Royalton-Hartland's Music Education Program Receives National Recognition For The Fourth Year In A Row



The Royalton-Hartland Central School District has been honored with the Best Communities for Music Education designation from The NAMM Foundation for its outstanding commitment to music education. Now in its 23rd year, the Best Communities for Music Education designation is awarded to districts that demonstrate outstanding achievement in efforts to provide music access and education to all students.

To qualify for the Best Communities designation, Royalton-Hartland answered detailed questions about funding, graduation requirements, music class participation, instruction time, facilities, support for the music program and community music-making programs. Responses were verified with school officials and reviewed by The Music Research Institute at the University of Kansas.

"Music education has and will continue to be an essential component of our District Curriculum. During the past two years, our students and staff exceeded all expectations, even using music to help them through the social-emotional challenges that they faced," said Dr. Hank Stopinski, District Superintendent. "Continuing our recognition as one of The Best Communities for Music Education will further support the investment and commitment of our school and community towards the merits of music education in our schools."

Since the passage of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) in 2015 and a stated emphasis on a well-rounded education, many school districts have re-committed to music and arts education programs. During the pandemic, music and arts programs were a vital component to keeping students engaged in school. ESSA provides designated funding for well-rounded educational opportunities through Title IV Part A Student Academic Success and Achievement grants. NAMM Foundation research has revealed that these grants are being widely used by school districts to address instructional gaps in access to music and arts education. "It's hard to convey in writing the impact the Music Department at Royalton Hartland has had on students' lives, including my own," said Crystalina Baumer, an 11th grade student. "I've been a part of the Chorus and Orchestra at Roy-Hart since elementary school and as of this year, a part of the Vocal Jazz Ensemble. Through these years, I can attest that the music opportunities at our school have knit together a family of distinct people with one common passion: music. At the head of this family are the incredible music

teachers here. Our teachers have not only provided us with an exceptional music education but support and guidance. I have witnessed many students, including myself; turn to our teachers for safety in music. With the gift that is the Music Department, students have been allowed to reach their full potential and seize their hopes. The music teachers and Music Department have made accomplishments accessible to me that I once only dreamed of achieving. Thanks to what has been granted to me by Roy-Hart, I have been involved in All-County and All-State Orchestra and Vocal Ensembles, felt what it is like to be someone else while in musicals, been given the reassurance to compete in music competitions, the courage to perform on stages nearby to several states away, and most of all I got to share what I value with others. I hope that I can continue to carry on the legacy created within the music rooms of our district in the future. My attestations can only define so much, instead, let the music we create be a measure of the significance the Royalton Hartland Music Department has made in students' and alumni's lives."

Research into music education continues to demonstrate educational/cognitive and social skill benefits for children who make music: After two years of music education, researchers found that participants showed more substantial improvements in how the brain processes speech and reading scores than their less-involved peers and that students who are involved in music are not only more likely to graduate high school, but also to attend college as well. Everyday listening skills are stronger in musically trained children than in those without music training. Significantly, listening skills are closely tied to the ability to: perceive speech in a noisy background, pay attention, and keep sounds in memory. Later in life, individuals who took music lessons as children show stronger neural processing of sound: young adults and even older adults who have not played an instrument for up to 50 years show enhanced neural processing compared to their peers. Not to mention, social benefits include conflict resolution, teamwork skills, and how to give and receive constructive criticism. Royalton-Hartland is a rural public school district in Upstate New York. Although a small school district (student population: 1151), Royalton-Hartland has a vibrant arts program that is fully supported by both the community, the school administration and the Board of Education.

Let's go on an adventure together....to Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park!



Me in the "mitten pose" in front of the rock formation called you guessed it The Mittens.

The last state I needed to visit to reach my goal of visiting all 50 states was New Mexico. It may have been admitted as the 47th state in the union on January 6, 1912, but it was "my" 50th state as of October 2019. My first big adventure in New Mexico was visiting Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park.

Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park is known as "The World's Largest Outdoor Museum" and it is absolutely incredible! Monument Valley is part of a large Navajo territory that spreads across the borders of New Mexico, Utah, Arizona, and Colorado - the bulk of the land is in Utah and Arizona. The actual Monument Valley Navajo Tribal Park is a National Park that sits well within the Navajo Reservation and is protected by the Navajo people. They are very proud of their land and their heritage and are excited to share their cultures and history. Direct quote

Valley has been oft featured in popular films, most notably those of Director John Ford, its stoic forms forever immortalized as icons of the American West. The mammoth buttes, like sleeping giants, rise from the wind-swept landscape alongside towering spires of rock like the striated pinnacles of an ancient cathedral. As the sun makes its way across the sky each day, the landscape appears to shift while the clouds overhead chase their shadows across the richlyhued desert terrain. The overall effect is one of haunting beauty hewn of sandstone and shaped by the elements. Quite a drive from Flagstaff, but well worth the scenic trip, Monument Valley is deep within the Navajo Nation Reserve. Here, the Navajo continue to adhere to age-old traditions, living life in the image of their ancestors."

You may explore the park on your own, but the rough terrain is best navigated with a 4x4 vehicle. Also, there are parts that are not accessible by the general public unless accompanied by a Navajo guide. So, I chose a tour put on by Monument Valley Safari Tours. It was an awesome 3.5 hour tour in a 4x4 Jeep with a Navajo guide - our guide was amazing - her name was Comasheena. The tour took us to all the common areas and then went off road further in to the restricted areas of the park. They restrict these areas because they want to ensure the formations and the land are not desecrated in any way. I'm so glad I booked the tour - our guide made it so interesting and the best views were definitely in the areas that the general public are restricted from. The rock formations throughout the park are all natural and not interfered with my humans in any way. If they erode or break down, they stay that way. The natives believe that nature must be left to run its course. However, they can keep outside threats from speeding up the natural course by restricting access where they can. Throughout the tour, we saw breathtaking views and natural rock formations, learned all about the culture

and history of the Navajo people, visited authentic Navajo dwellings called Hogans, saw an ancient Anasazi cliff dwelling ruin, heard a stunning Navajo song played in a cave with perfect acoustics (the video is in the blog post - don't miss clicking on it), and saw ancient Petroglyphs.

After I left Monument Valley, I drove to Four Corners Monument – the only place in the United States where four states all border each other: Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, and Arizona. That was a bit of a let-down, but still pretty cool to say I was there and stood on the spot where all the states touch each other. From there, I spent a few days in the Albuquergue and Sante Fe areas, which I won't go into here, but will include the blog link below for you to check out.



One of the stops on the tour was a Navajo dwelling called a Hogan. Inside were exhibits of Navajo goods and art and natives who proudly gave instructions on what we were looking at and how it was used or made. There were so many stunning jewelry and rugs and other crafts and art. Fascinating!

So....that put a cap on my "Visit all 50 states" bucket list item. If you're ever out in that area of the country - and, you really SHOULD go see it, if you never have - be sure to put Monument Valley on your to-do list. You won't regret it. And, if you really want to experience ALL of it, consider spending the money for one of the Navajo guided tours --- totally worth every penny!






