Community Concert Bands returning to Estherville's VFW

The March of the Belgian Paratroopers, by Pierre Leemans, will very possibly be one of the selections heard on Monday night, April 18th, when musicians from a 50 mile radius gather in Estherville's VFW hall for the Spring Concert of the Northwest Iowa Concert Band and Northwest Iowa Jazz Band, directed by Rich Nicklay and Scott Benjamin, respectively.




Stagerat Stan told us he heard rumblings at rehearsals that Howard Hanson's Chorale and Alleluia would be the likely opening selection for the concert band. Written in 1954, it is a standard of many advanced high school and college

RAMBO-ling

Another probable selection, The Liberty Bell March, was initially an untitled composition written for John Philip Sousa's unfinished operetta, The Devil's Deputy. While

attending the 1893 *Columbian Exposition* in Chicago, Sousa and his band manager watched the spectacle America, in which a backdrop depicting the *Liberty Bell* was lowered, and it was suggested that The Liberty Bell should become the title of Sousa's unnamed march. Coincidentally, Sousa received a letter from his wife saying their son had marched in a parade in honor of the Liberty Bell. Sousa agreed with the suggestion, The *Liberty Bell* sheet music was published by the John Church Company, and became an immediate success..

It wouldn't be much of a Northwest Iowa Concert Band concert without a circus tune. To make that happen, the concert band has been rehearsing American Big Top; by Brian Balmages. The tune can best be described as "An American circus march that meets Charles Ives." It is largely based on original material



without necessarily being categorized as a full-on patriotic work... Stan was less knowledgeable about the selections that he notes as "just probably" on Scott Benjamin's list for the second part of the concert. Between bites of Blue Cheese, Stan mentioned John LaBarbera's Tiger of San Pedro, as an opener; with follow-up tunes to likely include Metropole, by Howard Rowe; Tomorrow's Memories, by Paul Clark, and maybe even Neal Hefti's Li'l Darlin' as a swingin' closer! The concerts begin at 7:30 on the 18th (or 25th, if necessary)...

Some of you know the Old Professor has two "children" who have done very well on their own for several years. (Both are now well into their 40s.) Darling daughter has read road maps to give driving directions since she was in first grade. And after getting to know Iowa's main highways well once she got her driver's license, usually tried the back roads to criss-cross the state. On the other hand, son Scott still sweats at even the thought of reading a paper map for directions. Either way, Internet guides make life much easier for all of us. We mention this as research director RD has come up with today being Read a Road Map Day -- and she has attached a song to go with it (Is that any surprise?) That song is On the Street Where You Live, written by Alan J. Lerner and Frederick Loewe, for My Fair Lady, which premiered on Broadway in 1956, and on the big screen eight years later, in 1964. There are more than 300 different recordings of the song by almost that many different artists, including Vic Damone (1956), Nat 'King' Cole, and Harry Connick, on his 1992 album...

Composer conductor Percy Faith was born on April 7, 1908. Most everyone is probably familiar with his easy listening hits, Delicado, (1952), The Song From Moulin Rouge (1953), and Theme From a Summer Place (1959). If you are really knowledgeable you might even know that Percy Faith composed the theme for the NBC television series, *The Virginian*, starring James Drury and Doug McClure... (You say you don't read the closing credits?)

Saturday has just one possible song to go with Name Yourself Day. We think RD's selection of *I'm Henry the 8th I Am*, (which was written by Fred Murray and R. P. Weston in 1910) came as the result of her being a huge fan of Herman's Bermits, the group that popularized the song 55 years later, when it became the second number one hit for the *Hermits* and also one of the shortest-ever songs to top the charts, as it is not even two minutes long! *The Hermits* have performed the song not only on records, but on television shows including, Hullabaloo, The Ed Sullivan Show, and The Jimmy Dean Show, as well as The Clay County Fair, where she has seen them at least twice. RD has a very natural bias for good performances...

Those Council persons and local residents opposing the change have offered the compromise of requesting an IOWA DOT traffic survey and accepting their recommendations. This is provided at no cost to the City by the DOT. Not given any weight by those forcing the change. No consideration was given to petitions signed by 129 residents pleading for leaving the speed limits as they are.





March Madness Musings

Wow, what a crazy NCAA Tournament 2022 brought us as we returned to "normal" this year with fans in the stands and games back out of the bubble in Indianapolis. As is usual with March Madness, however, we know that nothing is "normal", and this year's tournament has definitely lived up to the Madness Mantra.

Locally we saw Iowa State make a magical run to the Sweet 16 that saw them win as many NCAA Tournament games this year as they won total games last season. We witnessed Iowa get upset by 12-seed Richmond in the first round in a game that ESPN.com ranked #4 on their Heartbreak Index of all the losses heading into Monday's Championship Game. Iowa was hot coming into the tournament, fresh off a B1G Tournament Championship, and many "experts" picked them to make a run at the Final 4, but the Spiders would put an early end to that hype. South Dakota State was a 13-seed and many people had them predicted to upset 4-seed Providence in the first round, but the Jackrabbits were never able to get their high-powered offense going and would fall 66-57 to the Friars.

Nationally we saw a plethora of upsets, led by everyone's Cinderella, 15-seed St. Peter's making a memorable run to the Elite 8 before falling to Championship Game participant North Carolina. The Peacocks upset Kentucky, Murray State and Purdue on their magical run that ended just short of the Final Four. We saw four double-digit seeds advance to the Sweet 16 with two of them advancing to the Elite 8. We also witnessed just one 1-seed advance to the Elite 8 in Kansas, had the Jayhawks not made the Final 4 it would have been the first Final 4 without at least one 1-seed. In the end, even with all the Madness, we still ended up with four Blue Bloods making the Final 4 in Duke, Kansas, North Carolina and Villanova. This would be the first Final 4 in history that all four participants had won multiple National Championships. Saturday's main event, Duke vs. North Carolina lived up to the hype that rivalry deserves. Both teams left everything on the court in a back-and-forth game that saw the Tarheels end the coaching career of legendary coach Mike Krzyzewski with a thrilling 81-77 victory. It's crazy this was the first time these two rivals had met in the NCAA Tournament, and what is even more unbelievable is that Coack K will now end his career with a 50-50 mark against the rival Tarheels. The first game of the night saw Kansas control Villanova from start to finish in their 81-65 victory. The Jayhawks looked very deserving of their 1-seed as they dominated the paint with their big men and controlled the perimeter with their long and athletic guards.

We go to press before the National Champion is crowned so this prediction will be outdated by the time you are reading, it but you can either call me a fool or a genius as you read my prediction. Obviously both teams are firing on all cylinders to make it this far, as North Carolina continues their hot play as an underdog 8-seed (hard to ever call UNC an underdog); while Kansas has kept up their strong play that saw them win Big 12 regular season and Conference Tournament titles. I believe the Jayhawks will be able to match UNC down low with their duo of post players batting UNC's Armando Bacot; while the Tarheels will have a hard time containing KU's Ochai Agbaji and Remi Martin on the perimeter as the Jayhawks will win one of the most entertaining Finals we've witnessed, 89-85. It's sad to see this year's NCAA Tournament end as it once again reminded us why March Madness is truly one of the greatest sporting events in the world!

Our business will deliver to your home or workplace, a weekly CSA share/box of locally grown produce for up to 20 weeks, starting in May and ending in October.

The following are the CSA share choices:

- CSA Mini Share: includes one monthly delivered box of locally grown produce starting in May - October which is a total of 6 times/boxes for the 2022 growing season. A CSA mini share is for a household of 1 to 2 adults/family.
- CSA Bi-Weekly Share: which is delivered every other week for a total of 10 boxes of locally grown produce
- CSA Half Share: includes a weekly delivered box of locally grown produce starting in May - October for a minimum of 17 weeks to a maximum of 20 weeks. A CSA half share is for a household of 1 to 2 adults/family.

CSA Full Share: includes a weekly delivered box of locally

grown produce starting in May - October for a minimum of 17 weeks to a maximum of 20 weeks. A CSA full share is for a household of 3 to 4 adults/family. We intend to deliver 20 weeks/times for your enjoyment of our

boxed produce half or full share but wish to have an understanding that our growing season can be unpredictable and have included the 17 week minimum. Deadline to purchase a CSA share is May 1, 2022.

The following fruits and vegetables will be available sometime during the 2022 growing season in the CSA box share: apples, asparagus, beansgreen, beets-red or golden, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage-green or red, carrots, cauliflower, celery, chard, cucumbers-slicers-burpless-pickling, eggplant, *garlic, kale, kohlrabi, lettuce-leaf green-red-romaine, onions-red-yellow-white, peas-sugar snap, peppers-sweet bell-hot, pie pumpkins, potatoes-red-white-Yukon, rhubarb, radishes, *raspberries, rutabagas, scallions, shallots, summer squash-yellow, sweet corn, tomatoes, winter squash- 10 varieties, and zucchini.
