sota is just four weeks away. While parts of the Mississippi River, smaller rivers and creeks have opened, lakes remain stubbornly iced over in mid-April.

"When ice out is late, the water remains cold and everything is delayed — spawning of fish etc.," said Rick Bruesewitz, Aitkin area DNR fishing supervisor. "Warmer water tends to lead to better fishing."

He said things could change in a hurry, if we get some 80 or even 90-degree days as we did last May. "We don't know what the panfish bite will be because, despite the cold water, crappies come into shore for feeding before spawning season." Walleye in Aitkin County

While Mille Lacs Lake is its own regulation entity, some lakes in Aitkin County do have special walleye regulations.

Farm Island and Big Sandy Lake have slot limits for walleye and on Lake Minnewawa, the walleye limit is reduced to three rather than the statewide usual six fish. **Sunfish Initiative**

unfish Initiativ

To improve the quality of sunfish angling, a five-fish limit was put on Big Sandy and its tributaries, with a 10 fish limit set for Minnewawa, Horseshoe, Rat, VanDuse, Waukenabo, Gun and Clear lakes in Aitkin County.

The crappie limit is at 10 with no special regulations.

Trout has a limit of five with no more than two longer than 16 inches. Northern Pike is a 10-fish limit with no fish kept between 22-26 inches and up to two fish over 26 inches.

Bass season will open later. Bruesewitz said he will be out on the water on opening weekend — but just where he will be and what he is seeking remain his secret.





READER RIBBETS **Rep. Dale Lueck legislative update**

In response to the increased outbreak of avian influenza within Minnesota's poultry industry, we authorized an additional \$1 million in emergency funding for the Department of Agriculture and the Board of Animal Health to cover costs associated with dealing with the outbreak.

The disease is endemic to wild birds and is spread to domestic poultry flocks during the annual spring migration north. The last serious problem in Minnesota was in 2015. Nine million birds in Minnesota were either were killed outright by avian flu or had to be euthanized.

The disease is rapidly expanding. At the time of the emergency funding authorization, it has reached 11 counties, involving 21 flocks, totaling over a million birds. The disease impacts domestic poultry and wild birds. It does not represent a human health issue. The eggs and poultry products we purchase in the grocery store remain safe to

consume.

April 8 marks the legislative session deadline for House and Senate committees to complete work on major policy bills and supplemental budget appropriations. The focus will now shift to final passage of the bills on the floor of both bodies where they will be subject to final amendments. If there are differences in the bills from the two chambers, the bills will then go to conference committees to be reconciled.

There are major differences in the House and Senate's approach on public safety issues. The Senate is advancing a number of common-sense public safety initiatives and carefully targeted spending to make our communities safer

amid the current historic spike in violent crime.

In the House, Republicans have put forward similar legislation aimed at reversing the dramatic increase in crime by holding criminals responsible for their actions, helping recruit and retain peace officers, and providing transparency on prosecutor's charging decisions and the court's bail and sentencing decisions.

The House Public Safety Committee decided not to allow hearings on those bills. The House majority is focused on solutions with something called "violence-interrupters," and significantly growing the state government bureaucracy with new full-time employees in St. Paul. The stark difference in approach will be worked out over the remaining 6 weeks of session. The Minnesota Constitution requires the legislature to adjourn no later than May 23rd. Please be safe!

Untold story of Aitkin Public Schools

As we begin the 4th and final quarter of the 2021-2022 school year, I have been doing some reflecting on Aitkin Public Schools and how well we provide a quality education for our students. I am not normally someone who will bet the house on standardized test scores. However, it is a mark that is used statewide to make comparisons, and it creates ongoing discussions not only about how well schools in general are doing but how well our school is doing specifically.

Last week, I looked at our data that is available on the Minnesota Department of Education website under MN school report cards. Using this data, I made comparisons between Aitkin and eight area schools: Crosby/Ironton, Brainerd, Pequot Lakes, Pine River-Backus, McGregor, Hill City, Isle, Onamia and Northland Schools.

Here is what I was able to gather in reviewing our Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA's) test results from 2021 compared to the 8 surrounding districts:

In mathematics Aitkin Schools ranked #1,

In reading Aitkin Schools ranked #3, and

In science Aitkin Schools ranked #5

MDE also collected a variety of other data points as well and out of the 9 area schools:

Aitkin Schools ranked #1 with a 95.2% attendance rate,

Aitkin Schools ranked #2 with 92% of students feeling their teachers and staff were caring, and

In 2020, Aitkin Schools ranked #2 with a 91.8% graduation rate.

What does this data show us about Aitkin Public Schools?

It shows that we have a staff that cares about our students, that our students want to be in school, that our students test scores are very strong, and that our students graduate at higher than state average and higher than all but one of the eight area schools. We have also gained in the number of students who open enroll to our district. In 2020 we had a net gain of just over 19 students choosing to come to Aitkin Schools instead of enroll in their home district. That number was 2 in 2017. We have had a net gain of 17 open enrolled students since 2017.

We as a school do not do it ourselves. We have outstanding communities that believe in and support our students and our school programs. We cannot thank you enough for that continued support. Due to the work our students and staff do and the support of our families and community, we will continue to provide a quality education for our communities.

We are doing a good work, but we are not done!

Yes, we can do better! Yes, we will do better! We are ISD #1!
