

Dear "Speakout"

The title of this week's article is "The Date Which Russia Would Invade Ukraine".

I am amazed that our leaders in Washington and most Americans did not know the exact date which Russia would invade Ukraine. I repeatedly wrote President Biden and Secretary of State Blinken regarding this date but all I heard on the news was that an invasion was imminent.

So, you are probably saying why I think I knew when the invasion would occur. Simple, because I am an avid historian and have open ears to what I hear.

American main-stream media does not tell us the truth and often perverts and edits the news to their own

political agendas.

The 2014 Winter Olympics was held from February 7 to 23, 2014, in Sochi, Krasnodar Krai, Russia. lows: "If you don't want to do that, then you can approve a different program. And what kind, you'll see. You'll see at 4 am, 22 February. I would have liked for 2022 to be a peaceful year. But I prefer the truth – I've spoken the truth for 75 years. This will not be a peaceful year. It will be a year in which Russia once again becomes a great power. Everyone will have to shut up and respect our country. The alternative is they shut us up and begin to exterminate Russians – in the Donbass at first, and then in Western Russia.

So, in this regard, so let's support this new direction in Russia's foreign policy." So, you can see that Russia told us back in December that they were going to invade the Donbass on February 22, 2022.

So, if Russia invaded Ukraine on February 22nd and Vladimir Volfovich Zhirinovsky said that there would be a war with NATO, why would we think that their ultimate goal would not be to invade countries in Europe which are members of NATO?

Anyone who looks at this situation and does not see an invasion of NATO and the involvement of the United States in a war with Russia must not wish to accept the facts. The United States of America has become an isolationist nation much like it was before World War II. But, we are on the verge of being awakened to the fact that we must rise up to deter aggression before we are forced to speak another language and accept a dictatorship and lose our freedoms.

I do not wish to be negative and viewed as a war monger, but I believe we need to see the handwriting on the wall. Currently we are concerned about the price of gasoline and the increase in food prices. There is much more which we should be concerned.



The Livingston County Board of Supervisors recently resolved to partner with Empire Access, a local internet service provider, in jointly applying to Round 3 of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Rural Utilities Service Rural eConnectivity (ReConnect) Program.

The \$1.15 billion ReConnect Program offers loans and grants to facilitate broadband deployment in areas of rural America that do not have sufficient access to broadband. If funding is awarded, the public-private partnership will bring the County closer to realizing the goals of the 'Light Up Livingston' initiative, which aims to offer high-speed, fiber-optic internet access to every address in the County.

"During Round 2 of the ReConnect Program, our public-private partnership with Empire Access was successful in securing \$11.3 million in grant funds. We want this momentum to continue with another successful ReConnect award in Round 3," stated Livingston County Administrator Ian M. Coyle. "Universal broadband access will foster economic development and increase the quality of life for residents throughout Livingston County."

A County-commissioned survey and study in 2019 designed to collect data on current broadband services in Livingston County determined: 41% of residents lack sufficient internet access, 90% of respondents consider broadband internet to be a vital public infrastructure, and 79% stated that government should play a role in financing high-speed internet development.




