#### **Time to Come Together**

Yet another mass shooting happened this past week in Uvalde, Texas, when a gunman killed his grandmother and then turned his carnage on an elementary school, killing 19 students and two teachers while injuring 17 more students and staff. These mass shootings are becoming way too common in the United States, with 213 of them alone in just 21 weeks of 2022. What is even more disturbing is that we have already had 27 school shootings in 2022; a place where we send our children to learn and grow is becoming less and less safe as each day passes.

I don't have the answer for how to stop these mass shootings, but I know something needs to change in our country as we have by far and away more mass shootings than any country in the world, averaging nearly 10 per week so far in 2022. I know one answer is our two political parties need to figure out a way to work together to make things safe for our children. I know one group believes that "guns kill people", while the other side believes "people kill people"; as with most things, the truth is in the middle, people with guns are killing people, and doing so at an alarming rate. I support our 2nd Amendment to Bear Arms 100%, but also know that we need to find a way to keep guns out of the hands of those who are not mentally capable of owning a gun. I find it odd that an 18-year-old can't go buy a 12 pack of beer (which they shouldn't be allowed to) or rent a vehicle, but can go purchase an AR-15 and ammunition. Not only do we need to examine our gun laws, in my opinion, more importantly is we need to have a larger focus on mental health in our country, especially among our youth. I'm not sure if it's because they spend so much time on their phones and social media, or if playing violent video games has something to do with it, but it appears that mental health is becoming an epidemic in this country and we need to figure out how to identify mental health warnings as well as treatments.

As I said above, I fully support Americans legally owning guns, and we love supporting our area organizations that stress gun safety and the responsible use of guns like Pheasants Forever, Ducks Unlimited and our fantastic Trap Shooting teams and leagues. We have to come together as a country and figure out how to responsibly put firearms in the hands of those who want to own them and who are mentally capable of owning them, while also figuring out how to improve our mental health system. I surely don't have the answers to how to do this, but I do know that if we keep pointing fingers and blaming each other, these mass shootings will continue and we will continue to lose more innocent lives. When is enough, enough?

The Red Cross Blood Drive was held on Monday May 16, 2022, at the Senior Center in Spirit Lake.


