

2. Transportation

3. 2022 Capital Reserve Fund Creation

RESOLVED, that in accordance with Education Law section 3651, the Board of Education of the Kendall Central School District is hereby authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund, to be designated "2022 Capital Reserve Fund," to defray the cost of construction and reconstruction of School District buildings, facilities and grounds, including original equipment, machinery, apparatus, appurtenances, furnishings, and other incidental improvements and expenses in connection therewith, in an ultimate amount not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) plus accrued interest and other investment earnings. 4. To elect one (1) member to the Board of Education for a term of five years commencing

July 1, 2022 and expiring June 30, 2027.

WEDDING DAY tipping guidelines

Vendors may be in the background during a wedding, but the roles they play are vital to making ceremonies and receptions memorable for couples and their guests. It's customary to tip wedding vendors who provide great service. The wedding experts at The Knot note that the following guidelines can help couples determine how much to tip the unsung heroes who make their weddings so memorable.

Photographer/videographer:

Photographers and videographers are unique among wedding vendors because their work will be looked at for decades to come. The

Knot notes that it's not necessary to tip wedding photographers and videographers who own their own studios. Their fees are all the compensation they need. However, many photographers and videographers do not own their own studios, and the efforts of such professionals are worthy of a little something extra at the end of the night. The Knot notes that a tip between \$50 and \$200 is standard for these professionals, and that tip can be given at the end of the reception.

Reception staff:

The reception staff works as hard as anyone during the wedding, and those efforts merit a good tip. Many reception venues include gratuities in their food and drink fees, and couples can check to see if they have already tipped staff and if they think the mandatory gratuity is sufficient. A tip between 15 and 20 percent of the food and drink fee is standard. Maître d' fees also may be built into the wedding contract. If not, a tip between \$200 and \$300 is standard and can be delivered at the end of the night.

Band/DJ:

Music features prominently at many wedding receptions. Bands and/or DJs can set the tone for a fun night couples and their guests will remember for years to come. Tipping musicians is optional, but it's the norm to do so when they provide exceptional service. Couples who have a band playing can tip between \$25 and \$35 per musician, while DJs generally receive a tip between \$50 and \$150.



Drivers:

Many transportation firms also include gratuities in their contracts, so couples should check to see if they've already tipped limo or bus drivers before paying them a little extra. If the tip is not included and the drivers arrive on time and get guests to the wedding on time, then a tip that's between 15 and 20 percent of the total bill is standard.

Delivery personnel:

Individuals who deliver items like cakes and flowers are typically given a gratuity upon delivery. A tip between \$5 and \$10 per person is standard, though individuals who deliver items like tables, chairs and portable restroom facilities and then set those items up may be deserving of a little extra.

Officiants:

Officiants who are affiliated with a church or synagogue where the ceremony will take place are not typically given a gratuity. However, The Knot notes that a donation to the place of worship between \$100 and \$500 is standard. Couples who still want to give the officiant a little extra can tip between \$50 and \$100. Independent officiants who receive fees directly from the couple need not be tipped.

These figures can serve as guidelines, but couples also can give a little extra if they feel their vendors have gone above and beyond.

Travel Thoughts By Kim

Let's go on an adventure together....to Lancaster, PA!

Early morning on Monday, March 28th, I got on a bus with a friend to join the Busy Buddies and Eastern Star groups for a two day trip to Lancaster, PA to attend the production of "*David*" at the Sight and Sound Theater in Lancaster. We returned late Tuesday evening – the 29th. It was a really nice trip. This was my third time attending a performance at Sight and Sound via group bus tours. It would have

been my fourth trip, but plans to see "Queen Esther" was canceled due to COVID.

I used to think I wouldn't enjoy being on a bus so long – especially a full bus, like this trip was. But, I've been on several, now – some day trips, a few overnighters, and even an 8-day trip....and, I'm planning a 7-day bus trip a bit later this year. I've come to enjoy them and they are a lot more comfortable than you'd think. It's a great way to go adventuring without the stress of driving or the expense of flying. It most always also means it is a group trip, so comes with group rates. I don't hesitate traveling by bus – especially when going with friends.

The current location of the Sight and Sound in Lancaster is a 2000 seat family-owned theater that opened in 1998 and brings the bible to life through amazing and emotional productions. While it does seat 2000 people, the way it is set up makes it feel surprisingly small and intimate and there truly are no "bad" seats. The productions are a mix of live performance, animatronics, special effects, and lighting that surrounds the audience. The main part of the production is on the stage to the front of the theater. The actors also enter from the wings and up the aisles from the back of the theater, and there are projected images and some live actors on the side walls, as well. The audience truly feels like they are a part of the performance - part of the crowds - part of the action. AND — they use live animals that appear both on stage and in the aisles — if someone is doing something that requires them to ride in on a horse they ride in on a horse. Shepherds tend REAL sheep. Flocks of doves fly overhead. It is truly amazing!!! The announcer provided some instructions before the show started - he said that there will be live animals and actors in the aisles, so cautioned the audience to stay seated and said "we don't want you to be swept away by a flock of sheep".....my thought was "why not - I think I'd enjoy that"!!! hahahaha

On this trip, the show we saw was "**David**" and it was incredible. I loved how they took the Psalms

that David wrote and put them to original music to give an emotional spin to their messages. I must admit, I didn't think I knew much about David, so the show reminded me of parts I didn't realize I knew and taught me so much more. David was a master poet and musician – he wrote the Psalms. He was a fearless warrior – he slayed Goliath and lead armies into battle to take back the holy land. He was anointed King and favored by God. He also had a dark side and did some things that he, himself, was not proud of and struggled to seek forgiveness for his sins. From the brochure: "Today, as you prepare to see giants fall and the Psalms come to life, it is our hope that one message resounds from the stage: throughout our victories and defeats, God is with us, always."

These group trips include the bus, hotel, the show, meals, and usually extra stops for shopping or sight-seeing, depending on the itinerary. This trip was no different. Check out the blog link below for all the details of what we did on this trip and some highlights from my other two trips. The other shows I've seen at Sight and Sound were "*Moses*" and "*Jesus*" – both were spectacular and had specific scenes that took my breath away and overwhelmed me with emotion. I can't wait to see another show there. There is also a Sight and Sound location in Branson, MO – maybe I'll

catch one of their productions out there – Branson is on my bucket list. And...they typically do a different show at both locations, so you could do two shows each year, if you really wanted to....hhhmmm....just thought of that and will keep it in mind! hahaha





- 1. Peel and dice potatoes and onions. Put them and a teaspoon of salt in a pressure cooker and cover with an inch of water. Close valve. Set pressure cooker to high pressure. Set timer for 5 minutes, cook and quick release when it's done. Drain potatoes. Cool until just warm. (If you don't have a pressure cooker, boil potatoes in a pot of water on the stove until tender.)
- 2. Set eggs on a rack in the pressure cooker. Add 1/2 inch of water. Close valve, set to high pressure for 5 minutes. Cook for 5 minutes, quick release, and leave lid closed for 5 minutes. After 5 minutes, take lid off. Drain eggs and cover with ice water to stop the cooking process. Let sit in ice water bath for about 5 minutes, then peel eggs. (If you don't have a pressure cooker, hard-boil eggs according to your favorite recipe.)
- 3. Add Greek yogurt, sour cream, mustard, vinegar, salt, pepper, celery seed, and dill weed to a large mixing bowl. Stir until smooth. You can taste test to see if you need to add ingredients.
- 4. Add cooled, diced potatoes, pickles and hard-boiled eggs. Gently stir until potatoes are coated with dressing. Adjust seasonings to taste. Refrigerate for at least 1 hour.

Notes: Yukon Gold or red potatoes hold their shape best in potato salad. White distilled vinegar is classic in potato salad, but you also can use cider vinegar, white wine vinegar or even lemon juice.
