## Aitkin Historical Society has 8,000 objects catalogued

With books and media filled with all kinds of advice on how to organize your home, your life or your office, a huge organizational and documentation project was completed by the Aitkin Historical Society.

Sarah Junot and Aurora Schuety have spent over a year working part-time to restore, clean, organize, photograph and document 8,000 artifacts and documents owned by the local historical society. It was paid for by a Minnesota

Legacy Grant. "The collection was stored in three places: the Depot Museum, the adjacent building and a storage building off-site," explained Junot, of Walker, who holds a Ph.D. in history from the University of California. "We went through every single object, and developed a description, condition report and photographic record. This will be uploaded into a digital catalogue that the staff can use to locate items."

Long-term, with more fund-

ing and staff time, the collection could be uploaded into a digital catalogue available on-line.

Schuety, a Palisade native, graduated in 2020 from the University of Minnesota-Duluth, with majors in philosophy and cognitive science; along with a museum certificate. She has worked this and other part-time jobs and recently moved to Grand Rapids.

"I've got another job lined up at the Forest History Center in Grand Rapids," Schuety

noted about her next step. Their work in Aitkin, under the grant, finished on May 6 when the funds and timeline ran out. "I want to get my foot in the door to do more museum work. My parents are still in Palisade."

Jonet said her passion is inventorying collections and she hopes to move on to another job in that field.

Jonet, calling herself a "total

nerd," likes to read, walk and hike.

Schuety got through the long winter by playing board games with friends, playing video games, watching shows and getting back onto reading for pleasure.

The storage room in Depot Museum is loaded with neatly categorized boxes. The collection has never been so impeccable.

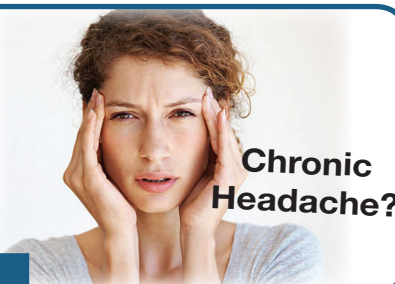

## Northern pike zone regulations

For those who will be fishing for northern pike, familiarize yourself with northern pike regulations and be prepared to measure the fish. Minnesota has three northern pike zones that apply to inland waters and reflect the differing characteristics of pike populations across the state:

North-central: Limit of 10 northern pike; anglers must release all fish 22 to 26 inches, with only two fish longer than 26 inches allowed in possession.

Northeast: Limit of two northern pike; anglers must release all fish 30 to 40 inches, with only one fish over 40 inches allowed in possession.

South: Limit of two northern pike; minimum size 24 inches.

Throughout the state, special regulations that cover individual lakes, rivers and streams remain in effect and take precedence over the zone regulations. The northern pike zone regulations do not apply to border waters.

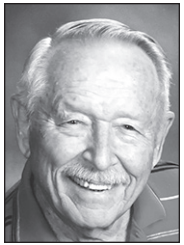
DAVID MEYER

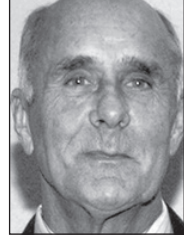
BENNETT GARNER

The candidate filing period in Crow Wing County for the 2022 election is May 17-31 for the following offices and filing fees are as noted:

**For all federal offices:**

US Representative for District 8 (\$300)

**For all state offices:**

State Senator District 6 (\$100), State Senator District 10 (\$100), State Representative District 6A (\$100), State Representative District 6B (\$100), State Representative District 10A (\$100), Governor and Lieutenant Governor (\$300), Secretary of State (\$300), Attorney General (\$300), State Auditor (\$300), Judges (\$300).

**For all county offices:**

County Commissioner District 2 (\$50), County Commissioner District 3 (\$50), County Commissioner District 4 (\$50), County Attorney (\$50), County Sheriff (\$50), Soil and Water Supervisor District 2 (\$20), Soil and Water Supervisor District 3 (\$20).

**City offices and townships**

City of Brainerd offices will also have filing dates of May 17- May 31. City of Brainerd filing fees are \$5. Candidates for the City of Brainerd will

file at the Brainerd city hall.

- City of Brainerd offices up for election in 2020 include: Alderman Ward 2, Alderman Ward 4, Alderman At-Large (1 seat), Mayor
- For all other cities and those townships with November elections the filing period is August 2- 16.

Candidates interested in city or township office should contact their local clerk to find out what offices are up for election in 2022.

Filing fees for city and township offices is \$2.

**School board**

Candidate filing periods for the Brainerd, Crosby-Ironton, and Pequot Lakes school districts are August 2 - 16. Persons interested in running for school board should contact the business office at their district for more information.

**Where to file**

Candidates for federal office must file at the Office of the Secretary of State. Candidates for state office may file with the Secretary of State, or with the county auditor in the county where they reside. Candidates for Crow Wing County office must file at the elections office at the Historic

Courthouse, 326 Laurel Street in Brainerd. Candidates for city or township office must file with their city or town clerk. Candidates for school board file with the school district clerk or designated officer.

**Requirements**

To run for office, a candidate must meet all of these

requirements:

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be an eligible voter
- Must be 21 years or older upon assuming office
- Must have maintained residence in their district for at least 30 days before the general election
- Pay all filing fees or present a petition in place of filing fee as allowed by statute

requirements:

- Complete and file an affidavit of candidacy
  - Complete and file campaign finance reports
- Redistricting may have adjusted candidate's legislative or commissioner districts and candidates are encouraged to visit [www.crowwing.us](http://www.crowwing.us) for more information.
