Milk Glass

Glass bottles were expensive packages for alcoholic drinks and other liquids, including many beauty products, by the late 1700s. But makers liked to give products a permanent label, not just a pasted, handwritten or printed paper label. So bottles were made with a thin layer of glass that was heated to cover the label and adhere it to the bottle permanently. Other less decorative bottles were made with the product name captured in the mold.

A label under glass couldn't fall off, get damaged or become illegible, so they were favored by apothecaries, the drug stores of the past. Many of these glass-covered labels were handwritten with the Latin names of medicines using fancy style gold-leafed letters. Glass Works Auctions featured milk glass barber bottles in an auction that included this American circa 1880-1900 barber bottle. It has a shaker top and a label under glass with the name "W.L. Doremus, Bay Rum" surrounding the head of a girl in a colorful bonnet. Highest bid, \$222.

Q. I inherited a set of International's "Spring Glory" sterling silver flatware 14 years ago. There are 12 five-piece place settings and several serving pieces. I showed it to a dealer last year who valued it at \$1,000. I need to know its current value.

A. International Silver Company made "Spring Glory" flatware from 1942 to 1996. Sterling silver flatware was a popular wedding present years ago. It's not as popular today and, although the price of silver has gone up in the past year, sets of silver are hard to sell. It's important to know if the value you were given is what the dealer thought they could sell the silver for or what they would pay you for it. You can check prices for "Spring Glory" silver flatware prices on silver matching services listed online. Replacements Ltd. lists a five-piece place setting of "Spring Glory" for \$210 to \$230. Matching services also buy silver flatware but will pay you a percentage of what they sell it for since they have to make a profit.

Q. Why do we say dinner dishes are made of china?

A. The story was part of my junior high school history lessons. Marco Polo brought "china" (a green colored pot) back from his explorations of China in 1260. Europe had

only heavy pottery dishes, and "china," the porcelain made in China, was lightweight, white, translucent and "fit for a queen." It was one of the things that encouraged the king and queen of Spain to give Christopher Columbus money for his explorations in 1492.

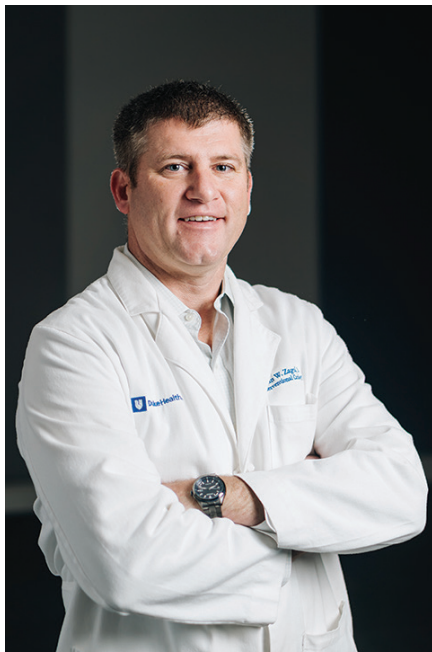

How Healthy is Your Heart?

Your heart is one of the hardest working parts of your body. It's also one of the most threatened. In fact, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), heart disease is the leading cause of death for both men and women in the U.S. – about one in four deaths. Additionally, in the U.S., someone has a heart attack every 40 seconds. And about one in five of those heart attacks is silent – meaning you may not be aware of damage to your heart that is happening or has already taken place.



That is why it is so important to stay on top of our heart health.

Do you know how healthy your heart is? This American Heart Month, refresh yourself on a few key indicators that can give insight into your heart's current health state and point to any specific steps you may need to take for its care.

Cholesterol is a substance that circulates in your blood and comes in two different types – LDL (also known as the “bad” kind) and HDL (known as the “good” kind). HDL cholesterol transports the LDL cholesterol from your arteries to the liver, where it is flushed from your body. Too much of the LDL or not enough of the HDL increases your risk for build-up and blockage in your arteries, potentially leading to heart attack or stroke. Knowing your cholesterol numbers is one of the key ways to assess your heart health and one of the most manageable factors in terms of lowering your risk for disease. Targets for healthy cholesterol levels can vary based on age and gender but a general rule of thumb for adults is to aim for 125-200 mg/dL.

Blood pressure is just what it says – it measures the pressure or force of blood within your arteries. Like cholesterol, there are two different numbers – your systolic pressure (the higher of the two numbers) measures your blood pressure when your heart beats and your diastolic pressure (the lower of the two numbers) measures your blood's pressure when your heart is resting between beats. A normal blood pressure reading is less than 120 systolic and less than 80 diastolic. Readings above these levels would be considered elevated or high, including hypertension when readings are 130/80 or above. High blood pressure can be a significant contributor to and sign of serious heart issues. Unfortunately, it is an all too common condition, affecting nearly half of American adults according to the American Heart Association, and presenting no symptoms the majority of the time. Because there are often no clear-cut symptoms, it's important to get your blood pressure checked. Fortunately, high blood pressure can be lowered and managed with the proper care.

Waist size can also be a harbinger for heart health and a predictor of heart problems. A study by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute showed that men with a waist size larger than 40 inches and women with a waist size greater than 35 inches are at higher risk for heart disease and type 2 diabetes. The good news is that healthy eating and physical activity can help you lower and maintain a healthy waist size and stay on the road to good heart health. Risk factors like high cholesterol and blood pressure can also run in your family, so knowing your family's heart health history can help you stay alert to your own health risks. And while these aren't the only markers on the map to good heart health, they are key factors in determining how healthy your heart is and your risk for heart issues now or down the road. Your primary care provider can check these numbers for you – including during your annual check-up – and work with you on a plan to make any changes necessary to get you back on track, whether it's simple lifestyle changes or medication if necessary.

How healthy is your heart? Know your numbers so you can know how to stay on the road to good heart health.

Caramel Apple Cobbler Dump Cake



Ingredients

- 2 (21 ounce) cans apple pie filling
- 1/2 (11 ounce) bag caramel bits (found in the baking section by the chocolate chips)
- 1 (15 ounce) box yellow cake mix
- 1 cup melted butter (2 sticks)



Instructions

- Preheat your oven to 350 degrees and grease a 9x13 baking dish with non-stick spray.
- Spread both cans of apple pie filling onto the bottom of your prepared dish.
- Sprinkle about half of the bag of caramel bits evenly over the top of the pie filling.
- Evenly distribute the dry cake mix over top.
- Pour the melted butter evenly over the cake mix covering as much of it as you can.
- Bake uncovered in the center rack for 30-40 minutes or until the buttery cake mix turns a deep golden brown.
- Allow it to cool for about 5 minutes and then serve warm with vanilla ice cream.

Recipe Notes

You could also sprinkle a handful of chopped pecans in with the caramel bits for added crunch, and if you really like spice, try sprinkling extra cinnamon or nutmeg over the cake mix before adding the butter.

Place any leftovers covered in the fridge for up to 5 days and reheat in the microwave. It's just as good leftover!

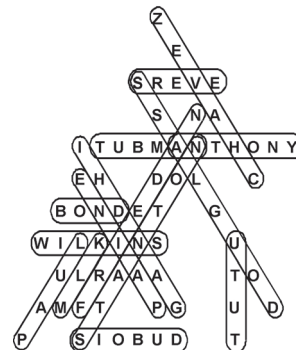

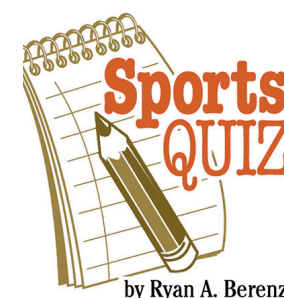
