

April 10, 2022, is Palm Sunday this year. April 6, 32 A. D. was the original Palm Sunday on which our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ rode into Jerusalem on a donkey.

Because there was no year 0, and Jesus Christ was thirtythree years old when He rode into Jerusalem, He was most likely born about 1 B. C.

You will probably ask how I arrived upon that information. If the Jewish Rabbis and historians took time to calculate the prophesies in the Old Testament, they would have been able to arrive at this exact date and would have realized that the young Jewish Rabbi named Jesus fulfilled all those prophesies.

The Prophet Daniel was reading the scrolls of the Prophet Jeremiah 29:4 KJV "Thus saith the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon". God's Word continues in Jeremiah 29:10 KJV "For thus saith the Lord, That after seventy years be accomplished at Babylon I will visit you, and perform my good word toward you, in causing you to return to this place."

The Bible continues in Nehemiah 2:1 KJV "And it came to pass in the month Nisan, in the twentieth year of Artaxerxes the king..." The precise start of Daniel's 70 weeks in Daniel 9:24-26 KJV tells when the period of 490 years started: "Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Know therefore and understand, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined." We know exactly when this occurred - the date is set in history. On 1st Nisan 445 B. C. Artaxerxes gave the decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem.

This is a known date. So, Daniel's seventy weeks (490 years) started on 1st Nisan 445 B. C. The 70 Weeks of Daniel prove that Jesus is the Messiah. There are 483 years x 360 days which computes to the total number of days in this prophecy to be 173,880 days.

From 445 B. C. to 397 B. C. is 49 years in which God stopped speaking through the last Old Testament writer Malachi and was silent for the next 400 years until the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

So, now we know that the first Palm Sunday was April 6, 32 A. D. Most Christians and historians tell us that God does not tell us when many happenings occur. But, to the contrary, God does not want us to be ignorant of the future but reserves many exact dates which we do not need to know. I pray that you will experience a wonderful blessed Holy week. I know that there are many very qualified ministers out there who can more fully illuminate God's truths to each of us and I would so love to hear from them.

Lord willing, I will see you next week.
