**Historical Film Premieres Across** Michiana The House of David has always been mys-

terious. From the stories of its leader and his high-profile trial, to the organizations' immense wealth, countless enterprises and inventions, to their world famous baseball team, there is a lot of information on the organization, but not many answers. That is why Chris Siriano, the Founder and Director of the House of David Museum, has executive produced a new documentary shedding light on its origins and history titled, 'House of David, Life Everlasting.'

"I was a history major at Western and after returning home after eight years of school, I decided to learn about our local history, but couldn't find much," Siriano explains. "I went to the libraries and everywhere, the more I read the more I kept finding out about the House of David. I started to learn that it was more than just an amusement park and I really started diving in deep. The more I learned, the more I realized that someone had to preserve their story."

The House of David Amusement Park in Benton Harbor drew approximately 75 million visitors to the area between 1908 to 1973. They had hotels on Main Street in Benton Harbor, some in the amusement park and kept hotels like The Vincent and The Whitcomb booked. At one point in time there would be up to five cruise ships docked in St. Joe, with visitors disembarking to make a stop at the famous amusement park, which was the past equivalent to Disneyland with its rides, a zoo, orchestras and band performances, vaudeville shows and miniature raceway featuring gas powered cars, which were a novelty at the time.

"As I studied them I found that they had multiple enterprises at the time such as Charley



However, while googling this phenomenon I've stumbled upon a number of goofy factoids about bird names, and - lucky you! - I'm inspired to develop some modest proposals for new names giving these "Common" birds more pomp, prestige, and panache!

One source of inspiration is a treasure trove of "alternate" names for the birds of Great Britain and Europe. A Swiss naturalist named Michel Desfayes spent decades obsessively collecting local, colloquial names that people have laid on various species over the centuries

Here's a handful of interesting monikers for birds that already have non-Common names: "Johanna of the Dunghill" for the Pied Wagtail; "Dickey Hedge-poker" for the Dunnock; "Shaking Pettychaps" for the Wood Warbler.

My favorite has to be "Cold Arse Bird." for a songbird known as the Fieldfare. Naturalists describe this bird's rump as "frosty-gray," and it appears in Britain in "the chill of autumn." Thus, the Cold Arse Bird, foretelling the coming of temperatures that will also turn human rumps frosty gray

One more: Sailors called the Black-legged Kittiwake "Tickle Arse." Why? Because Kittiwakes (a type of gull) gather their food by pursuing other birds and pestering them into dropping the food THEY'VE caught by pecking at their, ummmm, hind regions.

Ok, finally, let's start this column, with my suggestions for getting the "Common" out of those bird names

Common Loon: It's been called - maybe still is, somewhere? - this excellent alternate name;

"Hell-diver." I could just stop there, but then I wouldn't be able to mention that the Hell-diver's Latin name is Gavia immer; and more importantly, that it's known as "Imber Diver" in some countries; and even more importantly, that there's a song called "Imber Diver," by - most important of all - a band named The Drunken Sufis.

Common Merganser: "Big Sawbill" is a pretty good colloquial replacement that already exists. But we could also devise a new name from this description of its cooked flesh: "Rank, like an old kerosene lamp-wick." Hence, the "Lamp-wick Merganser"!

Common Nighthawk: "Bull-bat," and "Mosquito Hawk," have been used for this bird. I personally love "Piramidig" - apparently a human translation of the bird's sounds, which I read somewhere are short, nasal and utterly unmusical. In short, callithumpian.

Side note about Nighthwaks: They belong to a family of birds referred to as "goatsuckers." Their huge, some say "grotesque," mouths and nocturnal habits creeped people out in days gone by. In fact, the immortal philosopher Aristotle promoted these fake facts about goatsuckers: "They bee night-theeves, coming into the sheepherd's goat-pens, and sucking the milke from the goat udders, which then falleth away. AND the goats become BLIND to booteth! Hey, I'm Aristotle! I knoweth what I talketh about!

Common Yellowthroat: This one is easy - call it the Domino Warbler! Because the black coloration on its face looks like a domino mask - the small rounded kind that only covers around the eyes. Think the Lone Ranger, or Catwoman, or Mr. Incredible, or jillions of other superheroes who use this miniscule disguise to COMPLETELY obscure their real identity! And nobody wore it as well as Zorro! - for YEARS, it fooled even his own father!

Cars bus lines, 100 acres farmland, numerous hotels, a diamond mine in Australia, a gold mine west Oklahoma, a coal mine in Kentucky, furniture building companies, and resorts and factories around the world," Siriano explains. "In fact, during World War I, when Woodrow Wilson tried to ration use of coal, that was when they bought the coal mine and trucks would come back and forth from Kentucky delivering coal. The City of Benton Harbor ended up buying their power from them for a time."

House of David is credited with inventing the pin setting machine for bowling alleys, cross propellers for cruise ships to keep them from tipping over in wavy conditions, the self-flushing toilet, the process for putting grape juice into



a can and the forklift. They were also hired by NASA in the 60's to figure out how to take food into space inventing the process for space food used today and built one of the first automobiles, which currently sits in the American Auto Museum

"When I started studying them there were six or seven members that still remained and I was lucky that they kept inviting me over to tell their stories," says Chris. "I have volumes of notepads and over 10,000 photos in the <u>House of</u> <u>David Museum</u> that tell the story of who they were and all that they accomplished. While they were a high-profile organization, they were very mysterious mainly because the way they lived so oddly from the norm. They grew their own food, generated their own energy, made their own clothes, and didn't come to the outside world for anything."

One of the most notable aspects that people know about of the House of David was their baseball team.

"It was the only Caucasian team that played in the Negro Leagues. They couldn't play in the major leagues because they did not shave or cut their hair. They played all over America from 1914 to 1954. They traveled with African American teams and were a part of breaking the color barrier in that sport before Jackie Robinson entered the major leagues," says Siriano, "In fact, the Negro League Baseball Museum in Kansas City has a display about them that gives them a nod for helping breaking color barrier."



"I was fortunate enough to have lived around the (remaining) members for 25 years. They are deceased now, but I talked to them for hours at a time and I wanted to tell the real story, and the facts and dispel the rumors."

The documentary will delve deep into the House of David, explain the roots and beliefs of their religion and introduce some of their accom-




