



### **UNA Impact** \$340 Million

FLORENCE - The economic impact to the Shoals from the University of North Alabama is more than \$340 million annually, based on a recent and in-depth analysis of Colbert and Lauderdale counties for 2021. The data is part of a study performed by two UNÁ professors, Dr. **Doug** Barrett, of the Institute for Innovation and Economic Development, and Dr. Keith Malone, a professor in the Department of Finance, Economics, and Data Analytics in the College of Business and Technology.

The report was designed to determine the economic impact of the University on the Shoals and in a range of areas. These include generated earnings, spending, taxes, and employment in the Shoals that results from University operations.

Barnett noted that the following general estimates were conservative:

- \$443.55 million Total earnings in Colbert and Lauderdale counties as a result of the University in
- 1,667 Total jobs created as a result of the University in Colbert and Lauderdale counties in
- \$4,818,510 Total local taxes collected in Colbert and Lauderdale counties in 2021 as a direct result of the university.

"UNA's economic impact upon the Shoals community, particularly the City of Florence, is profound and expanding," said Dr. **Ross Alexander**, Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs. "Not only is UNA a first-choice university for all types of students, it is a first-choice institution for faculty and staff relocating to the Shoals to forge successful



Will Bankruptcy Effect My **Employment?**

So, it is clear that your employer may not fire you or discriminate against you in any way just because you filed bankruptcy. ## **Pay Attention To Straight Line Winds**

How to stay safe from these winds that can severely damage homes, landscapes and people.

Severe thunderstorms can create straight line winds in excess of 58 mph. These winds can pack a major punch, uprooting trees and knocking down power lines. Learn more about damaging straight line winds and how to stav safe.



#### What are straight line winds?

Straight line winds can come in many forms. Two common types are:

- **Downburst:** A strong downward current that bursts outward on or near the ground. Wind speeds can exceed 165 mph.
- Derecho: A system of merged thunderstorms up to 65 miles wide that travels in a straight line, causing wind damage across an area of at least 240 miles. Wind speeds can top 100 mph.

Straight line winds can cause the same level of damage as tornadoes, but they lack the atmospheric rotation to form a funnel. The aftermath will show the difference: If downed trees and other kinds of debris are in parallel rows, that signifies straight line winds. Tornado damage is more sporadic.

#### How to stay safe from straight line winds

Straight line wind safety resembles tornado safety. Keep these tips in mind the next time your area has a severe thunderstorm warning:

- Find shelter immediately or crouch down in the lowest spot you can find.
- Bring in or secure anything that's loose outside, such as lawn furniture, toys and bicycles.
- Stay away from trees and power lines.
- Go to the lowest level of your home and stay away from windows.
- If you're driving, pull over to a safe area with your vehicle in the direction of the wind.







Writer's Note: This 20th Anniversary reprint was first published on March 31, 2004. In difficult times, it is still my hope that we will have someone's hand to hold.

"Hold hands when you cross the street,' she reminded me and my aunt Bena, who is one year less five days older than me. We were raised like sisters. Ros, my oldest sister, was leaving us with a treacherous day ahead in I.C.U. "Hold hands when you cross the street," she had said. My eyes flooded with tears. I didn't expect to cry, but when Ros held us, the tears came.

A flood of memories, happy and sad, was wrapped up in that one line of instruction. In my tears, I could see being nine again. I remember holding Bena's hand, as we would run away from pursuing siblings. remember holding hands and running after we had gotten into mischief. Ponytails, black patent leather shoes, "Ruth Original" dresses, short white Sunday gloves also came to mind. Some Sunday afternoons, we were allowed to walk home from church, even though we were nine and ten. However, because we had to cross busy, Sixth Avenue, the last instruction would always be, "Hold hands when you cross the street."

Holding hands. I also recalled many times in our childhood when my big sister had held my hand. In the darkness of our bedroom, Ros would hold me and tell me that everything would be all right - even though fussing, cussing, and chaos were going on in our living room. My daddy's drinking was the culprit.

Protection. Holding other. This each particular day, my sister couldn't go to I.C.U, she had to get back to work. Bena's husband was in critical condition and facing risky surgical procedures. When Ros took our hands and put them together, her words overwhelmed me, but I was not fearful. I knew that I could help my aunt get through it. I have had lots of examples and training in holding on.

Problems and play create the bond and security in families. Teach the children to support each other. In the long run, they will need each other.

That day in I.C.U., there was a moment of trepidation. As we walked the corridor, I took Bena's hand. She smiled and looked at me with remembrance and assurance. She patted my hand and slowly and reflectively said, "That's right – that's right. Hold hands when you cross the street."



## **Medicare Minute**

## "Physician Charges"

Anyone who is on Medicare has the option of signing up for prescription drug coverage. This is also known as Medicare Part D. Some people with limited income and resources may be able to get "Extra Help" with the costs related to their Medicare prescription drug plan. This includes help with monthly premiums, annual deductibles and prescription co-payments.

To qualify for "Extra Help" your annual income must not exceed \$20.385 for an individual or \$27,465 for a married couple living together. Some of the things that count as income are: Social Security benefits, Railroad Retirement benefits, Veterans benefits, pensions or annuities and any wages you are earning from a job or self-employment.

You also must not exceed the resource limit to qualify for "Extra Help". Resources would include: bank accounts (including checking, savings and CDs), stocks, bonds, mutual funds, IRAs or any other investments. Cash and any real estate other than your home also counts. The amount of your resources must not exceed \$15,510 for an individual or \$30,950 for a married couple. The amounts listed for both the income and resource limits are for 2020.

Social Security has estimated that "Extra Help" is worth about \$5,000 per year for those who qualify. We meet with many people each year who qualify for this benefit and don't even know it. To find out if you qualify for "Extra Help" you can call or visit your local Social Security office, apply online at www.socialsecurity.gov or you can call or visit our office and we'll be glad to help. Regardless of the way you choose to apply, you will need your income and resource information available.





### How to Choose a Medicare Advantage Plan

I will be 65 and eligible for Medicare in a few months and am interested in getting a Medicare Advantage plan to cover my health care and medications. What tips can you provide to help me pick a plan?

Ready to Retire

Dear Ready,

Medicare Advantage plans have become very popular among retirees over the past 15 years, as nearly half of all new Medicare enrollees are signing up for Advantage plans, which accounts for about 42 percent of the entire Medicare market. Here are some tips and tools to help you pick a plan

that fits your needs.

First, let's start with a quick review. Medicare Advantage plans (also known as Medicare Part C) are government approved health plans sold by private insurance companies that you can choose in place of original Medicare. The vast majority of Advantage plans are managed-care policies such as HMOs or PPOs that require you to get your care within a network of doctors.

If you join an Advantage plan, the plan will provide all of your Part A (hospital insurance) and Part B (medical insurance) coverage like original Medicare does. But many plans also offer extra benefits like dental, hearing and vision coverage along with gym/fitness memberships, and most plans include prescription drug coverage too.

Medicare Advantage plans are also cheaper than if you got original Medicare, plus a separate Part D drug plan and a Medigap policy. Many Advantage plans have \$0 or low monthly premiums and don't always have a deductible, but they also typically have a high out-of-pocket maximum. In 2021, Advantage plan participants on average were responsible for a maximum of around \$5,100 for in-network care, and about \$9,200 when out-of-network care is included.

**How to Choose** 

To help you pick a plan, a good first step is to call the office managers of the doctors you use and find out which Advantage plans they accept, and which ones they recommend. Then go to the Medicare Plan Finder tool at // Medicare.gov/plan-compare to compare Advantage plans in your area. This tool provides a five-star rating system that evaluates each plan based on past customer satisfaction and quality of care the plan delivers. When comparing, here are some key points to consider:

Total costs: Look at the plan's entire pricing package, not just the premiums and deductibles. Compare the maximum out-of-pocket costs plus the copays and coinsurance charged for doctor office visits, hospital stays, visits to specialists, prescription drugs and other medical services. This is important because if you choose an Advantage plan, you're not allowed to purchase a Medigap policy, which means you'll be responsible for paying these expenses out of your

**Drug coverage:** Check the plan's formulary – the list of prescription drugs covered – to be sure all the medications you take are covered without excessive co-pays or requirements

that you try less expensive drugs first.

Dental, vision and hearing: Many Advantage plans ome with dental, vision and hearing benefits, but are usually limited. Get the details on what exactly is covered.

Coverage away from home: Most Advantage plans limit you to using in-network doctors only within a service area or geographic region, so find out what's covered if you need medical care when you're away from home.

Out-of-network coverage: Check to see what's covered if you want to see a specialist in a hospital that is not in a plan's network. You can get a list of doctors and hospitals that take part in a plan on the plan's website.

## **Bankruptcy Fundamentals**

There are different types of bankruptcy and each is designed to achieve a different purpose. The one most people think of is an individual "straight bankruptcy" known as a Chapter 7.

Frequently people ask if it will ruin their credit. Usually by the time a person is considering bankruptcy, their credit is already shot. If they have a judgment against them, or are being sued or garnished, bankruptcy will improve their financial situation. People can usually keep and pay for their house and cars, especially if they

are current on their payments.

In Alabama (and it differs from state to state) people who file are entitled to keep \$7,750 in personal property - cars, furniture, clothing. Tools of (your) trade are exempt as are certain pension plans and workers

An individual home owner may keep the first \$15,500 in home equity while a married couple may keep \$31,000 in equity.

Generally all debts are discharged - no longer owed - with some exceptions such as alimony, child support, student loans, and criminal restitution.

There are income limits per family to be able to file a Chapter 7.

There is a functional and well thought out type of bankruptcy for businesses that find themselves in trouble. These are known as Chapter 11 plans and are generally done by lawyers who are familiar with them. This is a pretty specialized area of the law.

Chapter 13 bankruptcy allows a debtor to repay certain debts, including the cost of bankruptcy over a period of time, generally 60 months.

This type of plan is known as a "wage earners plan." These plans allow more flexibility in how certain debts are kept and repaid. Lawyers who practice Chapter 13 bankruptcy do a lot of work in formulating and managing these plans.




