Piedmont Pets

A medical emergency at the shelter on April 12th resulted in being admitted to the hospital for surgeries. I worried all that night about my cat, Danny, and my four birds. They all had a sufficient supply of food and water for a couple of days, but they are not used to being alone for longer than 8-10 hours. April, the shelter manager, went to my house to take them to the shelter.

April told me that it took her some time to get all the birds into the travel cage. They know April, but what was happening was unusual. She said they tried desperately to avoid being picked up by her.

When she told me about this, it brought to my mind the importance of making wise, sound decisions for the animals. They truly have very little control over what happens to them. At that moment, my birds did not know that they were being taken to a familiar place (they visit my office occasionally), nor did they know what had happened. They just knew they were being removed from their large, comfortable cages.

A week later when I visited them at the shelter, they all four came running to the front of the cage to greet me. A few days later when I took them home, they whistled during the car ride and then explored every inch of their cages. They settled happily onto their familiar perches. And they knew when it was supertime and waited for their rice mixture by their food bowls.

Some people believe that small birds are low maintenance, but after having cockatiels in my home since 1998, I know that they have very specific needs. In fact, there is no such thing as a low-maintenance pet!

Helping me change my mind was my experience when I came home from work one day and discovered my gerbil, Gabe, was obviously dying. My cat, Dusty, was sitting on top of her cage and refused to move. A call to the vet assured me Gabe was not in pain, so Dusty and I began a

vigil until I was so sleepy I had to go to bed.

A couple of hours later, Dusty put one soft paw on my cheek to wake me up, and I got up to find that Gabe had died. My niece had a goldfish once—an unrequested birthday gift. It sort of hung there in the water for a few days until my sister felt sorry for it and bought another goldfish to keep it company. The two of them immediately started swimming around each other in the water and had a long life together. And that was a goldfish—those little creatures purchased so casually with the idea that if it dies, there are plenty more where that one came from!

I knew then that we humans still have a lot to learn about the emotional characteristics of animals. Until we know and are willing to fulfill all of the physical and emotional needs of each of our companion animals, it is best to remain without pets.

All pets come bearing an obligation of time, energy, and finances. There really is no such thing as a low-maintenance pet.

Each living creature we bring into our homes requires a healthy diet, clean water, clean surroundings and stimulation. But, just as importantly more importantly, each one requires love and companionship, some more than others.

Silver-Plated Pitchers

Silver-plated pitchers were made by Reed & Barton, a company founded in Taunton, Massachusetts, in 1822. The pitchers look like the double-faced stoneware pitchers made by the Martin Brothers in England between 1875 and 1915. Similar pitchers were also made by Royal Doulton.



Sunny Jim is the name of these two silver-plated pitchers. The two sold together at New Orleans Auction Galleries for \$4,750 in 2019 and could be worth even more now.

The silver examples are known as "Sunny Jim." The ones pictured are about 6 1/4 inches high, and each holds about 56 ounces (7 cups) of liquid. Many figural pitchers, steins and mugs had names that were used in advertising brochures. The silver pitchers were pictured in magazine ads in the 1920s and '30s. They were discontinued in the 1950s, but may have been made until the 1980s.

Three slightly different versions were made with different rims. These are probably the first two types of the pitchers. The third variant, which was probably at the end of the production, has a handle with a higher curve that was attached to the rim only at the outermost area of the scroll.

Q. I inherited a lot of piano sheet music when my mother passed away, much of it from the World War II era. Titles include "Bell Bottom Trousers," "March of the Free," "Wings of Victory" and "I Am an American." Is anyone interested in collecting these?

A. Some old sheet music is collectible, but most sell online and in flea markets, antiques shops and house sales for a few dollars. Subject, cover art, rarity and condition help determine the price. Some collectors look for music on a particular subject, but many collectors buy sheet music for the cover art. Covers with artistic illustrations or pictures of historical events, old cars or trains, or political events increase the value. Someone who is interested in patriotic music from the World War II era might be interested in your music. It's hard to sell the music yourself unless you're used to selling online. You might try a consignment shop in your area.

Surviving Inflation

Recent government figures outlined food price increases for one month. The numbers are grim.

Fruits and vegetables went up 2.3%, the highest since 2010. Dairy went up 1.9%, the highest since 2011. Cereals and bakery items went up 1.1%.

Averaged over the past 12 months, food prices have risen 8.6% (the highest increase since 1981), with poultry and fish climbing 13% and beef soaring 16%.

Wow! We knew it was bad because each time we go to the grocery store, we're spending more to get less. But to see the figures laid out in print just brings home how bad things have gotten. Bloomberg (www.bloomberg.com), whose economists we need to keep an eye on, predicts that this year we'll pay an additional \$5,200 for all household items (including gas, heating fuel and everything else) and services, which it calculates at \$433 per month.

We need to reconsider how we feel about food banks. We seniors generally don't want to do that, saying, "Oh, others need it more." Well, at this point, maybe we are those others?

In a few days, I'll be driving three of my senior neighbors to the food bank for the weekly pickup. It will be their first time, and they are nervous. But I made a scouting trip last week, parking across the street from the line of cars and walking over to talk to the person in charge. I was able to report back: No, they don't take your name or ask questions (except maybe to ask if you'd prefer apple or orange juice). No, they're not judgmental. No, it's not leftover expired food, and the fruits and vegetables were fresh and lovely. The people were friendly and welcoming, happy to do what they were doing. Just go to the food bank. You won't be judged.

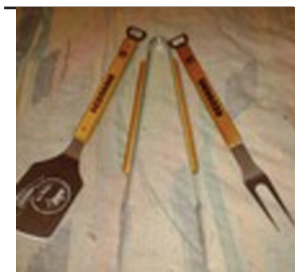

DEAR DR. ROACH: I'm not against medical marijuana when prescribed, but why do patients want or need to smoke it? What does the secondhand smoke do to children and adults around those who are smoking it? -- C.G.

ANSWER: Secondhand cannabis smoke has potential adverse effects. It can be irritating to the eyes and respiratory tract. The psychoactive component, THC, can be absorbed by someone in close proximity, especially if exposed over a prolonged period. This is also true for the vapor made by an e-cigarette device.

Cannabis smoke is irritating for the user as well. Many people who use medical cannabis use edibles containing extracts, THC and CBD. These have no risk to others, although they do carry a higher risk of acute intoxication for the user. In any event, cannabis users should take care not to expose people who do not want to be exposed, especially children.

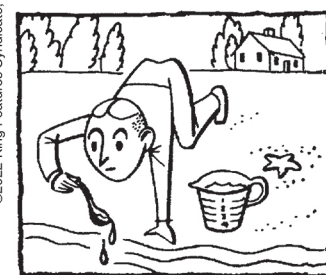

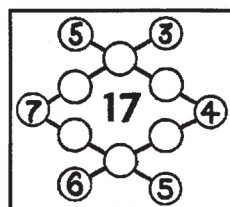

Strawberry Cream Cheese Pie



INGREDIENTS

- 1 9-10" graham cracker crust prepared
- Strawberry topping
- 5-6 cups quartered strawberries, stems removed divided (840g)
- ½ cup sugar (100g)
- 2 Tbsp cornstarch
- 1 Tbsp lemon juice
- Cream Cheese Layer
- 8 oz cream cheese softened (225g)
- ½ cup powdered sugar (65g)
- ½ teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup heavy cream (235ml)

Instructions

In small saucepan, combine 2 cups strawberries (280g), sugar, cornstarch, and lemon juice over medium-low heat. Stir frequently until strawberries release their juices. Use a potato masher to crush the strawberries until mostly liquid (it's fine if small pieces are remaining). Increase heat to medium-high and bring to a boil, stirring constantly. Boil (still stirring constantly) for 1 minutes and remove from heat, place in new heat proof container to cool faster. Set aside while you prepare your cream cheese layer. In a medium-sized bowl, beat together cream cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla extract until combined. In a separate, clean bowl, beat 1 cup heavy cream to stiff peaks. Fold into cream cheese mixture -- the resulting mixture will be thick and fluffy. Spread evenly into prepared graham cracker crust and place in refrigerator while your strawberry mixture continues to cool. Once strawberry mixture has cooled completely, add remaining strawberries and stir well. Pour over cream cheese layer, piling/mounding strawberries towards the center. Return to refrigerator and allow to set at least 4 hours (preferably overnight) before slicing and serving

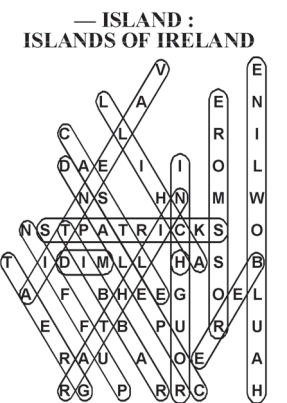

4. "Town Without Pity," in 1961. It nabbed a Golden Globe Award for Best Song the following year.
5. "Your Cheatin' Heart," by Hank Williams in 1952. The song, released weeks after Williams' death from a sudden heart attack, topped the charts for six weeks. The song was covered by Kitty Wells, Patsy Cline and Ray Charles, among others. Elvis Presley's 1958 version went to No. 1.
