



Melissa Etheridge to Headline Okoboji Blue Water Festival Concert

by Steve Weisman, Okoboji Blue Water Festival Publicity Director Another exciting piece of the puzzle for the 2022 Okoboji Blue Water Festival is now in place with the announcement of Melissa

Etheridge as the headliner for the Saturday, August 13 evening concert. Recognized as one of rock's most enduring and favorite female singer-songwriters. Etheridge, whose



raspy, smoky voice continues to make her one of America's favorite performers, will continue the Festival's reputation for drawing big name acts to the concert stage.

"We are proud to bring Melissa Etheridge to Okoboji to culminate our event," said festival co-chair Greg Drees. "She has sustained a more than three-decade career of excellence."

The Festival, which is an all-day family event to raise public awareness of water quality issues in the Iowa Great Lakes, is always highlighted by an evening of musical celebration. Etheridge will perform with her band on the new stage in Preservation Plaza at the Arnolds Park Amusement Park. "The concert is our way of wrapping up the day of water quality education," added festival co-chair Julie Peterson.

Just a month earlier, Drees and Peterson announced Chad Pregracke as the 2022 Okoboji Blue Water Festival keynote speaker. At the time, Drees noted that Pregracke is "truly one of the country's most dynamic speakers on the environment, and we know he will present a strong message for people to take home with them. His enthusiasm is contagious and his work ethic unparalleled. He will have festival patrons on the edge of their seats."

Meet Melissa Etheridge - Etheridge is an artist of conviction and the author of confessional lyrics, reflecting on her experiences as a breast cancer survivor and the architect of the Melissa Etheridge Foundation, which dedicates monies for research into opioid addiction.

Etheridge's early career blossomed quickly with the release of her self-titled first album in 1988. She accomplished memorable songwriting achievements, such as "Ain't it Heavy," which won her a Grammy Award in 1992. The following year, she won artistic and commercial critical acclaim with her fourth album, "Yes I Am." That collection included "Come to My Window," the searing song of longing that won her a second Grammy for Best Female Rock Performance.

Etheridge's career remained vibrantly relevant into the next millennium, and in 2007 she won the "Best Song" category at the Academy Awards for "I Need to Wake Up," written for a noted documentary on global warming, An Inconvenient Truth.

Three more albums, "This is M.E." in 2014, "Memphis Rock & Soul" in 2016 and "The Medicine Show" in 2019, her 15th studio recording, solidified Etheridge's standing in the industry as a steadfast and creative artist. Never one to sit on her laurels, Etheridge release "One Way Out" in 2021, a collection of songs she wrote in the 80's and 90's that never made the cut. But they have now, and Etheridge fans can take a journey back in time to get a glimpse of her past.

According to Drees, "The Okoboji Blue Water Festival welcomes Melissa Etheridge to the concert stage on August 13, 2022! Music lovers of all ages are invited to this free event to showcase one of rock's best-loved performers."

The world suffers in empathy for the innocent lives lost in Ukraine due to the Russian invasion. Additional and more personal suffering looms in the U.S. and the free world as the conflict threatens global energy supplies, markets and our pocket books: Russia holds Europe in an energy bind as the supplier of nearly 40% of its gas supplies and uses this European energy dependence as a weapon to subjugate Ukraine and other former Soviet republics.

Fortunately a group of Republicans lead by H.R.McMaster, senior fellow at Stanford University's Hoover Center and former US National Security Advisor under Trump, and Republican Senator Kevin Cramer propose a solution: a joint US/Europe carbon border fee on polluting Russian goods. Such fees - also referred to as border carbon adjustments- would levy a tax on high carbon polluting goods such as aluminum and cement from Russia as well as China. These fees would incentivize Europe to import lower-carbon goods made in the U.S. with higher environmental standards, including U.S. liquefied natural gas, cleaner than Russian gas. This policy would undermine Russian President Putin's power to coerce Europe amidst the unfolding Ukraine crisis. And it would also be good for our climate as it aligns well with a border adjusted carbon fee and dividend (HR 2307) endorsed by most economists to address that crisis.




St Patrick's Day will Rock

Research director RD usually comes up with a unique item or two each week for your edification and pleasure. This week is no exception. Today is Unique Names Day, and RD has done her job well for this holiday, noting a Virginiaborn jazz and pop singer was born with the name Dorothy Jacqueline Keely, who you probably remember better as Keely Smith. In 1959, she and then-husband Louie Prima qualified for a Grammy Award with their hit, That Old Black Magic, that remained on the charts for 18 weeks. Incidentally, Wednesday would mark the 94th anniversary of Keely's birth... Saturday, March 12th was the day in 1959 that By the Time I Get to Phoenix, by Glen Campbell, won a Grammy not only for the Best Record of the year, but also Best Album, in the 10th Annual Grammy Awards. Broadcast Music Inc. (BMI) logged the song as being the most performed song in the half-decade between 1940 and 1990. Some of the other versions included the work of Toots Thielemans (1968), Bobby Goldsboro (1968,) and Susannah McCorkle, on her 1985 album, How Do You Keep the Music Playing? Daylight savings time begins on Sunday. RD says that should happen with the song, When the Sun Comes Out. (And, of course, she is always right!) The song was written by Harold Arlen and Ted Koehler, and first released by Helen O'connell in 1941. Through the decades it has been covered over one hundred times by artists such as Jeri Šouthern (1958), Julie London (1966) and most recently, by Nikki Parrott on her 2012 CD, Summertime. Now how's that for timing? This public service announcement is brought to you as a reminder to set your clocks ahead one hour before you turn out the lights on Saturday night. Otherwise you'll be late for whatever you have planned for Sunday and maybe even Monday!

It's amazing how Mr. Yarns and his fellow Democratic geniuses are still blaming the previous administration for all of the problems going on in the world today. 



2 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon 1/2 teaspoon salt


In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, baking soda, ground einnamon, and salt. Stir in the oats and set aside. In the bowl of a mixer, beat the butter, brown sugar and granulated sugar together for 1 to 2 minutes, or until well combined. Mix

in the eggs, one at a time, then mix in the vanilla extract until fully combined, scraping down the sides of the bowl. Mix in the dry ingredients until just combined, then mix in the chocolate chips,

shredded coconut and chopped pecans until incorporated. Gover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line large baking sheets with parchment paper or silicone baking mats. Using a 1 1/2-tablespoon cookie scoop, spoon the cookie dough onto baking sheets, leaving room between each one. Gently press each ball down to slightly flatten. Bake for 10 to 13 minutes, or until lightly browned. Remove from the oven, and allow the cookies to cool on the baking sheets for 5 to 10 minutes, then transfer the cookies to a wire rack to cool completely.

Store in an airtight container at room temperature for up to one week.

Preservation Effort Launches in Conjunction with 165th Anniversary of Spirit Lake Conflict

March 8, 2022, marks the 165th anniversary of the 1857 Spirit Lake Conflict. A newly created 501(c)3 non-profit has formed with the intent to preserve the landmark where the significant

events took place. Friends of the Abbie Gardner Cabin Historic Site intend to lead a preservation effort in Arnolds Park, Iowa.

"Our goal is to preserve for posterity the sacred site and meaningfulness of this significant story," says President, Anita Bomgaars. "This date marks the 165th anniversary of the clash of cultures, consequences and conciliation that turned a tragic event into a magnificent commemoration of pioneer history. We need to keep that story alive."

The newly formed group is coordinating efforts with the Iowa Department of Cultural Affairs, who manages the cabin owned by the

State of Iowa. The original Gardner cabin, standing in its historic location, is one of Iowa's most historically consequential attractions, and is in need of restoration. Mrs. Abigail Gardner Sharp bought the deteriorating cabin in 1891, attempting to preserve the cabin for future generations. She operated it as a museum for the next 29 years, sharing the dramatic story of her capture and captivity by the Dakota leader, Inkpaduta.

In addition to the kickoff of preservation efforts, State of Iowa Archeologist, Dr. John F. Doershuk, is planning an on-site dig at the site this summer. Various opportunities will be available for the community to participate in the dig and learn about artifacts connected to the site and its history.

The Friends of the Abbie Gardner Cabin Historic Site are undergoing fundraising to preserve Second row: Cade Worrell, Kaz Menough, Grady Olson, the cabin and enhance the museum with additional interpretative features. To The Editor:

I would like to set the record straight regarding some of the comments made in a previous Letter to the Editor about a Carbon Dioxide sequestration pipeline proposed to go through northwest Iowa. Summit Carbon Solutions has proposed capturing carbon from industries which expel carbon dioxide to the atmosphere. A statement was made that "energy should stay or be generated in, not out of Iowa. I would agree with that statement as Iowa has numerous ethanol and bioenergy plants which use corn or soybeans grown by Iowa farmers. Those industries, many which are Iowa investor owned, are adding to the GDP of Iowa. What are the risks of the pipeline? The pipeline being proposed would be mostly 16 inches in diameter. The trench for the pipe will be one and a half times that diameter, thus disturbing less ground. Disruption of the soil will be minimal, but any reduction in yield will be paid for through the first 3 years and any tile will be first located before even having a trencher touch the soil. Any CO2 sequestration pipeline will go under tile lines. Any claim that the CO2 is being used for extracting oil is false. The geological formations relevant to CO2 storage are located 150 miles from primary Bakken oil fields to the northeast of the Summit Carbon storage facility. Let's keep energy plants in Iowa going to provide better markets for farmers who this year face input costs nearly twice as much as last year. No farmers - no food, fuel and fiber.

ISU Extension and Outreach Offers Teacher License Renewal

Reality TV often features contestants demonstrating skills as they live in the woods, race through an obstacle course, or compete in challenges on an island. However, in the reality of everyday living, financial literacy skills are far more important for survival and are now required for high school graduation, says Carol Ehlers, a human sciences specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach.

That is why Ehlers encourages K-12 teachers to register for the upcoming "Small Change: Building Financial Security for Educators" online course starting Wednesday, March 30, from 5:00 to 7:00pm.

The course content is embedded in the financial literacy standards of the Iowa Core 21st Century Skills and Social Studies, and connects participants with curricula, resources, and school-based programs for elementary, middle, and high school levels. 
