth that thousands of older shelter animals are overlooked

However, dogs and cats that are considered older or even elderly may be the best option for you. Older dogs are generally housebroken, do not have as many destructive behaviors (e.g. chewing) as puppies, and do not require as much exercise. Older cats are already litterbox trained and are probably less inclined to have destructive habits.

When puppies and kittens are young, their personalities and characteristics may not be as apparent. When a senior pet comes to the shelter from the owner, if the owners are honest and forthright, we are able to find out a lot of information that helps us make a perfect match.

Our Fritz Childrey Fund for Older Friends was established 13 years ago to help us place senior animals.

Fritz was an elderly dachshund that was adopted from a shelter. His human, Mark Childrey, has been a tremendous friend of ours for several years.

This fund has financed veterinary care for many older animals, pays for the adoption fee, and pays for the spay/neuter surgery. Adoption fees are waived for animals at least eight years old. Older dogs and cats are now in loving homes because of this fund. Donations, of course are accepted to finance this fund.

It is a sad fact that we will outlive most of our pets. It is painful when they die because our grief goes as deep as our love. In spite of that, we still encourage potential adopters to look beyond the cute little puppies and kittens and search for a loving senior companion.

Servings: 8

Crust:

3/4 cup butter

- 1 1/2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1 1/2 cups pecans, crushed

Cream Cheese Layer:

12 ounces cream cheese, softened

- cup powdered sugar
- 4 tablespoons heavy cream

Pudding Layer:

- 3 egg yolks cups whole milk

- teaspoon vanilla extract 1

chocolate syrup

1/2 cup chopped pecans

Heat oven to 350 F.

To make crust: In saucepan, melt butter; add flour, brown sugar and crushed pecans. Stir until combined. Press into 9 1/2-inch deep pie plate. Bake 15-20 minutes until crust begins to

brown. Cool completely.

To make cream cheese layer: In medium bowl, mix cream cheese until creamy. Add powdered sugar and heavy cream; mix until smooth. Spread over cooled pecan crust. Refrigerate.

To make pudding layer: In medium bowl, whisk egg yolks. Add milk; whisk until combined. Set aside.

In separate medium bowl, whisk sugar, cocoa powder, cornstarch, flour and salt until combined.

In saucepan over medium heat, add egg yolk mixture and flour mixture. Whisk constantly until pudding begins to thicken and bubble. Add butter and vanilla extract stirring until butter is melted. Pour chocolate pudding in shallow bowl. Cover with plastic wrap touching pudding to keep it from

forming skin. Refrigerate 30 minutes. Pour pudding over cream cheese layer. Cover pie with plastic wrap. Refrigerate overnight.

To make whipped cream topping: In stand mixer bowl, add heavy cream, powdered sugar and vanilla extract. Whip until stiff peaks form. Spread whipped cream over pudding layer.

Drizzle pie with chocolate syrup and sprinkle with chopped pecans.






