



This has been a difficult spring for us. Since Monday, June 6 through Tuesday, June 14, we have received over 180 animals. It is a physically demanding and a heart wrenching time for shelter employees; however, we prefer receiving all those animals to what happens in many cases – abandonment. It is chilling when people call to ask if we will accept their animals and when our answer is, as always, "yes," and the response is, "Oh good, I didn't want to put them out on the street."

Through the years, we have received hundreds of calls (maybe even thousands, actually) about animals being abandoned. Dogs, cats, rabbits, ferrets, and guinea pigs have all been rescued from cages on the side of the road, from median strips, at dumpster sites (sometimes in a taped box), and a myriad of other places. Sometimes, a dog's neck appears to have had a collar removed. The physical condition of the animals range from being in good condition to being emaciated or injured and near death.

The one they all have in common is the look in their eyes from being scared or confused.

That look usually goes away when they are rescued, brought to the shelter, fed, watered, and put in a comfortable resting spot.

Abandonment is against the law in Virginia; it is a Class 3 misdemeanor. The Comprehensive Animal Care portion of the Code defines abandonment as: "'Abandon' means to desert, forsake, or absolutely give up an animal without having secured another owner or custodian for the animal or by failing to provide the elements of basic care as set forth in 3.2-6503 for a period of four consecutive days."

Several years ago, the Virginia Legislature included companion animals

under the litter laws. At first, this may seem offensive to group pets in with garbage, but it actually is a very good step. However, if the person is charged under the litter laws, the crime is a Class 1 misdemeanor. The law itself is very well-written: "It shall be unlawful for any person to dump or otherwise dispose of trash, garbage, refuse, litter, a companion animal for the purpose of disposal, or other unsightly matter, on public property, including a public highway, right-of-way, property adjacent to such highway or right-ofway, or on private property without the written consent of the owner thereof or his agent."

Under the Class 3 misdemeanor abandonment laws, a person can be fined not more than \$500. Under the Class 1 misdemeanor litter laws, a person can be confined in jail for not more than twelve months, and fined not more than \$2,500, either or both

We will pay a reward for information leading to the arrest of anyone abandoning an animal in the City or in Pittsylvania County. The reward money comes from donations.

If you know of anyone who has abandoned an animal, please call us. Abandonment is illegal and cruel.




Salutatorian Amari Graves began her speech with an open letter to her high school, followed by dedications to friends and teachers.



SENIOR NEWS LINE

We've known for years that walking is a good form of exercise for seniors ... we just didn't know why. Now a new study not only explains how it works, but why brisk walking is even more effective. Ten years ago, researchers at Leicester University Biomedical Research Centre started looking at genetic data in the biobanks in the U.K. for clues about why seniors who walk seemed to live longer. They didn't fool around with a dozen or so participants. No, they analyzed the information of over 405,000 people.

And now we know: It's the telomere length. Telomeres (aka leucocyte telomere length, or LTLs) are the "end caps" on strands of DNA, the building blocks of our bodies and an indicator of our biological age. Fast walkers have longer LTLs, and therefore better health ... and longer lives.

That same study showed that as little as 10 minutes per day of brisk walking can equate to longer lives. (The Mayo Clinic prefers 30 minutes of activity per day, possibly broken into three 10-minute sessions.) The best walking pace appears to be 3 mph, although the research data was from wearable tracking devices like those we use to measure steps per day.

But there's more. A study at the National Institutes of Health concluded that the length of the telomeres is positively associated with consuming fruits, dairy, 100% fruit juice and coffee. On the other hand, food and drinks with high amounts of sugar and red meat can negatively affect the telomere length. The study gave a big thumbs up to the Mediterranean diet, with loads of nuts, fruits, vegetables, unrefined cereals, fish and olive oil.

If you invest in a pedometer to measure your steps, be sure to look for one that tracks your speed. Ask your doctor about any recommendations they have for the trackers.







Homeless Vet Falls Through the Cracks

The Department of Veterans Affairs creates numerous programs to deal with homeless veteran populations -- and this is all well and good. But it's the individual homeless vet who can fall through the cracks.

The VA Office of Inspector General reports about a veteran (I'll assume here it was a guy) who had multiple physical conditions on top of severe cognitive impairment. Years ago, he was given housing assistance and an evaluation and made part of a program. Eventually, he was booted out of the housing and thus booted out of the help program.

In the space of seven months, he took himself to the emergency room at a VA hospital a dozen times for various medical conditions, most a result of living outside or in a car. They admitted him for 33 days while he got evaluated for his cognitive functioning and had his medical conditions cared for. They discharged him and sent him off in a cab to a non-VA shelter.

For whatever reason, an hour later, he showed up at the ER again. They gave him a bus ticket to the shelter. The trip involved changes of buses, not an easy trick for someone with severe cognitive impairment. An hour later, he again showed up at the ER. Once more, they gave him a bus ticket and a printed list of instructions, telling him to go to the shelter. The next day, a social worker discovered that he never made it to the shelter, and the following day, the family filed a missing person report.

Three days later, he was found at the shelter. A reading of the OIG report shows one misstep after the other, with staffers putting a cognitively impaired veteran on a bus and not using one of the donated Uber gift cards and having him delivered right to the door of the shelter. In a large bowl, using a hand mixer, beat together eggs and sugar until light and fluffy, about 4 minutes. Add sour cream, vegetable oil, lemon zest, and vanilla and beat on low until just incorporated.

In a medium-size bowl, whisk together flour, baking powder, salt, and baking soda. Add the flour mixture to the wet half at a time, mixing in-between. Be careful not to overmix.

In a small bowl, add blueberries and sprinkle over the flour. Toss to coat the blueberries. Add floured blueberries to the muffin batter and fold

Using an ice cream scoop, fill muffin liners to the top with batter.

Place muffin pan in the oven and bake at 425 for 5 minutes THEN LOWER TEMPERATURE TO 375 and bake for 25 minutes or until tops are golden and a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean.

Remove muffins from oven and let cool in the pan for 5 minutes. Remove the muffins from the pan and cool completely on a cooling rack.

Lemon Glaze

In a small bowl, whisk together the powdered sugar and lemon juice. Drizzle glaze over the cooled muffins. Enjoy!


