


Summer is Here, Be Kind!



Underwater Cleanup Set for June 4

by Steve Weisman Clean water... that's the focus of the many lakes' protective associations, organizations and individual in the Iowa Great Lakes. One of the huge issues right now is the problem of littering. We see it on the roadsides, pretty much everywhere we go. Unfortunately, a huge trash receptacle



and waterways. Just look along shorelines, in the shallows and you'll see the ugliness of littering...and in the very waters we profess to hold near and dear to us!

That being said, people are fighting back against littering, and one of those opportunities is coming on Saturday, June 4 with an Underwater Cleanup with the goal to "Keep Okoboji Blue." Kyle Hamilton, organizer, says, "We're bringing back the Underwater Cleanup that was so popular with underwater divers back in the 1970s and 1980s in Okoboji.'

Headquarters will be at Boji Divers at Okoboji Boat Works in Smiths Bay (1401 Lake Shore Drive) with registration and check in running from 8:00 to 9:00am.

It will be a full day of diving, cleaning up, along with an underwater scavenger hunt, prizes, giveaways and free food for participating divers. The goal is to potentially have divers also work on East Okoboji and Big Spirit.

For recreational boaters and fishermen on the lakes Saturday, June 4, watch for the diver flags and make sure to stay at least 50 feet away. Also, outside of 50 feet, vessel operators must operate at idle speed out to a distance of 150 feet.

Hamilton encourages people to pass the word. "Please help us promote this Underwater Cleanup to help keep Okoboji blue." To learn more, you can reach out to Hamilton at 612-720-8111 or 712-338-0438 at the Boji Divers. You can also search

YMCA Provides Update on the Igniting a Healthy Legacy Campaign and Projects Timeline

The Bedell Family YMCA Aquatics Center renovation, as part of the Igniting a Healthy Legacy Campaign, has been under

way since late March of 2022. Restorations completed to date are the east windows replacement, demolition prep work, pool and play feature pumps installed, and play feature footings poured and cured. Other renovations are in progress due to shipping and manufacturing



delays. Barring any other logistical delays, the Aquatics Center is now tentatively planned to reopen on June 13.

Other construction plans in the Igniting a Healthy Legacy Campaign's scope have also been affected. Based on the original project estimates, fundraising was nearing 100% in February 2022, due to the hard work of our campaign volunteers. However, with inflation of construction materials, the actual bids for the Aquatics Center renovation increased by 17%, with Camp Foster projects jumping by 40%. Due to these changes, the Campaign's construction timeline has been adjusted.

Andrew Fisher, CEO of the YMCA of the Okobojis, provided insight on the revised timeline. "Due to the heightened impact of inflation, construction costs have increased beyond our original campaign fundraising goal. While we were able to meet that initial Campaign goal, we will now be moving forward with a two-phased approach for construction at the direction of our Board of Directors and campaign volunteers. This will allow us to progress with a number of our campaign initiatives while continuing to raise funds towards our adjusted fundraising goal."

Phase 1 of the campaign will include the Bedell Family YMCA Aquatics Center renovations, the Camp Foster Dining Hall expansion, the Camp Foster Airnasium construction, as well as the retirement of long-term organizational debt and the partial funding of our endowment growth goal. Construction of the Dining Hall and Airnasium is scheduled to take place later this year.

Funds will continue to be raised towards the Phase 2 projects. Phase 2 will include the Camp Foster Visitors Center, Health Center, and Camper Cabin projects, as well as additional endowment growth.

The Igniting a Healthy Legacy Campaign is the YMCA's campaign to renovate the Bedell Family YMCA's Aquatics Center, provide new and renovated structures at Camp Foster to further support the camping and local community, and enhance organizational sustainability by growing the organization's endowment and eliminating long term organizational debt. Including the increased construction costs, 72% of the Igniting a Healthy Legacy Campaign's total has been funded.
