Medicare Minute

"Medicare Part B Coverage"

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare 'covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$233 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$233 filed on Part B each year and, after the deductible is met, you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you receive.

is the only radiation therapy center in north Alabama to offer prone breast radiation therapy. Prone breast radiation therapy is a unique approach to treating breast cancer. Radiation is administered on a specially designed breast board to help a woman lie comfortably in the prone position – typically on the stomach, with the breast hanging away from the body.

In this position, radiation beams can be delivered within a few millimeters of precision, allowing the physician to protect surrounding tissue and nearby organs like the heart and lungs. This lowers the risks for immediate side effects and for future complications like heart disease.

The amount radiation delivered in the prone position is the same as standard supine treatments. The patient is simply in a different position, avoiding exposure to radiation major internal organs. Most studies when comparing that radiation treatments in the prone position versus supine position, there is lower radiation exposure to both the lungs and

heart. "The heart is especially vulnerable to damage when the left breast is treated," said Radiation Oncologist, Dr. Vic Liengswangwong at North Alabama Cancer NAMC. Center at "Placing patients in the prone position allows us to limit radiation exposure to the heart and other vital organs. We are so excited to be the first to offer this treatment to the North Alabama community.



PASSENGERS AND GUESTS IN VEHICLES

Persons riding in motor vehicles are classified in the statutes and causes as either guests or passengers and are owed differing duties depending on whether they are guests or passengers. The difference is that guests are usually riding for free while passengers are being transported by a common carrier, such as a taxi or bus, for a fee or fare.

The duties owed by drivers or operators of motor vehicles

to their social or other nonpaying guests who are passengers are governed by the guest statute.

The guest statute provides that the driver of a vehicle only owes a guest the duty to not willfully or wantonly injure the guest. However, the guest statute is in derogation of the common law, and as such, it should be strictly construed.

The relationship between the host and the guest is consensual in nature. Therefore, protests by a guest to the driver about the driver's operation of the vehicles may vitiate that consent and change his status to that of a passenger. Whether children under 14 years of age subject to the guest statute is to be decided by the jury based upon the individual child's capacity to consent.

Basically, if you pay for the ride or are doing something to benefit the driver you are a passenger and may sue. If the driver is reckless, you are a passenger and may sue.

Where a person is a guest and seeks damages from the driver's underinsured motorist insurance carrier after a single vehicle accident, the guest statute controls the ability of the guest to recover against the insurer. 



It's because those boys out on the field represent us, our home state, the same way the Olympic athletes represent our country. And when we cheer for them, we cheer as one.

With a country that's polarized like never before, we need something to bring us together. And nothing brings people together faster than sports.

Maybe that's the angle vou've been looking for. Maybe you could grab some popcorn, get the kids back on the couch, and root for the home team as they take on China and Řussia.

Who knows, the winter games might be your chance to have a deep, meaningful discussion with your children about world politics. Then again, that might send them running from your living room faster than a Dutch speedskater.




