# New Thai/Asian restaurant strengthens Crosby's revival



A new Thai restaurant, Drunken Noodle, is scheduled to open in 2023 at 102 West Main Street in Crosby.

There is a new dining option on the horizon for the Cuyuna region. The business partners of 30 West Main LLC, owners of the Crosby Lofts and Rafferty's building, have announced the signing of a lease in a new building with Thamrong "Keng" Dechawuth, owner of Thai restaurants the Drunken Noodle in Fargo and Tara Thai in Bemidji.

Dechawuth's new Thai restaurant in Crosby will be located in the soon-to-be-renovated building at 102 West Main Street and is slated to open in early 2023. The new venture will be called "Drunken Noodle" and it will feature fresh, traditional. Thai dishes with locally sourced ingredients, plus other innovative southeast Asian cuisine.

The 30 West Main partners extensively surveyed their guests at Crosby Lofts, as well as their social media following throughout the entire local area, and the state, revealing the need for local Thai/ Asian food. According to 30 West Main partner, Nick Summers: "The results in the restaurant category showed that a majority of responses desired Thai/Asian food to be available in the Cuyuna region. When we reviewed the Thai/Asian restaurants in northern Minnesota, we learned about Keng and his popular restaurants in Fargo and Bemidji. We knew his food would be a good fit that will benefit the CCSRA and the region year

around." Dechawuth is a native of ThaiStates to study electrical engineering at the University of Southern California in the late 1990s and graduated with a master's degree in 2000. However, he soon found his true passion in the restaurant industry and in 2009, he opened Drunken Noodle in Fargo, followed by the Bemidji location.

"I am excited about opening the new restaurant in Crosby-it will be a fun, family restaurant," said Dechawuth. "Whether you eat in the restaurant or order carry out, our dishes will be good, fast, comfort food. This area's mountain bicycling and the guiet lakes are some of the things I like about Minnesota and I know the visitors and residents will enjoy our food."

Dechawuth and his staff are already looking forward to enjoying the variety of outdoor activities that the Cuyuna region offers, from spending holidays with their families, to learning mountain bicycling, or going fishing.

30 West Main partner Susan Arndt added: "My husband Doug and I have so many memories and good times of this area. It's

Lathrop said he is considering other business options and that as a community, Hill City is beginning to thrive. "Our town is a work in progress," he summed up.






