SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speak Out",

The title of this week's article is "Russia in the Bible". The Bible contains 31,121 verses, and of this total, 8,352 verses, or 26.8%, of the Bible contains Bible prophesy.

So, as we see Russia committing all these war crimes against innocent civilians, and seemingly not being punished by other countries of the world, we ask why no-one is helping Ukraine.

This was prophesized in the Bible that nations would not come to the aid of their fellow nations and that God would intervene. He will destroy Russia and all the armies of these other countries and do a much better and more thorough job than we humans could ever do.






