New Lakeland, LTC agreement benefits students

Lakeland University has signed transfer agreements with four Wisconsin technical colleges, including Lakeshore Technical College in Cleveland, to make it easier for students to complete a bachelor's degree.

The agreements were approved by the UW Board of Regents on April 7 and authorize the technical colleges to offer the two-year liberal arts associate of science (AS) and associate of arts (AA) degrees. Lakeland has signed agreements with LTC, Mid-State Technical College in Wisconsin Rapids, Moraine Park Technical College in Fond du Lac and Northeast Wisconsin Technical College in Green Bay.

Under these new agreements students who earn the 60-credit Liberal Arts - Associate of Arts or Liberal Arts - Associate of Science Degrees at one of the participating technical colleges will be able to transfer to Lakeland with Junior standing and apply all their credits to a Lakeland bachelor's degree.

The new agreements are the latest chapter in Lakeland's long history of successful partnerships with Wisconsin's technical colleges. Lakeland was among the first four-year colleges in Wisconsin to develop pathways for technical college graduates to complete a bachelor's degree.

"More partnerships are being explored," said Lakeland President Beth Borgen, adding that Lakeland has pledged to serve as the four-year university partner for any WTCS school applying for authorization.

Through special pre-major pathways, technical college graduates will have a wide variety of academic options for their

four-year degree at Lakeland, including Accounting, Analytics, Business Administration, Communication, Computer Science, Criminal Justice, Management Information Systems, Marketing and Psychology.

Graduates of Wisconsin Technica College systems also will receive a 20 percent tuition discount at Lakeland.

"The degrees available through these new agreements enable technical colleges to enhance the educational options they provide to their communities," Borgen said. "By partnering with the technical colleges in this way, we open college options to new populations of students who have the potential and ability to pursue post-secondary education. This new level of access benefits students and their families, local schools and Wisconsin communities."

The new agreements also provide pathways for many students to pursue their bachelor's degrees without leaving the area. Lakeland has centers in Wisconsin Rapids, Green Bay and its main campus in Sheboygan County, as well as many degrees which can be taken completely online or through hybrid platforms.

The new transfer agreements are expected to go into effect in the fall 2022.

"It is exciting to see public and private institutions working together for a common good - helping our students achieve their educational goals while aligning with regional workforce development needs," Borgen said. "We are always interested to partner in innovative ways to serve our students and their communities."

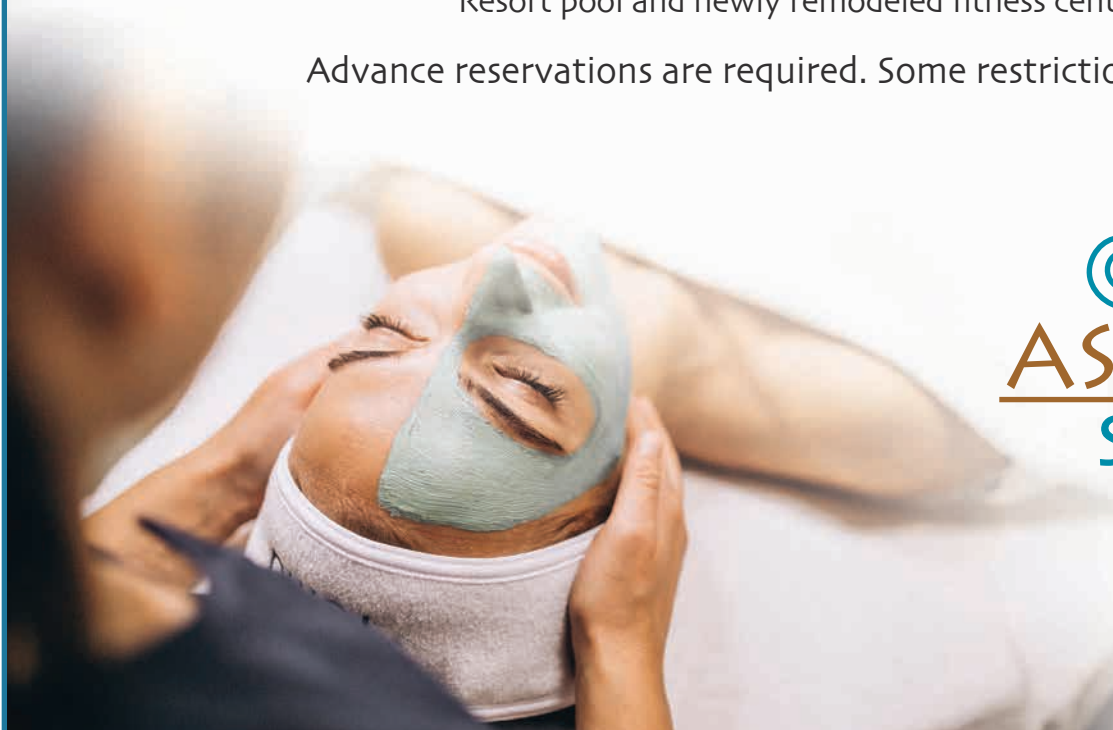

The Baer Burger has been deemed "The best burger this side of the Mississippi". It consists of an 8oz. Black Angus hand pressed patty, Pseudo Sue braised onions, Swiss cheese, candied bacon, and a fried egg on a brioche bun. Hungry yet?

The current operating hours are: Monday 4pm-close, Wednesday-Friday 4pm-close, Saturday-Sunday 11am-close.

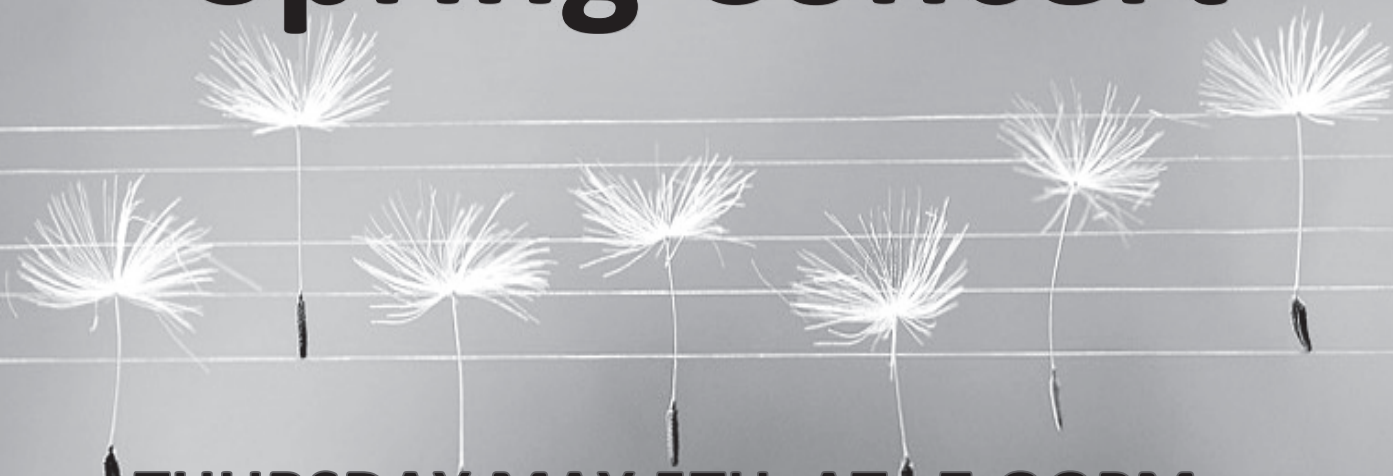

Spring Election

The spring election took place on Tuesday, April 5th. Elkhart Lake voter turnout was 36%.

Ordinance Updates

The Village Board recently updated two ordinances. The first is the shoreland ordinance and the second is the beach pass ordinance.

Shoreland Ordinance

The reason for the shoreline ordinance being amended was the Village needed to make changes so our ordinance would be in compliance due to a court case (Sunflower vs. Oneida County) that was recently decided regulating structures below the ordinary high water mark (Section 17.08).

The key takeaways for the changes are as follows:

1. Confirming that an owner is allowed one pier for the first 50 feet of shoreline and 2 boat slips. An additional boat slip is allowed for every additional 50 feet of shoreland (i.e., 100 feet of shoreland 3 boat slips, 150 feet of shoreland 4 boat slips).
2. In the first 50 feet of shoreline a person may secure up to 2 personal watercraft on the pier and then for each additional 50 feet of shoreline owned the owner can have one additional personal watercraft.
3. All piers require a permit from the Village regardless of DNR guidelines. If the pier meets DNR pier regulations, the Village permit is to ensure the structure does not interfere with the riparian rights of other riparian owners.
4. Existing non-confirming piers may be replaced or repaired as-is. Meaning, no changes to the existing design, size, footprint, or location but you can keep it useable as currently installed. Any changes to the location, size, or configuration will require a Village permit.
5. New piers fall under the DNR guidelines, which is 6 foot in width and 200 square feet for the maximum platform area. Any area created by use of "fingers" is part of the total 200 square feet platform limit. No "fingers" are allowed lakeward of the loading platform.
6. Piers may not interfere with neighboring riparian rights.
7. Rafts must be anchored within 200 feet of the ordinary high-water mark, and they cannot interfere with others' riparian rights, and they cannot interfere with public rights in the waterway such as boating.
8. There are limits to the amount of riprap and to the size of the riprap that can be placed in the lake.
9. There are also is a 2 cubic feet limit to the amount of deposits for an activity or project that is exempt from a permit. This is in totality and not 2 cubic feet every year or every few years.

Beach Ordinance

The Board finds it necessary to provide some clarity to the beach ordinance. Below

are the three sections that were revised.

1. The use of public beaches owned or leased by the Village shall be limited to residents of the Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah Joint School District No. 1 and one guest accompanying each resident. As a prerequisite to the use of public beaches owned or leased by the Village, such residents of the Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah Joint School District No. 1 shall purchase identification tags from the Village Clerk or designee.

4. No person shall grill, barbecue, or have a cookout on the public beaches owned or leased by the Village. Small amounts of food are allowed.

5. No person shall use a pop-up tent, canopy, or table on the public beach.

Beach Pass Information

The Village is reminding people that the Village beach is for residents of the Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah Joint School District only, per Village Ordinance. The police will be monitoring beach use more frequently. The prices of the passes is \$5 for residents and \$40 for school district residents, which are good for an even and odd year (this is the first year of the beach pass). These passes will be available by May 16th. The price of replacement passes is \$25 for Village residents and \$50 for school district residents. Rental properties are to have their guests use Fireman's Park. This is the public access to the lake that should be used for guests. Some of the other regulations include:

- No person shall allow a dog to be on any public beaches owned or leased by the Village.
- No person shall use or possess beverages containing alcohol on the public beaches owned or leased by the Village.
- No person shall ignite nor maintain fires of any kind on the public beaches owned or leased by the Village.

Water/Sewer Bill Late Charges – Beginning May 16th

The Elkhart Lake Water and Sewer Departments will once again begin to apply late charges on past due balances beginning May 16th. Due to COVID, late charges had been suspended, but the Village will once again apply late charges to outstanding balances. If you have an outstanding balance and want to be placed on a payment plan, please contact the Village of Elkhart Lake at 920-876-2122 or by email at clerk@elkhartlakewi.gov.

Arbor Day

The Arbor Day program will be held on April 29, 2022. A tree will be planted in the Village Park, weather permitting, and the poster contest winners for the 5th graders at Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah School will be announced. The public is welcome to attend.

Memorial Day Event May 28th

The annual Memorial Day Tribute Program will begin at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 28th at Memorial Park, which is located on the corner of Highway 67 and Chicago Street. Immediately following the program, the Lions Club will be sponsoring a brat fry, with proceeds to be used for maintenance of the Veteran's Memorial. The featured speaker this year will be Retired Major General Timothy M. Zadalis. He retired from the Air Force in 2017 after nearly 34 years of distinguished service. He lives in the Elkhart Lake with his wife, Carol.

False Alarm Ordinance

A reminder that the Village Board has a false alarm ordinance. Each time the Village of Elkhart Lake Police Department, Fire Department, or First Responders respond to a false alarm arising from an intrusion alarm and/or fire and/or emergency medical alarm, the Village Clerk's Office should be notified to determine what, if any, service charge is applicable.

- A service charge for excessive alarms shall be charged for false alarms in a 12-month period (January-December of the same year) as follows:
 - a. No service charge shall be charged for the first alarm occurring within a calendar year.
 - b. 2nd occurrence shall result in a service fee of \$100
 - c. 3rd occurrence shall result in a service fee of \$175
 - d. 4th occurrence shall result in a service fee of \$200
 - e. 5th and subsequent occurrences shall result in a service fee of \$400 per occurrence.
- There are certain cases when no service fee shall be assessed.

Building Permit Required

If you are planning a construction project on your home or business, you must apply for a building permit. Permits must be obtained prior to commencement of work. We have had a few people looking to install patios and doing some work and then finding out they cannot have one. We want to prevent this from happening. It is best if you call the Clerk's Office at 920-876-2122 to find out if your project will require a permit. Failure to do so will result in double the permit fees, potentially tearing out of what has been done, and could even result in a fine of up to \$1,000.

Household Hazardous Waste

Sheboygan County has established three (potentially four) periodic collection sites for disposing of hazardous wastes. The majority of the program is funded with County tax dollars, so be prepared to show proof of residency. When those funds are depleted, the sites will be closed until funds are again available. The fees are: \$15 – Vehicles with hazardous waste only, \$40 – Vehicles with household size electronics only (for each 6 items), and \$40 – Vehicles with both hazardous waste and household size electronics (for each 6 electronic items). Dog Licenses

Please stop in at the Village Hall to license your dog. The license was due by March 31st, so a late fee will be assessed. You need to provide a proof of rabies vaccination and pay the fee (\$7.00 per spayed or neutered dog and \$14.00 per dog if not spayed or neutered, plus the late fee).

Dog Refuse Stations

The Village has installed Dog Refuse Stations throughout the Village. We have installed two new ones along Victory Lane. These stations will dispense plastic

Vintage Elkhart Lake celebrates 10 years and renovations

Vintage Elkhart Lake Wine Shop and Fine Foods at 100 East Rhine Street is celebrating ten years of business and has some wonderful changes made in-store as they begin their next decade. From just occupying a few rooms of the building in 2012 with roughly 100 different wine options, to expanding throughout the building with over 400 wine options now, owner and sommelier Jaclyn Stuart said “it’s hard to believe it has already been ten years.”

One change on the horizon is the disappearance of the old tasting bar that once only sat eight people to make the entrance less congested and more welcoming. The plan is to rearrange the front counter to allow more space when first entering, as well as checking out. It will also be where customers can get a programmed card to use at the brand new Wine-o-Matic Tasting Stations.

These new tasting stations are located in the former event room which has been remodeled into a wine lounge, featuring vintage furniture, paired with new, comfortable sofas for customers to relax on and enjoy a bevy of wine options.

The state-of-the-art Wine-o-Matics were made in Italy and are the first of their kind in Sheboygan County. “We had to have a tech come out from California just to set them up. They have four distinct temperature zones and use food-grade argon to keep the wine oxidizing, so the last glass will be as good as the first,” Jaclyn said.

The tasting stations have 16 wines “on tap,” but the wine comes straight from the bottle. This allows tasters to enjoy the wine as if they had just opened it up themselves. Portions dispensed will range from a one-ounce taste to a half-glass and full glass. Taste-sized portions will start at just \$1 and glasses will start as low as \$5. Stuart said, “I want to make sure the experience is affordable and approachable, like wine should be. But if someone wants to try something like a \$100 bottle, they can do that too, with a taste for just a few dollars.”

Each selection also will have Stuart’s personal tasting notes posted above. If customers are interested in more technical information regarding the wine they

are tasting - like how long the wine was aged in oak, or what sort of soil the vines were planted in - they can scan a QR code just below the handwritten tasting notes.

The selections will change regularly and will feature a range of palate-pleasing options including reds, whites and rosés. At least two options will be sweet, but the rest will vary with the seasons and what Stuart wants to feature. For those warmer seasons, there is also the option to enjoy the wine outdoors in Vintage’s Bubble Garden.

In addition to Stuart’s expertly crafted wine selection, Vintage also carries an array of spirits, craft beers and mixers. To pair with those beverages, sweets and snacks are available to purchase, along with pastas, sauces, olive oils, vinegars and more. “I also carry everything needed to put together a great charcuterie board, including plenty of great Wisconsin cheese,” she said.

One of the things Stuart loves about Elkhart Lake is how everyone is collaborative, not competitive. “Everyone is so supportive of each other,” she said. For that reason - along with Vintage Elkhart Lake being open year-round - Stuart will continue to stay open throughout the day and close before the dinner hour. “I want people to also support other restaurants and bars in town.”

As a leading wine expert and author, Stuart also teaches wine classes. In 2020 Stuart made her classes virtual, which many people said helped them get through quarantine. She would like to continue these classes with a hybrid style of in-person and virtual.

“My hope is that after the launch of the new Wine-o-Matic Wine Lounge, I can start those classes back up. I know so many people looked forward to them each week and it was such a fun way to teach people about wine.”

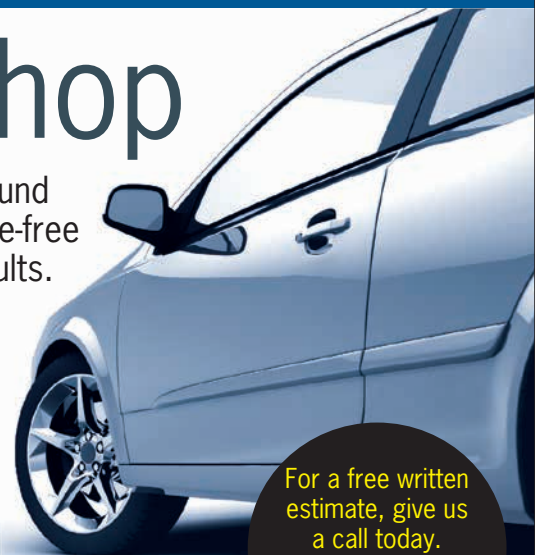
