Tigers Win Norwalk Tourney



"While the community elects school board members, they serve as unpaid innovators who help students take flight by devoting their time to monthly meetings, reviewing board materials, communicating with citizens, exploring learning opportunities, and attending school functions and activities," said Superintendent Abrahamson.

The Okoboji School Board is the navigator for our school district. They oversee the budget, develop policies, set the atmosphere for the district, and make decisions that impact the entire community. Most importantly, they are committed to student achievement. It might not seem like rocket science, but it is!

"Our school board keeps the district on course. They serve 1,208 students and 225 employees and are responsible for an annual budget of \$35M (includes Governmental Funds, Proprietary Fund, and Fiduciary Fund). It's a big job for no pay, but our board members say they serve to meet the needs of our students and our community," said Superintendent Abrahamson.





Iowa Lakes Offers Emergency Medical Technician Training

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training will be available at Iowa Lakes Community College from June 1 to August 4. People interested in joining the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) field with the minimum training required by the State of Iowa to transport a patient in an ambulance should register for the class as soon as possible.

Based on the National EMT Educational Standards, this training includes psychomotor skills practice in a classroom, online lectures, and 32 hours of onsite clinical/field training. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will be eligible to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) certification exam.

The EMT training will meet from 8:00 am - 12:00 pm Monday through Friday, from June 1 to June17 and then move to Tuesday and Thursday from June 20 to August 4.

Tuition includes instruction, an online textbook, a uniform shirt, and the psychometer exam currently scheduled for August 6 for \$1789. Fees for physicals, vaccinations, and certification are additional charges not included in tuition. Preregistration is required and closes on May 19.


THE MUSIC OF THE GREAT AMERICAN SONG BOOK

Bobby Darin was born in New York on May 14, 1936, and lived too short a life as a fine entertainer, passing away less than a week before Christmas, in 1973. With his versatile voice, Darin recorded Pop, Jazz, Rock'n' Roll, folk, Swing, and Country songs. His first million-selling single was *Splish Splash*, in 1959. *Mack the Knife* became his biggest hit, topping the charts for nine weeks. No stranger to awards, Darin won two Grammy awards in 1960, earned a star on The Hollywood Walk of Fame in 1982, was posthumously inducted into the Rock'n'Roll Hall of Fame in 1990 and The Songwriters Hall of Fame in 1999.

Family Caregivers of Military Members and Veterans Need Support

May is National Military Appreciation Month, a time to recognize and honor current and former military personnel. Many military service members and veterans with physical and mental illnesses and injuries receive care and support from family and friends. These caregivers help those they care for have better quality of life. Yet playing this role can impose a substantial physical, emotional and financial toll on

caregivers. Military and veteran caregivers are hidden heroes, said Malisa Rader, a human sciences specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. Veterans suffer more frequently from traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic stress disorder, diabetes, and paralysis or spinal cord injury. The caregivers of service members and veterans sacrifice their livelihoods, health and wellbeing as they support care receivers through panic attacks and chronic mental and physical conditions and help them navigate the health care system. They also save the United States \$14 billion each year as voluntary labor.

an essential role in caring for injured or wounded service members and veterans. This enables those for whom they are caring to live better quality lives and can result in improved rehabilitation and recovery, but the toll on their own wellbeing can be high," said Rader, who specializes in family wellbeing issues.

ISU Extension and Outreach is offering a telehealth course titled "Powerful Tools for Caregivers of Military Members and Veterans" starting May 19 at 7:00pm. This educational offering provides information, support strategies, communication techniques, stress reduction ideas and resources to assist family caregivers of veterans and military personnel with their concerns related to caregiving. The Elizabeth Dole Foundation commissioned the first national comprehensive study

military care receivers cope

with stressful situations or other emotional and behavioral challenges. In addition, their caregiving journey starts earlier in life (85% are under 40) and lasts

longer, according to Caregiv-

ing in the U.S. 2020, a report

by AARP and the National

Data from Caregivers of Veterans: Serving on the Home Front, commissioned by National Alliance for Caregiving and United Health Foundation, showed the following:

· 96% of caregivers of veterans are female.

· 70% provide care to their spouse or partner.

· 30% of veterans' caregivers care for a duration of 10 years or more as compared to 15% of caregivers nationally. ·88% report increased

stress or anxiety as a result of caregiving. ·77% state sleep depriva-

tion as an issue.

"Remember, you cannot pour from an empty cup," Rader said. "The end result can be poor health, mental distress and less life satisfaction for the caregiver. When the caregiver suffers, veterans suffer along with their families and communities."

"Powerful Tools for Caregivers" can help military and veteran caregivers get the tools and resources they need to take care of themselves and their loved ones, Rader said.




View From The Bench by John Adams, Jr.

Twins Finding a Way

I apologize in advance to Minnesota Twins fans if this article brings my infamous "John Jinx" to our beloved Twins. With a

well-deserved day off on Monday the Twins currently sit alone in first place in the American League Central by three games over the Chicago White Sox with an 18-11 record. What is even more impressive than being in first place is that the Twins started the season extremely slow and are 15-4 in their last 19 games, including nine



straight wins at Target Field, which is a new record. Minnesota is not blowing away teams by any means, but they are finding ways to win the close games.

This past weekend the Twins swept the Oakland A's, winning the three-game series by a total of three runs with victories of 2-1, 1-0 and 4-3 over the weekend. Starting pitching has been a strength of the Twins so far as they are third in the American League with a 3.17 ERA, lead by potential-star Joe Ryan's 3-1 start with an impressive 1.63 ERA. The bullpen has improved since the start of the season with Jhoan Duran throwing straight gas in late-game situations and Emilio Pagan also showing up as a reliable closer with four saves, even though he always seems to make it interesting by walking a few guys in the ninth inning. The Twins' bats have been average at best, as they are currently hitting just .238 as a team, which is 11th best in Major League Baseball. One reason for the slow start with hitting has been injuries, as stars Byron Buxton and Carlos Correa, and struggling Miguel Sano have all missed at least five games with injuries, but fortunately for the Twins, those injuries were not as severe as they first appeared. Other players, including former #1 overall pick Royce Lewis have filled in nicely during these injuries and the Twins are showing they have a very deep bench, which is vital during a 162-game season.

Staying healthy will be key for the Twins moving forward, as they await word on the extent of the injury to starting pitcher Chris Paddack, who left the game on Sunday with elbow soreness after just two innings. Minnesota should get Mr. Do-It-All Luis Arraez back soon off the Covid-IL, and hope to have Correa back later this week. Unfortunately for the Twins, staying healthy has not been a strength for them in the past, with key injuries to pitchers (Kenta Maeda, Randy Dobnak) and constant injuries to star Byron Buxton. The Twins are definitely due for some good luck in this area, and if Buxton can stay healthy, he has a chance to be an MVP candidate. Buxton staying healthy is absolutely huge for this team, as he not only is leading the MLB in homeruns with nine, but he also brings an energy to the team that is unmatched. If this team can stay healthy, the bats start to heat up and the pitching remain strong, they will have a chance to make the playoffs and hopefully end that dreaded 18-game playoff losing streak!

This award is earned by less than 1% of the student members of the National Speech and Debate Association's debaters and demonstrates great effort and commitment as a competitor and as a student. In order to qualify for the award, a student must earn at least a 3.7 grade point average and must have earned 750 merit points.

Debate Sweepstakes: The Okoboji Debate Team earned a 2nd place finish in Sweepstakes in January. The sweepstakes award is based upon total points earned by the team throughout the state tournament. There is no class system which means all schools are competing for this award.

Public Forum: Senior Haley Harms and Junior Connor Cunningham took 1st place in the Galligan division to earn a State Championship. This is the second consecutive year for Haley to be on the Championship team. Junior Chayse Packebush and Sophomore Sam Hoggard won their way into the quarterfinals in the same division. Freshmen Tyler Christenson and Marc Hoggard finished with a 2-3 record.

If you need to dispose of building structures or other large objects that two men cannot easily handle, please call City Hall at (712) 332-2341 to make special arrangements and we will try to accommodate you.

The City will not pick up any hazardous items such as oil, paint, pesticides, weed control products, etc. Empty paint cans will be picked up if the can is dry and the top is off.

Please refrain from placing items curbside prior to the Saturday before the clean-up day. All debris needs to be curbside and ready for pick up by 7:00 a.m. on June 6th.

Utility Billing

Utility bills are sent out at the end of each quarter and are due by the 20th of the month in January, April, July, and October. Bills that are not paid by this date are considered past due and are subject to being disconnected.

Animal Protection
Pet Owners: There is a Leash Law in Arnolds Park. It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the City limits. "At large" means off the premises of the owner and not under the control of a competent person who has the animal on a maximum 10-foot leash, restrained within a motor vehicle, or housed in a veterinary hospital or kennel. Animals found at large in violation of this chapter shall be seized and impounded at the impoundment facility utilized by the City; or, at the discretion of the peace officer, the owner may be served a summons to appear before a proper court to answer charges made thereunder.

Yard Waste & Open Burning
The City has proper di

The City has proper disposal methods for yard waste and we ask that it never be blown into or placed on the streets, public roads, or neighboring lots.

If you wish to have your yard waste (no dirt or rocks) picked up it must be placed in City bags, tied shut, and placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Tuesdays. The bags must not weigh more than 50 pounds. Cut branches in 4 ft. lengths and bundle with a City bag attached. City bags are available for purchase at City Hall and at Casey's in Arnolds Park. Another option is to drop off your bags at the Dickinson County Regional Collection Center located at 2260 220th Street (A34) Milford, IA; charges may apply.

If you choose to burn your yard waste, please be courteous to neighbors and use good judgment based on weather conditions. All fires must be attended by a person 18 years of age or older at all times. Any yard waste that you burn on your property, must originate on your property. The burning of garbage, rubber, or anything of a toxic matter is strictly prohibited. Yard waste cannot be burned on City property.

Garbage Collection

Beginning Memorial Day and continuing through Labor Day, garbage will be picked up on Mondays and Fridays. Collection begins at 7:00 a.m. If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated collection day.

Paint, lawn waste, or recyclables are not to be placed in the cart. Also, remember to place your carts at least five feet away from any structure (i.e. mailboxes, trees, cars).

Recycling

Curbside recycling days are the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. Please contact City Hall if you would like to receive a recycling container. Recycling must be placed in the correct container in order to be picked up, Town & Country will not pick up recycling in any other container or if it is mixed in with garbage. Please have containers out by 7:00 a.m. on pick-up day. If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated pick-up day. There are recycling bins located at 700 240th Avenue if you should miss the curbside collection.

Accepted recyclables include: cans (steel, tin, aluminum), plastic containers (bottles, tubs, jugs), flattened cardboard, paper (newspapers, office paper, junk mail, magazines, phone books). Shredded paper and plastic bags need to be bagged separately in clear plastic bags. Do not recycle the following items: Glass (bottles, jars), styrofoam, ceramics, porcelain, baking glass, toys, clothes, shoes, rubber, waste & food, pizza boxes, hazardous materials (paint, lead, glue, oil), electronics (TVs, keyboards, batteries, bulbs), furnace filters.

Appliances & Electronics

Appliances and electronics are picked up curbside year-round. You must purchase a tag for these items at City Hall. If you choose to dispose of items yourself, Dickinson County has a recycling facility located at 2260 220th Street in Milford. Please contact (712) 338-2549 with any questions.
