

SPEAK OUT

Dear "Speakout",

The Decline of American Education. I want to be positive in my comments while at the same time being honest as to the state of our public-school educational system today.

I attended a high school graduation in a Livingston County high school a few years ago and heard the valedictorian in his speech thank his English teacher for teaching him and his classmates how to copy and paste from internet sources into English composition assignments so they would not have to compose the compositions themselves.

This is very sad as many high school graduates cannot compose a letter or document on their own.

Recently I was at an area store and had finished placing my items on the conveyor when the power went off. My purchase total was visible on the register, so I gave cash to the young cashier for my purchase. She became very confused and said that she did not know how to make change. I told her what the change would be, and she asked me how I did that. I told her that I was taught in school how to calculate in my head.

She asked for help from her supervisor who verified my calculation was correct. The young cashier in the next aisle commented that he didn't have to learn how to calculate in his head and relied on a calculator in school. He then commented that because he had not been taught to read and write cursive, he could not read portions of his own high school diploma which was in cursive.

A study of 2021 high school graduates who cannot read cursive totaled over 700,000. This is called the "Dumbing down of America". Is our educational system improving or failing?

Many parents today are so busy making money that they do not know the content of their children's curriculum and homework and therefore do not fully understand what their children are learning. The SAT Reading scores in 1972 averaged 530 while they were 494 in 2016. SAT writing scores declined from 497 in 2006 to 482 in 2016.

Public schools have instituted sliding scales to make students feel better by averaging scores, so no student feels bad. This does not help our students.

The average cost for a public-school student's education in Livingston County is \$18,770 while the national average is \$12,383 per student. One public school in our county spends over \$22,000 per student and has the lowest SAT and College Board scores in the county. It seems the more we spend on education, the lower the educational level of our students.

More than 1240 of the nation's 2330 bachelor's degree-granting schools have said they did not require students to submit ACT/SAT scores for admission in 2020. Academic standards in the 1600s and 1700s were significantly higher than they are today.

By removing prayer and Bible reading from our public schools, the number of young women with out of wedlock children has skyrocketed. We removed the Ten Commandments from our public schools and no longer teach our students that they should not kill.

As a result, school shootings are escalating enormously. Our children are our future and legacy. We need to restore high-quality education for our children so they can be productive citizens in our wonderful country and function to their fullest.

Lord willing, I will submit an article again next week. Ron Powell Nunda

The Dangers of Indoor Tanning

In preparation for summer, it may be tempting to visit a tanning booth or bed. These were once thought of as a "safe alternative" to natural sunlight, but in reality, tanning beds are just as dangerous for your skin as the sun. Tanning beds give off high levels of ultraviolet, or UV, radiation, which damages the skin. Although you may not see the effects immediately, it can increase your chances of developing skin cancer in the future. According to the Skin Cancer Foundation, just one indoor tanning session can increase the likelihood of melanoma by 75%. Indoor tanning can also cause immune system suppression and complication with vision and eye health, including cataract development and eye cancer.

One in five Americans are estimated to be diagnosed with skin cancer in the course of a lifetime. Although preventable, thousands of people die from skin cancer each year. There are two forms of skin cancer. Non-melanoma skin cancers are those that are localized to one area of the body and do not spread to other systems or organs in the body. They are usually found on areas of the skin that are most exposed to UV radiation, such as the face, hands, and neck. Melanoma skin cancer is more dangerous, and results from repeated overexposure to UV rays. Melanoma can spread to other parts of the body, making it more dangerous and deadly if left untreated.

Both forms of cancer are highly treatable when detected in their early stages, so take time to talk to your doctor about a skin cancer screening. However, avoiding indoor tanning beds all together is the safest and easiest way to avoid skin cancer. Remember to wear sunblock of at least SPF 30 if you are going out in the sun and reapply every two hours.




