THE BUGLE BOY LISTENING ROOM



Tumbleweed Smith

Musicians from Texas and beyond perform at The Bugle Boy Listening Room in La Grange.

"They come here just because of our reputation as a great place to hear music," says Heather Allbright, Executive Director. "At The Bugle Boy there is no talking during a performance. We're a

Tumbleweed Smith little non - profit organization with 60 theater seats and room for 20 extra chairs, which makes a maximum audience size of 80. Our mission is to elevate and sustain original live music. Basically we are dedicated to the songwriters and their songs." Bugle Boy is in its 18th year. It started out as a coffee shop, but the only time it drew a crowd was when it had music. So music became the main attraction.

"Everybody says it's almost like having an intimate show in your own living room. People are able to come and see their favorite artists, meet them, visit with them, get their pictures taken with them and really get to know them a little bit."

Bugle Boy is in a World War Two barracks building on the north edge of town on Highway 77.

"We're Army Green in our paint scheme and have tried to keep some of that World War Two, Andrews Sisters type atmosphere."

Musicians who perform there must have 90 minutes of original material and are paid for their performances.

"We were the first fair trade venue in the state of Musicians have a guaranteed minimum or a large percentage of the door take, which ever is greater. They also get to keep all the income from their merchandise sales.

The facility has 90 shows a year on Friday and Saturday nights. Ticket prices are \$25, more for big name musicians.

"We have a long list of people who want to book annually, then we fit in these people who show interest. They contact us if they want to perform."

The shows are broadcast live on the website thebugleboy.org. Professional sound, lighting and video equipment are permanently installed to record and show musicians who play all types of music. Some performers record albums there because of the professional sound engineers.

"We have been told that we have some of the best sound around and that's why people will come and play here."

In between the performing groups' two 45-minute sets, guests can get beer, wine, coffee or root beer floats. Concerts start at 8 PM and are over by 10. ticket sales, funding comes from fundraisers, patrons and grants.







While employed at HCSO his determination and work ethic earned him several opportunities for advancement. He worked his way through the ranks, becoming a Sergeant and eventually a training officer. One of Melvin's proudest moments was in 2016, when he graduated from the East Texas Police Academy sponsored by Northeast Texas Community College in Mount Pleasant, Texas. On that day, he achieved the goal of becoming a Police Officer. Steve Martin

Comedy, Broadway, Movies, Music and more!



Martin was born on August 14, 1945 in Waco, Texas, the son of Mary Lee Stewart: and Glenn Vernon Martin, a real estate salesman and aspiring actor. He has an older sister, Melinda. Martin is of English, Scottish, Welsh, Scots-Irish, German, and French descent, and was raised in Inglewood, California with his sister, and then later in Garden Grove, California, in a Baptist family. Martin was a cheerleader of Garden Grove High School. One of his earliest memories is of seeing his father, as an extra, serving drinks onstage at the Call Board Theatre on Melrose Place. During World War II, in the United Kingdom, Martin's father had appeared in a production of Our Town with Raymond Massey. Expressing his affection through gifts, like cars and bikes, Martin's father was stern, and not emotionally open to his son. He was proud but critical, with Martin later recalling that in his teens his feelings for his father were mostly of hatred.

Martin's first job was at Disneyland, selling guidebooks on weekends and full-time during his school's summer break. That lasted for three years. During his free time, he frequented the Main Street Magic shop, where tricks were demonstrated to patrons.[By 1960, he had mastered several magic tricks and illusions and took a paying job at the Magic shop in Fantasyland in August. There he perfected his talents for magic, juggling, and creating balloon animals in the manner of mentor Wally Boag.

In his authorized biography, close friend Morris Walker suggests that Martin could "be described most accurately as an agnostic ... he rarely went to church and was never involved in organized religion of his own volition". After high school, Martin attended Santa Ana College, taking classes in drama and English poetry. He joined a comedy troupe at Knott's Berry Farm, Later, he met budding actress Stormie Sherk, and they developed comedy routines and became romantically involved. Sherk's influence caused Martin to apply to the California State University, Long Beach, for enrollment with a major in philosophy. Sherk enrolled at UCLA, about an hour's drive north, and the distance eventually caused them to lead separate lives. Inspired by his philosophy classes, Martin considered becoming a professor instead of an actor-comedian. His time at college changed his life.

Stand-up comedy - Late night

In 1967, his former girlfriend Nina Goldblatt, a dancer on The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour, helped Martin land a writing job with the show by submitting his work to head writer Mason Williams. Williams initially paid Martin out of his own pocket. Along with the other writers for the show. Martin won an Emmy Award in 1969 at the age of twenty-three. He wrote for The Glen Campbell Goodtime Hour and The Sonny and Cher Comedy Hour. Martin's first television appearance was on The Smothers Brothers Comedy Hour in 1968.

Personal life

In the late 1970s and early 1980s, Martin was in a relationship with Bernadette Peters, with whom he co-starred in The Jerk and Pennies from Heaven. He also dated Mary Tyler Moore and Karen Carpenter. On November 20, 1986, Martin married actress Victoria Tennant, with whom he co-starred in All of Me and L.A. Story, Later divorced. On July 28, 2007, Martin married writer and former New Yorker staffer Anne Stringfield. Bob Kerrey presided over the ceremony at Martin's Los Angeles home. Lorne Michaels served as best man. The nuptials came as a surprise to several guests, who had been told they were coming for a party. In December 2012, Martin became a father for the first time when Stringfield gave birth to a daughter.

Martin has been an avid art collector since 1968, when he bought a print by Ed Ruscha. In 2006, he sold Hopper's Hotel Window at Sotheby's for \$26.8 million. Martin served on the Los Angeles County Museum of Art board of trustees from 1984 to 2004. He organized an exhibition in 2019 with Gagosian Gallery titled "Desert Painters of Australia", which featured art by George Tiungurravi and Emily Kame Kngwarreve.

Martin suffers from tinnitus; the condition was first attributed to the filming a pistol-shooting scene for Three Amigos in 1986, but Martin later clarified that the tinnitus was actually from years of listening to loud music and performing in front of noisy crowds.
