Smokey Jake's BBQ restaurant fires up in downtown Aitkin

Smokey Jake's BBQ, which has operated a food truck around the area, opened in a remodeled store on Hwy. 210 in Aitkin, just west of the stoplight.

The owners are Jacob and Michiyo Schanz. Their son Erik also works with them, along with Jenna Rasmussen. The restaurant opened on July 7.

Jake Schanz, a retired Marine from Minnesota, raved about "our high-quality made-from-scratch smoked meat sold directly to customers," on a San Diego website. At that time, he operated a food

truck with two commercial smokers, that he later relocated to Minnesota.

Jake said he started hosting friends for BBQ when he worked in technology and then catering gigs blossomed from there. Then he did pop-ups at local breweries in San Diego.

The organization Main Street Launch helped him to buy his food truck and have working capital.

In Aitkin, the restaurant is open from Wednesday through Sunday. The menu features smoked sandwiches and sliders; burgers, grilled cheese, ribs and cold and hot side dishes.
