VIP wristbands are valid for unlimited rides all nine days of the Fair. These wristbands are \$55 in advance, saving amusement goers \$5 when purchased in advance.

Fair Food Bucks are a special for fairgoers. Each Fair Food Buck is worth \$1 and can be redeemed for food or beverage at any non-carnival food and beverage vendor at the 2022 Fair. Fair Food Bucks can be purchased at the Events Center Box Office (Monday-Friday, 8:30am-5:00pm).

For the last several months the people of Ukraine have been torn from their homes. More than 4.9 Million people are now refugees in other countries and starving. Much like northwest Iowa, the Ukraine is an agricultural area and is known for its wheat production - it is literally the breadbasket of Europe. Due to the Russian invasion, forcing farmers out, crops are not being planted which will have a potentially long term impact on the area.

The trade of Taylor Rogers, who is second in MLB with 22 saves, with San Diego for Pagan and Chris Paddack has been nothing short of a disaster. Paddack is out for the season with an elbow injury, and Pagan has given up an astounding 29 runs in his last 34 innings pitched. This bullpen is so bad that it made me come out of my June/July basketball writing hiatus to address it! Let's hope the front office does something soon, or Twins' fans won't even have to worry about extending our playoff losing streak!

Parsons continued that the Fair Association is also always

looking for new members.

"I think it's a myth in the community that we are a closed organization," he said. "In reality, anyone (including non-Clay County residents) can be a member of the Fair Association."

Any individual or business is eligible to become a member upon payment of the \$100 lifetime membership fee. The Association is currently composed of 839 lifetime members – 787 individual members and 52 associate members. Individual members have the right to vote and hold office. Associate Members are non-individuals (businesses, organizations, political subdivisions, etc.) that can attend meetings, but cannot vote or hold office. Originally, members were called "stockholders" because they purchased "shares" in the Association that could be transferred to other individuals or businesses. Changes in Iowa law, however, caused that system to be eliminated in 2011.

The membership gathers each October for an annual meeting which includes an election for the Board of Directors.
