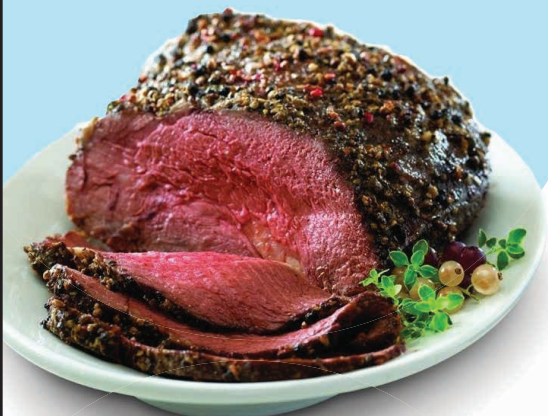

Albion named best community for music education for 15th straight year

Press Release, Albion Central

ALBION - For the 15th
consecutive year, the
National Foundation of
Music Merchants (NAMM)
Foundation has named Albion
Central School District as a
Best Community for Music
Education.

While 738 districts around
the country received the
recognition this year, few
have maintained Albion's
continued success. Albion
was the only school in the
county to earn the award in
2022 and one of just four in the

Genesee, Livingston, Orleans,
Wyoming (GLOW) region, joining LeRoy, Pembroke and
Perry school districts. Lockport and Roy-Hart are the
only districts from Niagara County honored this year.

The award program recognizes outstanding efforts
by teachers, administrators, parents, students and
community leaders who have made music education
part of a well-rounded education.

Albion's music department returned to normalcy
this school year, bringing live music back after Covid-19
precautions lifted. High school students in both band
and chorus performed in the annual Veteran's Day
concert in early November before select seniors
performed during the long-held event, Senior Tea.

November also saw the return to live shows as the
high school cast and crew of Totally Not a Musical took
the stage followed by the middle school's performance
of No Dogs Allowed.

Music set the holiday mood as each school held its
own festive holiday concert throughout December.
Many Albion students traveled to the All-County Music
Festival held at Holley in February before Albion was
honored to host the second All-County Festival at the
beginning of March. All ages joined in song for the all-
district chorus concert, also in early March.

The auditorium was packed full for the spring
musicals. Alice in Wonderland, performed by the middle
school, was a huge success while Shrek the Musical,
presented by the high school, impressed attendees of
all ages.

The district's music departments continued to
connect directly to the community, too. Many current
and former students and staff performed at the annual
Albion High School Alumni Foundation Holiday Concert.
High school band and chorus students brought their
talents to the town as they took part in holiday caroling
the day before winter break, another long-standing
tradition.

Music will remain throughout the school year with
spring chorus and band concerts and marching band
performances coming soon. Community members are
always encouraged to attend.

active participation in music making across the lifespan
by supporting scientific research, philanthropic
giving and public service programs. The organization
represents the generosity and philanthropy of the
music products industry and is funded through

Medina village officials work to bring down tax rate

MEDINA - Village officials are in the throes of work on the 2022-23 village budget. The spending plan needs to be adopted by April 30.

The board held a public hearing on the tentative \$6,368,175 budget on Monday evening. That tentative budget would set the tax levy at \$3,735,640 and the tax rate at \$21.47.

Mayor Mike Sidari said the rate will certainly be under \$20 per \$1,000 of assessed property. The board wants to get the rate to a minimal increase over the \$18.77 in the current 2021-22 budget. That \$6,109,526 budget raised \$3,259,119 through the tax levy.

"We still have budgets to go through," Sidari said during Monday's hearing. "We will work our best to get down to the tax limit."

The board voted Monday to override the tax cap with the budget, but that doesn't mean the board will exceed the cap which for Medina is only about a 1 percent increase.

"We all know expenses are running high," Sidari said. "We don't know what's going on with gas, with tires, with salt. There are several issues affecting our budget. We will try to get it down as low as we can."

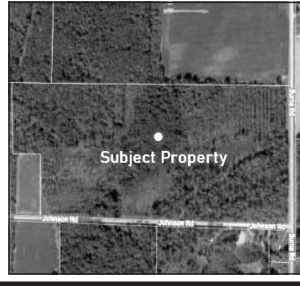

Explaining easements, setbacks & CCRs

Property setbacks as well as easements and conditions, covenants and restrictions (CCRs) must be considered before renovating an existing home or building a new one. Setbacks are mandated buffers between surveyed property lines and permanent structures. Easements are legal designations that enable individuals or entities to use portions of a person's property for physical access or to build on it for one reason or another. Easements may be owned by utility companies for gas lines or government agencies when sidewalks are on a private property. Additional examples of easements include greenbelt conservation easements, beach easements or view easements, according to The Spruce, a home and lifestyle resource. CCRs include rules established by many planned communities, subdivisions and planned unit developments. CCRs, easements and property setbacks can affect which type of renovations are allowed on particular plots and may affect the issuance of permits. It's essential to learn about property easements, CCRs and setbacks in advance and discuss them with contractors when drawing up preliminary plans. Your property deed or plat map as well as the local building inspection offices can highlight any regulations that may be in effect on your property and if they may affect future projects.
