Author Visit Highlights Depression and Mental Health

Medina High Jr-Sr High School recently played host to author Bree Barton. She has penned four books: Heart of Thorns, Tears of Frost, Soul of Cinder and her latest Zia Erases the World.

High School librarian Jennifer O'Toole invited Ms. Barton and Julie Berry, from the Author's Note Bookstore, to talk to 7th graders in the library on April 28th. Ms. Barton talked with the students about her experiences with depression and how she started experiencing those feelings in the 6th grade. "It came on very suddenly and in the nineties nobody was really talking about mental health. It is a very confusing situation for kids and I am hoping by sharing my story, it may be helpful to students here."

Her experience with depression inspired her book Zia Erases the World. The story centers on Zia and her challenge of finding the right words for the fear that is growing inside of her. She settles on a word of her own making: Shadoom. When she stumbles upon a family heirloom: the C. Scuro Dictionary, 13th edition, she realizes in its magical pages she has the ability to erase words that remind her of Shadoom. The consequences of her actions has some funny and heartbreaking moments, but ultimately allows her to get help and overcome her dark moments and reach for

She shared with the students what her life was like in the sixth grade and the challenges she faced as a child of a single mom who

moved almost every year. "I was not cool," she told the students. "We were poor and I wore hand-me-down clothing. I was depressed and very sad. I spent a lot of time in the library because books are a great way to escape. I started writing fantasy when I was 10 years old and submitting my stories to editors when I was 11. I got a lot of rejection notices. When some mean girls at school made fun of me, I quit writing for quite a while because their comments really hurt me."

She eventually began writing again in high school. "I had a tough time, but eventually I found a way back to myself and I had my mom and other adults that I could talk to about what I was feeling and they helped me. I took up dancing and getting healthier physically helped me to get healthier mentally. She read a chapter from Zia and also discussed with the students what it is like to be an author and her journey as a writer. She also answered questions from the students. Mrs. O'Toole says this about Ms. Barton's talk, "It was a pleasure to host Bree and to learn more about her background and the inspiration for her work. I think her honesty and life story was relatable and truly resonated with our students. I am thrilled to be working with Julie Berry & the Author's Note Bookstore to bring authors in-person to speak with Medina students. It's such a valuable, worthwhile, and fun learning experience for students to take part in."

How to pick the right trees for your property

- · Canopy spread: Trees grow out as well as up, so it's important to consider their potential width at maturity as well. The ADF sizing guide can help homeowners get an idea of how wide a tree is likely to be at maturity. Trees that spread out quite a bit don't necessarily need to be avoided, but it's important that they're planted far enough apart so they don't adversely affect surrounding plants. In addition, wide trees that are planted too close together can make the landscape appear crowded, taking something away from its aesthetic appeal.
- Growth rate: Growth rate is an important variable because it can affect how quickly homeowners will see changes in their landscapes. Homeowners who want to plant for privacy can consider trees with quick growth rates or purchase more mature trees that are already near full growth. Those who are not in need of instant transformation can try trees with slower growth rates, which the ADF notes typically live longer than fast-growing species.
- · Requirements: Different trees require different amounts of sun and moisture and different soil components to thrive. Homeowners can have their soil tested to determine which trees will thrive in it. Local garden centers can be a great resource for homeowners who want insight as to which trees will thrive in their local climates.



A drink to soothe your stomach



moothies are often associated with breakfast, but they actually can be enjoyed all day long. Smoothies have been around since the

1920s, when the first blender was invented by Stephen Poplawski. In 1939. the Waring blender company designed a pamphlet that came with the appliance that included fruit-based drinks. Smoothies can include a variety of

ingredients and serve various purposes. This recipe for a "Ginger Papaya Smoothie" from "Super Smoothies" (Crestline) by Ellen Brown employs ginger, which can help overcome nausea and other stomach issues.

Ginger Papaya Smoothie Yields 4 1-cup servings

- 1 cup chilled papaya nectar
- 1 container (8 ounces) peach low-fat yogurt
- ½ cup silken tofu
- 1/4 cup whey protein powder
- 3 tablespoons crystallized ginger
- 2 cups papaya cubes, frozen
- 4 papaya spears for garnish (optional)

Combine papaya nectar, yogurt, tofu, whey protein powder, and crystalized ginger in a blender or smoothie maker. Blend on high speed for 45 seconds or until mixture is puréed and smooth. Add papaya cubes and blend on high speed again until mixture is smooth. Serve immediately garnished with papaya spears, if desired.

Tip: Crystallized ginger is fresh ginger that has been cooked in sugar syrup to render it both sweet and tender. It is usually then coated with sugar to prevent the slices from sticking together. To find crystallized ginger, look in the baking section of your supermarket rather than the produce aisle.
