## Treasurer's Office Closed for an Hour





#### Big Weekend for Big 4 Hoops

One would struggle to find a better weekend of college hoops for our four Division I programs in the State of Iowa. The four programs combined to go 7-1, which was the best that they could do as the UNI and Drake women played each other on Saturday. Drake won that game at UNI 73-68, scoring the last seven points of a back-and-forth game that saw the Bulldogs complete the season sweep of the Panthers. The Iowa State women got a big win on Saturday over #15 Oklahoma. The 25th ranked Iowa women got a huge road win at #6 Indiana over the weekend 96-91. The Hawkeyes led for most of the game and will have the unique opportunity of playing Indiana again on Monday night in Carver Hawkeye Arena due to an earlier game being postponed. The good news for Iowa fans is they won this first game with star Caitlin Clark scoring "only" 18 points, which shows the firepower this team has when they are healthy. Iowa State finished off the strong Saturday with an impressive 89-67 win over #15 Oklahoma in front of over 11,000 Cyclone fans in Hilton Coliseum. The win came on a day when star Ashley Joens was honored for becoming ISU's all-time leading scorer. The senior made the day very memorable with a 28 point and 9 rebound performance that kept the Cyclones in first place in

the Big 12. The weekend was huge for the men's teams as well and Iowa State got it started with a much-needed 75-54 victory also over Oklahoma in Hilton Coliseum on Saturday behind Izaiah Brockington's 22 points on 10 of 13 shooting. This was probably ISU's best overall performance of the season since they dismantled Iowa 73-53 in December. The Cyclones raced to a 40-25 halftime lead and then fended off several Sooner runs in the second half, where ISU fans were holding their breath after watching ISU blow a 15-point second half lead in Hilton a week ago in a crushing overtime loss to Kansas State. That history would not repeat itself as ISU answered with a late 15-0 run to put the game on ice and improve to 18-9 on the season while bolstering their NCAA Tournament chances. Iowa played at about the same time and came away with a huge 75-62 win at #18 Ohio State. The win came off the heels of a very disappointing home loss to Michigan on Thursday night and was very impressive considering the short turnaround time for the Hawks. The game started like the short turn around time bothered Iowa, as they fell behind 21-10 at the 13:00 mark of the first half. Star Keegan Murray would have no part of another loss as he scored the next 10 Hawkeye points to pull Iowa back into the game. Murray scored 20 points in the first half that saw the Hawks take a 39-38 advantage. Iowa would control the second half and pull away late for the key victory that puts them squarely in the NCAA Tournament with an 18-8 overall record and 8-7 mark in the B1G. Drake would top off the Saturday hoops extravaganza with an impressive 83-76 road victory over what was then league leading Loyola Chicago. Freshman star Tucker DeVries led the Bulldogs with 24 points as Drake improved to 19-9 overall and 10-5 in the Missouri Valley, which is just 1.5 games behind league leading Northern Iowa. Speaking of UNI, the Panthers location, with sufficient parking, an area for our Food Bank of capped off the weekend of hoops with a dominating 95-75 win over Missouri State at home on Sunday night to take over sole possession of first place in the Valley. AJ Green led UNI with 21 points while Noah Carter added 17 points and 8 rebounds as the Panthers claimed their fourth straight home victory in the

race for the #1 seed in the upcoming Arch Madness Tournament. We are so blessed to have so many quality programs in the State of Iowa. On the women's side, Iowa and Iowa State are locks for the NCAA Tournament and Drake and UNI will have solid chances to claim a spot if they can win the Missouri Valley Tournament in a few weeks. On the men's side, it appears Iowa and ISU still need 1-2 more wins each to solidify their spots, but as of Monday they were both in according to CBS's Bracketology Report that updates daily. CBC has Iowa in as 10 seed playing LSU and ISU in as a 7 seed playing Murray State. For UNI or Drake to make the tournament, they will have to win their conference tournament, which both teams will have a very good chance of as they are both playing quality basketball at the right time of the season. Let's hope the Cyclone and Hawkeye women can keep their strong seeds and that Drake or UNI can surprise people and win their conference tournament. On the men's side, hopefully ISU and Iowa can pick up their needed wins and Drake or UNI can win the Valley Tournament so we have three men's teams in the field, which makes watching the tournament so much more enjoyable. Let the Madness begin!

Preheat oven to 425°F. Spray a large sheet pan with cooking spray. Set aside. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Add ground pork, chopped ginger and minced garlic. Cook, stirring and breaking

powder. Pour over pork and veggies and stir well to combine. Bring to a low boil and cook for 1 minute, then remove from the

heat. Place egg rolls wrappers flat on the counter in a diamond shape. Place

 $1/4-1/_2$  cup of filling in the center of each wrapper. Fold the bottom corner up, then fold each side in, then roll up. Place a dot of water on the top corner to

seal the egg roll shut. Place egg rolls on the greased pan, spray the tops and sides liberally with clive oil spray, then bake until crisp, about 20–22 minutes, flipping halfway through. Meanwhile, in a medium saucepan, combine

sliced carrots, soy sauce, orange juice, sesame oil and ground ginger. Bring to

a boil over high heat, then cover and reduce heat to low. Simmer for 15-20

minutes, until tender. Stir in honey, then serve with egg rolls. If desired, dip egg rolls in sweet and sour sauce or Thai sweet chili sauce.



## CB Lewis Central Shakes the Lakes!

Spirit Lake's 4th Annual Show and Jazz Choir Competition, Shake The Lakes, saw regional middle school and high school music students competing Friday and Saturday in the Sami Bedell Center for the Performing Arts, with the Spirit Lake Music Boosters hosting 38 performing groups and several thousand people over the two days of the event.

Festivities kicked off on Friday night with five middle school show choirs participating in competition inside the packed Sami Center. The evening culminated in this year's debut performance by the home group, Spirit Rising, from Spirit Lake Middle School, directed by Luke Miller, with choreography by Spirit Lake alumni Max Bower, assisted by Spirit Lake High School junior Maggie McKim.

(Due to space constraints, we can list only the first three place awards for each competition. More information may be found on school websites or Facebook.) Middle

School Show Choir awards included Sioux City East's Evolution earning first place, followed by Sioux Center's Adrenaline, and Emmetsburg's Evolution. Best Vocal and Visual awards were earned by Sioux City East. Central Lyon's Claire Reiter, with Sioux Center's Eden Dekruyf each earned Best Soloist awards as well.

High School events kicked off at 8:00 Saturday morning, and continued for over 15 hours, with 14 show choirs and 16 jazz choirs competing for awards. (As hosts of the event, Spirit Lake's Lake Effect Jazz Choir and Music Factory Show Choir participated in the event only in exhibition, with the latter not taking the stage until after 10:30 PM after a full day of set up and event hosting for the students. Despite the late hour, the 77 Music Factory performers and the 20 member Baldies Eagles band brought the energy inside the building to a fever pitch with a breathtaking visual and vocal performance. Both Lake Effect and Music Factory are directed by Luke Miller. Choreography for *Music Factory* is provided by Ben Eklund.

Jazz Choir awards in Class 1A included Harris - Lake Park's Vocal Jazz, Mason City, Newman Catholic's Viva Voce, and South O'Brien's Melomania.

Class 2A placings included Central Lyon's Roarin' Jazz, and West Lyon's Vocal Jazz, along with MVAOCOU's Vocal Jazz. Class 3A saw Algona's Scarlet Midnight, as the only recognized choir in the class, while Class 4A saw competition with Storm Lake's Vocal Jazz taking first, and Sioux City North's Jazzafrass taking second.

Vocal Jazz Caption Awards were earned by Central Lyon's Combo, with Best Male Solo awarded to Algona's Seth Walker, and Best Female Solo earned by Elizabeth Tapia, of

High School Show Choir Daytime Awards included Emmetsburg's Black and Gold, in First Place, in the Prep Division; with Sioux City Heelan's Magnifique in First Place, followed by Heelan's MoMANtum, and Sioux Center's Revolution, in the Unisex Division. North Union's Kinetic Fusion earned First Place in the 1A Division, while Tri Center's TC Sensations, took Second Place. In the 2A Division, Belmond-Klemme earned First Place, followed by Vermillion's Rhythm in Red, and Emmetsburg's High Voltage. 3A competition saw Sioux Center's Satisfaction earn First Place, and Heelan's Harmonia Mundi, Second. Lewis Central's Corporation was first in the 4A Division, while Ralston, Nebraska's Rush was Second.

Belmond-Klemme's *New Group* was named the Champion in 1A/2A competition. Caption Awards went to Ralston's Donaven Carr as Best Male Vocalist; Ashlyn Van Vorst, of Sioux Center's Satisfaction, as Best Female Vocalist. The People's Choice Award for Best Male Vocalist went to Donaven Carr. And Ashlyn Van Vorst was named Best Female Vocalist. The People's Choice Award went to Sioux City Heelan, with Alta-Aurelia named for the Social Media All Star Award. The Best Director award was earned by Sioux City

Grand Champion, Lewis Central's Corporation, also won Best Vocals, Best Choreography, and Best Band. Runners up included Ralson's Rush, Sioux Center's Satisfaction, Heelan's Harmonia Mundi, Vermillion's Rhythm in Red, Belmond-Klemme's New Group, and Emmetsburg's High Voltage. 1A Division award winners included North Union's Kinetic Fusion, and Tri-Center's TC Sensations, 2A Division winners included Belmond, Klemme's New Group, Vermillion, South Dakota's New Group, and Emmetsburg's

Sioux Center's Satisfaction garnered First Place in the 3A Division, followed by Sioux City Heelen's Harmonia Mundi. 4A competition saw Lewis Central's Corporation take First Place, followed by Ralston, Nebraska's Rush. Belmond-Kemme's New Group earned Class

Iowa School Aid Unfair to the Okoboji School District

Over the last several decades the State of Iowa's financial aid to education has grown to become very complex. An inadvertent result of these complex calculations for State Aid to Education has resulted in an unfair treatment to the Okoboji School District.

Iowa law 257.1 provides that if a school district has extra money in its infrastructure fund its State Aid to Education will be reduced by the same amount. This unfair wording means the Okoboji School District has been unfairly deprived of \$6,200,000 in annual State Aid to Education since the 2010-2011 school year. As a result, Okoboji School District property taxpayers have had to pay an additional \$6,200,000 in property taxes. The Okoboji District is the only school district in Iowa that has been impacted so far.

Iowa Legislators To The Rescue

Our local Iowa legislators have committed to fixing this inequity in the current legislative session. Our Senator Dave Rowley has authored an Iowa Senate bill to fix this inequity (SF 2248). A similar bill has been proposed in the Iowa House by Representative - John Wills of Spirit Lake (HF 2136). We have the support of our local legislators, but your words of encouragement will provide them the extra motivation to be sure this inequity is fixed during the 2022 legislature session. As you know having legislation introduced is just the first step to having any legislation adopted. We need a majority of the House and a majority of the Senate to have any legislation enacted. We can reasonably expect support from Governor Reynolds, if this legislation is adopted by both houses of the legislature. If we miss the 2022 session it will be another year before we have another opportunity to fix this problem.



The Boji Mammoths (23-7-4) were eager for a rematch after getting shutout game 2 in Omaha a week ago. Omaha would get on the board first with a powerplay goal at the 2:17 mark for a one



goal lead after one period. Boji would answer early in the 2nd at 14:10 on a goal by Cale Quiring assisted by Blake Danielson. Josh Wavra would find the net four minutes later assisted by Ethan Jerge. The Mammoths would add a third goal at 4:40 by Camdon Cardwell assisted by Regan Crichton to carry a 3-1 lead into the third. Quiring would add an insurance goal with 11:23 remaining for a 4-1 lead where it would finish for a solid Mammoth win. Brody Madagan made 19 saves for the win. The Knights would tie it early in the 2nd at 13:50 however the Mammoths would respond at 6:28 Dillon Ferguson unassisted for a short-lived 2-1 lead as the Knights would score at 3:31 to tie it at two. Boji would go back on top with a powerplay goal at 1:05 by Pierce Hetland assisted by Cale Quiring and Dillon Ferguson for a 3-2 lead going into the third. The Mammoths would tally two minutes into the 3rd with a goal by Cale Quiring assisted by Dillon Ferguson but 53 seconds later the Knights would find the net to make it 4-3 with 12:07 remaining. Iowa School Aid Unfair to the Okoboji School District

Over the last several decades the State of Iowa's financial aid to education has grown to become very complex. An inadvertent result of these complex calculations for State Aid to Education has resulted in an unfair treatment to the Okoboji School District.

Iowa law 257.1 provides that if a school district has extra money in its infrastructure fund its State Aid to Education will be reduced by the same amount. This unfair wording means the Okoboji School District has been unfairly deprived of \$6,200,000 in annual State Aid to Education since the 2010-2011 school year. As a result, Okoboji School District property taxpayers have had to pay an additional \$6,200,000 in property taxes. The Okoboji District is the only school district in Iowa that has been impacted so far.

Iowa Legislators To The Rescue

Our local Iowa legislators have committed to fixing this inequity in the current legislative session. Our Senator Dave Rowley has authored an Iowa Senate bill to fix this inequity (SF 2248). A similar bill has been proposed in the Iowa House by Representative - John Wills of Spirit Lake (HF 2136). We have the support of our local legislators, but your words of encouragement will provide them the extra motivation to be sure this inequity is fixed during the 2022 legislature session. As you know having legislation introduced is just the first step to having any legislation adopted. We need a majority of the House and a majority of the Senate to have any legislation enacted. We can reasonably expect support from Governor Reynolds, if this legislation is adopted by both houses of the legislature. If we miss the 2022 session it will be another year before we have another opportunity to fix this problem.



## ISU Extension and Outreach to Host Farm Succession Workshop

Iowa State University Extension and Outreach invites area farmers and livestock producers to attend "Farm Succes-

sion for You" on Wednesday, March 16, from 10:00am to 3:00pm, at the Dickinson



County Community Room located in the Expo Building at the Fairgrounds in Spirit Lake.

The program is designed to provide both practical experience and real research-based technical expertise to guide farmers and ag businesses in building their own succession plan.

"The program will focus on making a plan for the future in terms of your farm or agribusiness," said Madeleine Bretey-Smith, ag program coordinator with ISU Extension and Outreach. "We want to see local farmers and families survive and thrive for generations to come. This program is being hosted as an opportunity for farmers to learn about and begin making plans to protect their farm for the next generation, whether that be for a child or grandchild, neighbor or friend."

The program will focus on farm transition and estate planning, with the following topics and speakers featured:

- "Succession: What is your vision? What are your goals?" presented by Gary Wright, farm management specialist with ISU Extension and Outreach
- "Ideas for a Successful and Harmonious Farm Transition,"
   presented by Kitt Tovar Jensen, a staff attorney with the
   ISU Center for Agricultural Law and Taxation
   "Succession Planning Legal Pavious" presented by Kitt
- "Succession Planning Legal Review," presented by Kitt Tovar Jensen, a staff attorney with the ISU Center for Agricultural Law and Taxation
- "Beginning Farmer Loan and Tax Credit Programs, presented by Steve Ferguson, ag development and program specialist with the Iowa Finance Authority

Overall, the program will address the importance of creating a successful transition plan that is legally binding and secure. As goals, life and laws change, succession and transition planning are an essential part of a successful farm business.






