



Old Silver Fillings In Your Mouth?

Do vou have old silver fillings? They seem to last a long time. However, they give us a false sense of security that all is well, especially if they don't hurt. As the metal fillings age, they corrode and expand. Then the material pulls away from the tooth, forming a gap where a cavity occurs. We often cannot see nor feel this gap with our instrument that detects the cavity, but the cavity causing bacteria get in there, X-rays don't show decay on the side of the fillings, only underneath them. If you can't see it and fix it, the cavity gets worse.

My biggest concern

is the expansion of the material. The filling acts like a pry bar to crack and break the tooth apart, resulting in the need for an onlay or crown; and worse yet, sometimes the tooth needs to be extracted because it is broken beyond repair. I have seen even a small silver pit filling break a tooth to the point that it is not fixable!

Don't wait until it is too late! A crack can form under the filling where we can't see it from the outside. The tooth will then break at some point in time. The removal of the filling does not crack the tooth. The expansion of the old filling causes it. So my recommendation is to remove your old silver fillings and have them replaced as soon as possible to prevent a catastrophic fracture. Save your back teeth! They are every bit as important as your front teeth when it comes to chewing function, comfort, and health!!



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Deciding on Early Retirement

Consider all the incentives. What will your financial position be if you accept early retirement? Compare your net income in retirement with your net income if you continue working. Non-Medical In-Home Care Program

The Lake County Council on Aging offers programs designed to enhance quality of life, promote choice and help seniors live independently in their homes as long as possible. One of the newer programs offered is the non-medical inhome care program.

This program provides compassion and help for seniors who find they need assistance with activities of daily livina.

A Council on Aaina Social Worker will help you determine if you meet criteria for the program. Eligible clients will be assigned to a contracted home healthcare agency that will provide 2 hours of in-home care once per week.

Carealvers will provide assistance or supervision with bathing. They may assist with the following services according to a care plan: basic nail and skin care, oral hygiene, light housekeeping, laundry, changing bed linens and planning and preparing meals.

Non-Medical care is the only service provided. Caregivers do have service limitations and cannot assist with thinas like skilled medical care, medication management, or transportation.

Funding for this program is provided by the Board of Lake County Commissioners.



Mobile Food Pantry continues through September, adds new locations



The Lake County Mobile Food Pantry will continue to provide free, fresh produce to Lake County seniors through a weekly distribution at locations across Lake County.

Distributions are Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

From May through September, the Lake County Mobile Food Pantry will alternate distribution locations between Lake Erie Church in Madison, New Hope Baptist Church in Painesville, Wickliffe Senior Center and Mentor Parkn-Ride.

Lake County seniors, 60 years and older, may register



for one pick-up per month. Participants must certify annual gross household income is at or below \$25,759 for a household of one and \$34,839 for a household of two. Preregistration is required for the 75 spots available each week.

For dates and times of distributions or to register for a pick-up, call Lifeline at 2-1-1 or the Council on Aging at 440-205-8111. Call Laketran at 440-354-6100 to arrange a ride to pick up your produce.

The Lake County Mobile Food Pantry is provided through a partnership between Lake County Board of Commissioners, Lake County Volunteer Network, Laketran, Lifeline and Council on Aging. Fresh food is generously donated by Greater Cleveland Foodbank. The distribution schedule is a www.laketran. com.

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Hammertoes and curled toes often are the cause of corns and irritations that produce pain when wearing shoes. Traditionally hammertoes were corrected by removing a part of the bone and inserting a pin into the toe. The recovery period was often long and painful.

• Medicaid is permitted to ask for up to five years of bank account and other financial history – that's 60 months! Be selective in how many accounts you open and keep them consolidated at one or two banks.



• Medicaid often requires a photo ID, Social Security card, birth certificate, passport, green card, marriage certificate, and health insurance/Medicare cards. It can be difficult, or even impossible, to obtain these items once a person is in poor health, so have them ready just in case.

SURGERY OF THE HAND AND UPPER EXTREMITY Michael C.

Q: I have recently experienced snapping in my left ring finger when I am using my hand for everyday activities. Occasionally, the finger locks in place and releasing it can be quite painful. The condition seems to be worse in the morning but improves slightly in the day. What could cause the problem?

A: The condition that you are describing is commonly referred to as a "trigger finger". This condition occurs when the flexor tendon sheath in the palm near the base of the finger becomes thickened. This makes it more difficult for the tendon to pass through the tendon sheath and the tendon begins "catching". This catching causes the locking which you are experiencing. This condition most commonly occurs as the result of aging, however, other conditions such as diabetes, hypothyroidism,

rheumatoid arthritis, and repetitive gripping can also place patients at risk for the development of trigger finger. A trigger finger can occur in any of the fingers and the thumb. Trigger fingers are often treated initially with rest and anti-inflammatories, however, cortisone injections into the tendon sheath often will result in improvement. If there is no improvement, surgery can be performed to release the tendon sheath and prevent further triggering from occurring. The surgery is performed through a small incision in the palm and can often be done under a local anesthetic. If the condition is left untreated. stiffness in the finger will occur. An evaluation by an appropriately trained physician who can provide specific recommendations is always the first step.

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


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Are You a Caregiver of a Family Member with Dementia?

• caregivers who have begun caring for their family member at home,


• those who have moved their family member to a care facility, and
