## ROASTED PEPPER SALAD WITH FETA, PINE NUTS, \& BASIL

## 4 Servings

## Ingredients

- 4 bell peppers (any combination of red, yellow or orange), halved, seeded and cored
- 2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 2 teaspoons red wine vinegar
- 1 small garlic clove, minced
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh basil, divided
- $1 / 2$ teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- $3 / 4$ teaspoon salt
- $1 / 8$ teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- 3 tablespoons pine nuts
- 2 ounces (a scant $1 / 2$ cup) crumbled Feta
- $1 / 3$ cup pitted kalamata olives


## Instructions

1. Set an oven rack in the top position and preheat the broiler. Line a baking sheet with aluminum foil.
Place the pepper halves on the prepared baking sheet and broil for 5-10 minutes, rotating the pan once, until well charred. Remove the peppers from the oven and place in a bowl; cover tightly with plastic wrap (so they steam) and let cool until luke warm.
2. Peel the skin from the peppers (do not rinse under water) and cut into $3 / 4$-inch strips. Place back in the bowl; add the olive oil, red wine vinegar, garlic, 2 tablespoons of the basil, oregano, sugar, salt and pepper. Refrigerate for at least one hour or overnight.
3. Heat a small skillet over medium heat. Add the pine nuts and cook, stirring frequently, until golden, about 4 minutes. Immediately transfer the nuts to a small bowl to stop the cooking process. (Pay close attention: they go from perfectly golden to burnt quickly.)
4. Transfer the marinated peppers to a serving dish and top with the feta, olives, toasted pine nuts and remaining tablespoon basil (do not toss). Garnish with whole basil leaves if desired.

CREAMY CORN SALAD
10 Servings

## Ingredients

- 2 lbs. Frozen corn, thawed under cool running water
- 1 cup diced red bell pepper
- $1 / 4$ cup diced purple onion
- 1 jalapeño pepper, seeded and diced
- $1 / 2$ cup plain greek yogurt

- $1 / 2$ cup mayo
- $1 / 2$ tsp salt
- $1 / 2$ tsp black pepper
- $1 / 4$ tsp garlic powder
- $1 / 4$ cup chopped cilantro


## Instructions

1. Combine the corn, red bell pepper, onion and jalapeño in a large bowl.
2. In a separate bowl whisk together the yogurt, mayo, salt, pepper and garlic powder. Gently stir into the corn mixture. Add in the chopped cilantro and stir. Refrigerate until ready to serve.

## Notes

Salad can be made up to a day ahead of time, but sauce does thin out the longer it stands. Best if enjoyed within 2 days.

## Claybank Master Gardeners July 2022 <br> Greetings Gardeners,

**With a heat index running over $100^{\circ}$ gardening activity is restricted to early morning for this gardener, and hopefully for most of you, too. (Although some of you may be like a couple of friends recently retired from over 30 years in missionary work in Indonesia who say it's not even humid here!)
** Garden tip: I have put shade cloth netting next to my tomato plants to protect them from the scorching afternoon sun. Tomatoes like heat, but most varieties won't produce new fruit in temperatures over 90 degrees, or when night temperatures are above 70 degrees. More frequent watering is necessary to even maintain most fruit-bearing veggies.
** In June Bence Carter, Regional Extension Agent in Forestry Wildlife and Natural
Resources, spoke to the Claybank Master Gardeners about snakes of Alabama. Although many people are so afraid of snakes, they will kill any they see, Bence emphasizes the importance of NOT killing snakes, because of the $\mathbf{6 0}$ known species here in Alabama only 6 are actually venomous, and the rest are beneficial. The six venomous ones are copperheads, cottonmouths, pigmy rattlesnakes, eastern diamondback rattlesnakes, timber or canebrake rattlesnakes, and eastern coral snakes. Pit-vipers, the first 5 on this list, are recognizable by their thin necks and "cat-like" pupils of their eyes. Coral snakes are recognizable by the red, black, and yellow bands running across their bodies. ("Red on black, a friend of Jack; red on yellow, kill a fellow.") The rest are harmless and beneficial, as they feed on insects and disease-carrying rodents. Did you know that black or indigo snakes are natural enemies of rattlesnakes? If you go online to www.aces.edu/blog/ topics/forestry-wildlife/identification you will find great information and photos to help identify friend or foe in the realm of snakes.
** If you farm, and wild hogs are your nemesis, call Bence. He is also the agent for all of AL who can advise on hog management.
**According to the SOW app, you can still plant corn, pumpkins, southern peas, tomatoes, \& watermelons at this time.
** The Claybank Master Gardeners usually meet on the second Wednesday of the month at Hoppergrass Restaurant in Ozark, 129 East Ave., across from Milky Moos. Come join us, we love new faces.
