

Iowa Lakes Offers Emergency Medical Technician Training

Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training will be available at Iowa Lakes Community College from June 1 to August 4. People interested in joining the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) field with the minimum training required by the State of Iowa to transport a patient in an ambulance should register for the class as soon as possible.

Based on the National EMT Educational Standards, this training includes psychomotor skills practice in a classroom, online lectures, and 32 hours of onsite clinical/field training. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will be eligible to take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technician (NREMT) certification exam.

The EMT training will meet from 8:00 am - 12:00 pm Monday through Friday, from June 1 to June 17 and then move to Tuesday and Thursday from June 20 to August 4.

Follow up with *I'm Just a Lucky So and So*, recorded by Ella Fitzgerald with Duke Ellington in 1957. End the day on a happy note with Sarah Vaughan's 1965 vocal version of Henry Mancini's instrumental, *Mr. Lucky*.

Bobby Darin was born in New York on May 14, 1936, and lived too short a life as a fine entertainer, passing away less than a week before Christmas, in 1973. With his versatile voice, Darin recorded Pop, Jazz, Rock'n' Roll, folk, Swing, and Country songs. His first million-selling single was *Splish Splash*, in 1959. *Mack the Knife* became his biggest hit, topping the charts for nine weeks. No stranger to awards, Darin won two Grammy awards in 1960, earned a star on The Hollywood Walk of Fame in 1982, was posthumously inducted into the Rock'n'Roll Hall of Fame in 1990 and *The Songwriters Hall of Fame* in 1999.

Family Caregivers of Military Members and Veterans Need Support

May is National Military Appreciation Month, a time to recognize and honor current and former military personnel. Many military service members and veterans with physical and mental illnesses and injuries receive care and support from family and friends. These caregivers help those they care for have better quality of life. Yet playing this role can impose a substantial physical, emotional and financial toll on caregivers.

Military and veteran caregivers are hidden heroes, said Malisa Rader, a human sciences specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach. Veterans suffer more frequently from traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic stress disorder, diabetes, and paralysis or spinal cord injury. The caregivers of service members and veterans sacrifice their livelihoods, health and wellbeing as they support care receivers through panic attacks and chronic mental and physical conditions and help them navigate the health care system. They also save the United States \$14 billion each year as voluntary labor.

"These caregivers play an essential role in caring for injured or wounded service members and veterans. This enables those for whom they are caring to live better quality lives and can result in improved rehabilitation and recovery, but the toll on their own wellbeing can be high," said Rader, who specializes in family wellbeing issues.

ISU Extension and Outreach is offering a telehealth course titled "Powerful Tools for Caregivers of Military Members and Veterans" starting May 19 at 7:00pm. This educational offering provides information, support strategies, communication techniques, stress reduction ideas and resources to assist family caregivers of veterans and military personnel with their concerns related to caregiving. The course will be led by certified class leaders, most with military experience. The Elizabeth Dole Foundation commissioned the first national comprehensive study

of military caregivers. During that research, the RAND corporation noted there are 5.5 million caregivers for former or current military personnel in the United States, 1.1 million of whom are caring for military veterans who served after the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001. There are unique circumstances surrounding military caregivers, particularly those caring for younger individuals who served in Iraq or Afghanistan:

- Post-9/11 caregivers tend to be younger and juggle work with caregiving duties. Most have no support network.
 - They are four times more likely than non-caregivers to be depressed.
 - One-third of post-9/11 caregivers are without health insurance.
 - They typically help their military care receivers cope with stressful situations or other emotional and behavioral challenges.
- In addition, their caregiving journey starts earlier in life (85% are under 40) and lasts longer, according to Caregiving in the U.S. 2020, a report by AARP and the National

Alliance on Caregiving.

Data from Caregivers of Veterans: Serving on the Home Front, commissioned by National Alliance for Caregiving and United Health Foundation, showed the following:

- 96% of caregivers of veterans are female.
 - 70% provide care to their spouse or partner.
 - 30% of veterans' caregivers care for a duration of 10 years or more as compared to 15% of caregivers nationally.
 - 88% report increased stress or anxiety as a result of caregiving.
 - 77% state sleep deprivation as an issue.
- "Remember, you cannot pour from an empty cup," Rader said. "The end result can be poor health, mental distress and less life satisfaction for the caregiver. When the caregiver suffers, veterans suffer along with their families and communities."
- "Powerful Tools for Caregivers" can help military and veteran caregivers get the tools and resources they need to take care of themselves and their loved ones, Rader said.

Shrimp Quesadilla - Serves 6

2 tablespoons vegetable oil
1 onion, sliced
1 red bell pepper, sliced
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground cumin
1 teaspoon chili powder
1 pound uncooked medium shrimp, peeled and deveined
1 jalapeño pepper, seeded & minced (optional)
1 lime, juiced
1 teaspoon vegetable oil, or as needed
6 large flour tortillas
3 cups shredded Mexican cheese blend

Heat 2 tablespoons vegetable oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir onion and red bell pepper in the hot oil, until onion is translucent, and peppers are soft, around 6 to 8 minutes. Stir in salt, cumin and chili powder. Stir shrimp into mix and cook until shrimp are opaque and no longer pink in the center, 3 to 5 minutes. Remove skillet from heat; stir jalapeño pepper and lime juice into shrimp mixture. Heat a skillet over medium heat and brush with about 1/6 shrimp filling and 1/2 cup Mexican cheese blend on one side of tortilla. Fold tortilla in half. Cook until bottom of tortilla is lightly browned, about 5 minutes; flip and cook other side until lightly browned. Repeat with remaining tortillas and filling.

Twins Finding a Way

I apologize in advance to Minnesota Twins fans if this article brings my infamous "John Jinx" to our beloved Twins. With a well-deserved day off on Monday the Twins currently sit alone in first place in the American League Central by three games over the Chicago White Sox with an 18-11 record. What is even more impressive than being in first place is that the Twins started the season extremely slow and are 15-4 in their last 19 games, including nine straight wins at Target Field, which is a new record. Minnesota is not blowing away teams by any means, but they are finding ways to win the close games.



This past weekend the Twins swept the Oakland A's, winning the three-game series by a total of three runs with victories of 2-1, 1-0 and 4-3 over the weekend. Starting pitching has been a strength of the Twins so far as they are third in the American League with a 3.17 ERA, lead by potential-star Joe Ryan's 3-1 start with an impressive 1.63 ERA. The bullpen has improved since the start of the season with Joao Duran throwing straight gas in late-game situations and Emilio Pagan also showing up as a reliable closer with four saves, even though he always seems to make it interesting by walking a few guys in the ninth inning. Other players, including former #1 overall pick Royce Lewis have filled in nicely during these injuries and the Twins are showing they have a very deep bench, which is vital during a 162-game season.

Staying healthy will be key for the Twins moving forward, as they await word on the extent of the injury to starting pitcher Chris Paddack, who left the game on Sunday with elbow soreness after just two innings. Minnesota should get Mr. Do-It-All Luis Arraez back soon off the Covid-IL, and hope to have Correa back later this week. Unfortunately for the Twins, staying healthy has not been a strength for them in the past, with key injuries to pitchers (Kenta Maeda, Randy Dobnak) and constant injuries to star Byron Buxton. The Twins are definitely due for some good luck in this area, and if Buxton can stay healthy, he has a chance to be an MVP candidate. Buxton staying healthy is absolutely huge for this team, as he not only is leading the MLB in homers with nine, but he also brings an energy to the team that is unmatched. If this team can stay healthy, the bats start to heat up and the pitching remain strong, they will have a chance to make the playoffs and hopefully end that dreaded 18-game playoff losing streak!



Information from the office of the Dickinson County Veteran Affairs for You:

VA Announces Nine New Cancers Added to the Presumed Service-Connected List Related to Particulate Matter

On April 26th, 2022 the VA announced the addition of nine rare respiratory cancers to the list of presumed service-connected disabilities due to exposure to fine particulate matter for Veterans who served any amount of time in Afghanistan, Djibouti, Syria or Uzbekistan during the Persian Gulf War from September 19, 2001 to the present. Or, any Veteran who served in the Southwest Asia theater of operations from August 2, 1990 to the present. This includes Iraq, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, the neutral zone between Iraq and Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, Qatar, the United Arab Emirates, Oman, the Gulf of Aden, the Gulf of Oman, the Persian Gulf, the Arabian Sea, the Red Sea, and the airspace above these locations.

The VA is taking a new approach to making decisions on presumptives, one that takes all available science into account, with one goal in mind--getting today's Veterans, and Vets in the decades ahead, the benefits they deserve, as fast as possible.

The VA has identified through scientific and medical evidence, a biological plausibility between airborne hazards, specifically particulate matter, and carcinogenesis of the respiratory tract. The unique circumstances of these rare cancers warrant a presumption of service connection.

Veterans and survivors who had claims previously denied for any of the below respiratory cancers are encouraged to file a supplemental claim for benefits:

- Squamous cell carcinoma of the larynx
- Squamous cell carcinoma of the trachea
- Adenocarcinoma of the trachea
- Salivary gland-type tumors of the trachea
- Adenosquamous carcinoma of the lung
- Large cell carcinoma of the lung
- Salivary gland-type tumors of the lung
- Sarcomatoid carcinoma of the lung
- Typical and atypical carcinoid of the lung

The VA will contact impacted Veterans and survivors to inform them about their eligibility, and it will provide information on how to apply.

Spring Clean-Up Day

The annual Arnolds Park Citywide Clean-Up is scheduled for **Monday, June 6, 2022**. This is offered to all residents of Arnolds Park as a discounted way to dispose of items that are not collected during regular garbage pick-up. Please place small items in boxes or bags. **Discounted tags for appliances, electronics, and furniture may be purchased one week prior to clean-up day.** Also, no lawn waste or recycling will be collected. If you need to dispose of building structures or other large objects that two men cannot easily handle, please call City Hall at (712) 332-2341 to make special arrangements and we will try to accommodate you.

The City will not pick up any hazardous items such as oil, paint, pesticides, weed control products, etc. Empty paint cans will be picked up if the can is dry and the top is off.

Please refrain from placing items curbside prior to the Saturday before the clean-up day. All debris needs to be curbside and ready for pick up by **7:00 a.m. on June 6th**.



Utility Billing

Utility bills are sent out at the end of each quarter and are due by the 20th of the month in January, April, July, and October. Bills that are not paid by this date are considered past due and are subject to being disconnected.

You may pay by check or cash at City Hall, or online using a credit card at www.arnoldsparkcity.com. Another option is to have your payment automatically deducted from a checking or savings account. Please contact City Hall for more information on automatic withdrawal.

Animal Protection

Pet Owners: There is a Leash Law in Arnolds Park. It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the City limits. "At large" means off the premises of the owner and not under the control of a competent person who has the animal on a maximum 10-foot leash, restrained within a motor vehicle, or housed in a veterinary hospital or kennel. Animals found at large in violation of this chapter shall be seized and impounded at the impoundment facility utilized by the City; or, at the discretion of the peace officer, the owner may be served a summons to appear before a proper court to answer charges made thereunder.



Yard Waste & Open Burning

The City has proper disposal methods for yard waste and we ask that it never be blown into or placed on the streets, public roads, or neighboring lots.

If you wish to have your yard waste (no dirt or rocks) picked up it must be placed in City bags, tied shut, and placed **curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Tuesdays**. The bags must not weigh more than 50 pounds. Cut branches in 4 ft. lengths and bundle with a City bag attached. City bags are available for purchase at City Hall and at Casey's in Arnolds Park. Another option is to drop off your bags at the Dickinson County Regional Collection Center located at 2260 220th Street (A34) Milford, IA; charges may apply.

If you choose to burn your yard waste, please be courteous to neighbors and use good judgment based on weather conditions. All fires must be attended by a person 18 years of age or older at all times. Any yard waste that you burn on your property, must originate on your property. **The burning of garbage, rubber, or anything of a toxic matter is strictly prohibited. Yard waste cannot be burned on City property.**



Garbage Collection

Beginning Memorial Day and continuing through Labor Day, garbage will be picked up on Mondays and Fridays. **Collection begins at 7:00 a.m.** If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated collection day.

Paint, lawn waste, or recyclables are not to be placed in the cart. Also, remember to place your carts at least five feet away from any structure (i.e. mailboxes, trees, cars).



Recycling

Curbside recycling days are the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month. Please contact City Hall if you would like to receive a recycling container. Recycling must be placed in the correct container in order to be picked up, Town & Country will not pick up recycling in any other container or if it is mixed in with garbage. Please have containers out by 7:00 a.m. on pick-up day. If you do not have your container out in time it will not be picked up until the next designated pick-up day. There are recycling bins located at 700 240th Avenue if you should miss the curbside collection.

Accepted recyclables include: cans (steel, tin, aluminum), plastic containers (bottles, tubs, jugs), flattened cardboard, paper (newspapers, office paper, junk mail, magazines, phone books). Shredded paper and plastic bags need to be bagged separately in clear plastic bags. **Do not recycle the following items:** Glass (bottles, jars), styrofoam, ceramics, porcelain, baking glass, toys, clothes, shoes, rubber, waste & food, pizza boxes, hazardous materials (paint, lead, glue, oil), electronics (TVs, keyboards, batteries, bulbs), furnace filters.



Appliances & Electronics

Appliances and electronics are picked up curbside year-round. You must purchase a tag for these items at City Hall. If you choose to dispose of items yourself, Dickinson County has a recycling facility located at 2260 220th Street in Milford. Please contact (712) 338-2549 with any questions.



Severe Weather

Sirens located at City Hall, Dam Road, & Benit Drive will be sounded. Tests for these sirens are held every Wednesday at noon.

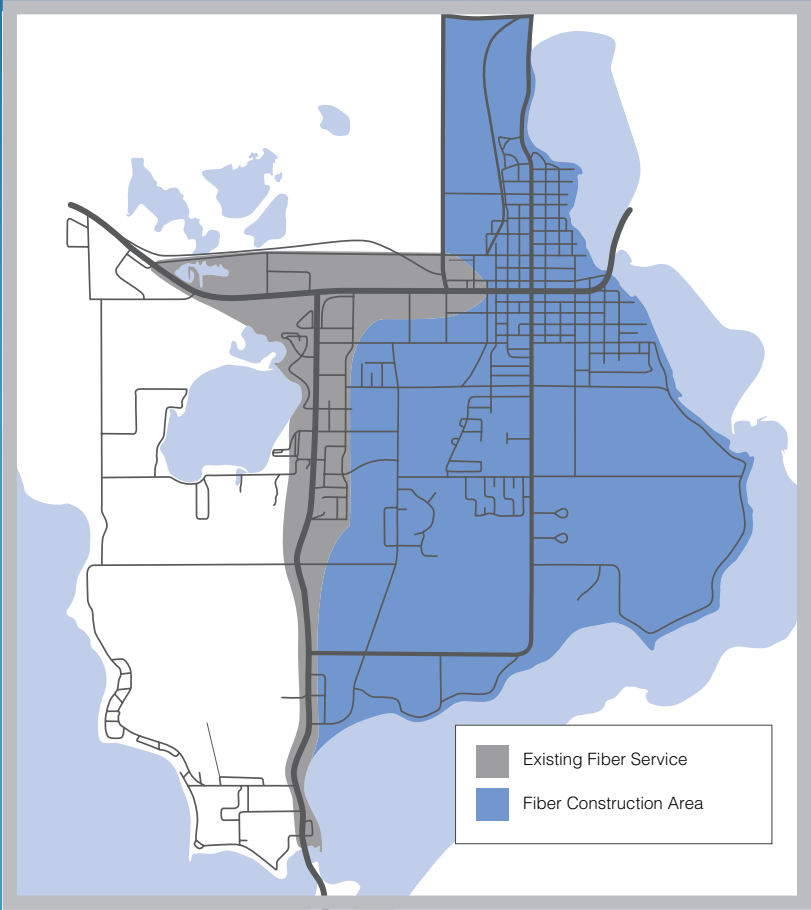
