Aitkin Principal Karelis retires; Band Director Halvorson moves to Kuwait

By ANN SCHWARTZ Retiring Aitkin High School principal Paul Karelis notes that this past school year was the most difficult of his 37 years in education.

"We lost three students in our graduating class, a sophomore and a staff member this year," he noted. "Coping with those deaths made a very difficult year for the Aitkin School District. There were lots of changes we didn't see coming - Covid and other issues. It's been a tough year."

Born and raised in Aitkin County on a farm south of

town, Karelis headed to the University of Minnesota majoring in environmental science and agricultural education and meeting his wife Kelly.

Paul's dad, John, was a mechanic, farmer, county commissioner and bus driver and mom Eileen (Sjodin) was raised locally in the Elm Island Lake area and spent her life as a homemaker.

Paul taught five years in Wisconsin, where he also coached football and then spent 25 years in Worthington as a teacher and administrator. In Worthington, they and the way that education is had 954 students and a strong emphasis on agricultural education.

"Then I came back home and was here at Aitkin High School for the last seven years." This year's graduating class has been with him since they were seventh graders.

Facing a teacher shortage will be a nationwide problem in the near future. Districts will be more creative using community experts and teachers not licensed in the specific areas in which they teach. "I think it is the pay

changing so rapidly - online learning and changes make it more difficult as time goes on. The way we teach is changing."

Today's teens are inundated with information but they are expected to learn as much as past students and also to master technology. "Kids have instant access to information - they want instant gratification and the introduction of cell phones makes it hard for kids to concentrate because they always focus on their


