

By ANN SCHWARTZ The Aitkin City Council and its Planning Commission voted on July 5 to grant a variance and conditional use permit to Bonham Construction, which allows a Tractor Supply store to locate in the former Shopko building in Aitkin. The votes were unanimous, with Trevor Betley abstaining on the planning commission vote due to

business conflicts. The measure allows the company to remove some parking spots and add to the impervious (non-porous) surface of the 4-acre site, as well as build a 16-foot fence and construct a greenhouse area. The greenhouse goes

on the east side of the present building.

Don Bonham joined the Planning Commission meeting via cellphone. He expressed concern about obtaining a stormwater permit that could hold up construction until spring. "That could kill the deal for this year."

Administrator Mike Skrbich said that the city's engineers are researching to discover if there ever was a stormwater permit issued for the building and site and that it will have to be addressed in the future. He said it is a requirement of the state of Minnesota.

Skrbich said that Bonham Construction has already

applied for a building permit for the building site and noted that Tractor Supply has a trend of moving into former Shopko buildings in small towns.

Tractor Supply carries products related to livestock and poultry; pets, farm and ranch; horses, cooling, outdoor living; lawn and garden, sporting goods, home decor, clothing and boots and shoes. There is a store in Little Falls.

# Funds to buy or repair homes

Grants of up to \$10,000 are available to homeowners 62 and older and must be used to remove health or safety hazards, such as fixing a leaking roof, installing indoor plumbing, or replacing a furnace.

Willy Wonka had nothing on T-Ladd. An avid treat-eater, he taught his grandkids there is nothing wrong with eating pie for breakfast (or lunch or dinner). He had the diet of a 12-year-old, and would often be found munching on snacks and goodies (cheese balls, popcorn, donuts, Ritz crackers with peanut butter and jelly, the list goes on) instead of eating "real" meals. Terry loved his simple life, spent almost entirely in Palisade. From making the sweetest syrups and jams from his own raspberry bushes, to mowing his grass in his floppy hat, to planting and babying his flowers (Terry's secret: some of them are fake) and vegetables. His interest in history was passed on to his grandkids, who will always remember his TV being set to World War 2 and Nazi Germany documentaries, even during "uplifting" family gatherings. He also loved learning about family history and heritage. He shared this knowledge when he took his kids and grandkids on a trip to the orphanage where his dad lived. His wardrobe consisted of flannel, a year-round fashion choice that perfectly complemented his suspenders and faded jeans. Terry loved nature, and was able to enjoy the outdoors during his 30-year career as a park ranger at Sandy Lake for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The opening morning of rifle deer season took on "top holiday" status for Terry, and for decades, he hosted an opening morning breakfast where he and his guests shared stories of hunting seasons gone by. Deer hunting was a year-round endeavor for Terry, who spent hours drawing maps to plan drives, studying and sharing "trail cam" pictures with his nephews, and sighting in guns with his son and grandsons. Believe it or not, even though he was a sharpshooter in the Army, Terry didn't bag many deer. He always said he was "waiting for the big one," but we think he never wanted the hunt to end. Some of his ashes will be spread by his deer stand, so his hunt can forever continue. Terry's stage 4 cancer diagnosis was a time for him to show how he could make lemonade (with lots of sugar) out of lemons. 
