



#### Heller Signs to William Penn University



# Meyer Inducted Into Iowa Volunteer Hall Of Fame

Dr. Steven Meyer, founder of Siouxland Tanzania Educational and Medical Ministries (STEMM) in Sioux City, Iowa,

was inducted as a member of the 2022 Iowa Volunteer Hall of Fame by Lt. Governor Adam Gregg in a ceremony at the Iowa State Capitol building on Thursday, April 21,

Being selected for the Iowa Volunteer Hall of Fame is the

most prestigious state-level honor volunteers can receive as recognition of extraordinary donations of volunteer service to their communities.

Meyer, a board-certified orthopaedic surgeon with CNOS, co-founded STEMM 25 years ago to develop a relational bridge between Siouxland and Tanzania by addressing the priorities of spiritual growth, medical care, and educational opportunities. In building this relationship, the overwhelming AIDS orphan crisis was one that could not be ignored and today is also an integral part of the STEMM ministry.

Meyer said, "It's beyond humbling to be recognized by the leadership of our great state of Iowa for the impact STEMM has made not only in Tanzania but Greater Siouxland as well. This is not my award, but I receive it on behalf of the hundreds of volunteers, donors, prayer warriors and trip participants that have been essential for our collective success. Most of all, I thank Almighty Creator God for the inspiration, passion and opportunity to do his work in changing lives for Christ on both sides of the world."

During the 25 years since STEMM was first organized, yearly outreach trips have sent hundreds of healthcare workers and other volunteers from all denominations from Siouxland to Tanzania, along with immeasurable amounts of donated medical supplies. Through Meyer's vision and dedication, STEMM has developed a 100-acre campus in Mbuguni, complete with a farming operation, educational offices and an orphanage with capacity to care for more than 50 young African children at a time.

"The work of Dr. Meyer and his team came into my purview late last year and has been such an inspiration to my family along with others I've shared the STEMM story with. Knowing that the 25thanniversary is upon us, it seemed like the perfect time to bring his story to the attention of the Governor and staff at Volunteer Iowa in hopes that his selfless efforts in Iowa to impact the world might be recognized. This is the perfect way to honor his commitment to the human race and we're so proud to know that he has chosen to live and work in Iowa while making such a difference in Tanzania," said Kevin C. Brown, Executive Director of STEMM, based in Spencer, Iowa.

The campus also operates a feeding program that provides 5,000 hot lunches each day in area schools. day for a sports-lovers paradise to catch the Twins-White Sox game and then the Timberwolves-Grizzlies NBA Playoff game. The timing worked out great with the Twins playing at 3:05 and the Timberwolves playing the late game of the day at 9:05, and with Target Field and the Target Center just blocks away we had the perfect setup with a hotel room right downtown.



We weren't certain we'd get to see the Twins game as the forecast all week called for thunderstorms for later afternoon, but the day turned out great with temps in the 70s and an overcast sky

# CASA Program Encourages Citizens to Make A Difference

April is National Child Abuse Prevention month (CAPM) and Northwest Iowa CASA Program is raising awareness of the need for more dedicated members of the community to step up and help end child abuse and neglect through supporting children and their families in the child welfare system.

CASA/ICFCRB volunteers, or Court Appointed Special Advocates/Iowa Citizen Foster Care Review Board members, are from all walks of life with different life experiences who are willing to devote their time to help a child navigate the child welfare system. They consistently advocate for what is in a child's best interests and for what is needed in order to overcome the circumstances which brought them before the juvenile court. Many of the children involved have been removed from their homes and placed into foster care; some of the children remain in their homes. And each child needs someone to pay attention to what is important to them and what is in the child's best interests during this difficult time in their life.

CASA/FCRB volunteers get to know the child's case and engage those important to the child and family. They work with a collaborative team which helps build support networks to care for families well beyond the life of the case. Volunteers make recommendations to the judge overseeing the child's case. with the goal of ensuring that the child is safe and the family has the resources, support and healthy relationships they need. When reunification is not a possibility for a child, volunteers advocate to keep them connected to their home communities and others who can provide a positive, healthy and loving environment.

Until all children are safe, secure and able to thrive and when a national month dedicated to child abuse prevention is no longer needed, CASA/FCRB continues to need more individuals to go beyond just awareness and become a volunteer as part of the solution. 





#### Spirit Lake Alumni Awarded Fulbright to Spain

by Ben Partridge - International Programs Tessa Reed, 2018 Spirit Lake graduate who received a BA in global studies and Spanish from the University of Iowa in December 2021, is the winner of a Fulbright English Teaching Assistantship Award to Spain for 2022-23.

Could you give me a brief synopsis of what you'll be doing with your Fulbright?

I will teach English in La Rioja, Spain, for the 2022-2023 academic year. Depending on my placement, I will assist teaching staff at early childhood, elementary, secondary, or vocational training schools. In addition, I will establish a program that integrates refugees into the community for my supplementary project. This program will include foreign language instruction, housing assistance, employment assistance, and other resources they may need for successful integration, such as food and medical assistance programs. I intend to explore local culture through flamenco dance classes and share my American dance experience in modern dance. In addition, I will learn how the cultural, historical, and economic factors of wine shape the Spanish community in La Rioja—a premier wine region—and participate in local harvest festivals and traditions, such as the San Mateo Festival in Logroño and foot-crushing of the

What drew you to this field of study? Through an independent study I developed in high school, I came to work at Centro Esperanza Infantil in Mexico, an organization that minimizes the barriers to accessible education, becoming interested in the social determinants that influence health, including education, social identity, health care access, and physical environment. I also enjoyed volunteering with IC Compassion in Iowa City, a refugee assistance program, where

I worked with refugees in ESL language instruction, transportation assistance, and US civic test preparation. The complex relationship between the circumstances of individuals and health inequity led me to pursue a degree in global health studies.

As I have grown up in a predominantly monolingual town, foreign language has become a tool

to expand my worldview. My fascination with the Spanish language, including the culture and history of the countries that speak it, led me to pursue a degree in Spanish. Additionally, my study abroad opportunity in San Sebastián, Spain, in 2020 reinforced these inspirations through my unforgettable conversations with my host family and friends who I am still in contact with today.

How do you envision this will influence your life/future career?

Through my Fulbright scholarship, I intend to explore the intersections of Spanish tradition set by the people of La Rioja and the modern socio-economic influences evident in schools and refugee communities. In addition, this experience will teach me successful cross-cultural collaboration and project management strategies. I will apply these skills through a career in social entrepreneurship that reduces health disparities by addressing the socio-economic facets.

What advice do you have for future students interested in applying for a Fulbright?
