



HERITAGE WIND PROJECT **Orleans County, New York**

NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF 94-c MAJOR MODIFICATION REQUEST

On or about July 27, 2022, Heritage Wind, LLC ("Heritage" or "Applicant") will submit a Major Modification Request to the Office of Renewable Energy Siting (the "Office" or "ORES") pursuant to Section 94-c of the New York State Executive Law. The Heritage Wind Project, a major wind electric generating facility, was issued a Final Section 94-c Permit by ORES on January 13, 2022 in ORES Matter Number 21-00026. This notice announces that Heritage Wind is requesting a modification of its Permit under 19 NYCRR § 900-11.1(c) to relocate six previously permitted wind turbines within the Facility Area.

Under the proposed modification request, the Facility would consist of up to 31 wind turbines generating up to 200.1 megawatts (MW) of electricity to be located in the Town of Barre, Orleans County. Much of the permitted Facility is unchanged from the Final Permit issued in January 2022, and will include wind turbines, access roads, electrical collection lines, substations, permanent meteorological tower, temporary power performance towers, an operations and maintenance (0&M) building, and staging/laydown areas to be used during construction, and which may include a potential temporary concrete batch plant. A point of interconnection substation will be placed in the Town of Barre, along the existing National Grid Lockport-Mortimer 115 kV power line, to deliver electricity generated by the Facility to the New

York State electric grid, as previously proposed.

The Facility is a zero-emission wind energy facility that will assist the State in meeting the goals of the Climate Leadership and Protection Act and State Energy Plan, which includes obtaining 70% of energy generation from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive impacts of the Facility include diversification of energy supplies, new employment opportunities (both temporary construction employment and full-time jobs), and increased revenues to County and local tax bases, purchase of local supplies, goods and services. In addition, the Applicant has attempted to minimize impacts to land associated with the modified Facility components by limiting the disturbance to forested lands and wetlands to the maximum extent practicable. However, the construction and operation of the modified Facility components may result in some environmental impacts as more fully described in the Major Modification Request, including, but not limited to: impacts on terrestrial ecology, including avian and bat species; minor impacts to forested land, wetlands and agricultural lands; and impacts to people, including noise, traffic and visual impacts.

This notice is being provided in accordance with 19 NYCRR §§ 900-11.1(c) (1) and 1.6(c) and will be published at least three days prior to the filing of the Major

Modification Request. In addition, a copy of the Major Modification Request will be served on the Chief Executive Officer of each municipality in which any portion of the Facility is located, as well as those persons and agencies enumerated in 19 NYCRR 900-1.6(a).

Upon filing the Major Modification Request, given the proposed increase in base nameplate capacity from 184.8 MW to 200.1 MW, the Applicant will provide additional local agency funding in the amount of \$15,300 (\$1,000/MW of additional proposed base nameplate capacity), to be disbursed by the Office to local agencies and potential community intervenors to help pay expenses, including attorneys and consultants, associated with participating in the 94-c process. Within thirty (30) days of the date of the filing of the Major Modification Request, any local agency or potential community intervenor seeking funding from the local agency account must submit a request for initial funding to the Office of Renewable Energy Siting, at 99 Washington Avenue, Albany, New York 12231, Attention: Request for Local Agency Account Funding.



Can soft tissue injuries be prevented?

The American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons notes that many soft tissue injuries can be prevented with proper conditioning and training. Athletes also can employ some additional strategies to reduce their risk for soft tissue injuries.

Use proper equipment. Wear loose fitting clothing that promotes mobility and flexibility and replace athletic shoes as they wear out.



Aim for balance in your

fitness routine. Adhere to a fitness regimen that incorporates cardiovascular exercise, strength training and flexibility.

Warm up. Warm up by running for a few minutes or engaging in another mild physical activity before starting any highintensity exercise.

Stay hydrated. Drink water before, during and after exercise. Cool down. Gradually reduce the intensity of your movements as your workout winds down.

Stretch after exercise. Hold each stretch for 10 to 20 seconds before slowly and carefully releasing it.

Exercise daily. Aim for at least 20 minutes of moderate physical activity every day.







Travel Thoughts By Kim

Let's go on an adventure together....to Sonnenberg Gardens!

On Thursday, July 14th, I had the pleasure of visiting a local treasure - Sonnenberg Gardens in Canandaigua, NY. It was a day-trip organized by Mitzy Peglow of Orleans Travel for the Busy Buddies group I belong to. A comfortable motor coach took our group from Tops parking lot to our destination in Canandaigua the "Sonnenberg Gardens and Mansion State Historic Park" for the day. It was such a lovely day - I had a great time! I love doing day-trip bus tours. It gives me an opportunity to experience new things around our area without having to drive and find my way around. Perfect!

Sonnenberg Gardens is a 50-acre estate located at the north end of Canandaigua Lake in the beautiful Finger Lakes - originally a 300-acre farmstead. The property, open to the public from late spring to mid fall, was the summer home of Frederick Ferris Thompson and his wife Mary Clark Thompson. Frederick was a prominent New York City banker - one of the co-founders of what is now known as Citibank and JPMorgan Chase Bank. Mary was the daughter of former NY Governor Myron Holley Clark. The couple's primary home was in New York City, but they chose Mary's home town of Canandaigua for their summer residence. In 1887, they built a 40 room Queen Anne style mansion where the former farmhouse stood. Today, the property is managed by a non-profit organization that was formed in the early 1970s to restore the mansion and gardens. They have a year round staff of six, about 170 seasonal volunteers, and operate solely on funds raised from admissions, events, memberships/donations, and gift and wine sales. They receive no local, state, or federal funding. Given all that and some other facts from the history of the property, I think they do an awesome job.

We were left to explore the gardens and the mansion on our own. It was a lovely day to stroll around the property and take in the splendor and opulence of life in the gilded age. When I think of a summer home, I think of a small cottage on the lake....they built a 40 room mansion with bedrooms equipped with full bathrooms and large walk-in closets / dressing rooms in every one. The mansion is simply stunning and full of beautiful original furnishings and items that belonged to the Thompsons. While the gardens could use a little more tender loving care, it is easy to imagine how gorgeous the property must have been back in the Thompson's day.

The property consists of the mansion, nine gardens of various styles - including a wonderful Japanese garden, several green houses, a café that serves light lunches, a gift shop, and the Finger Lakes Wine Center where they offer wine tastings.

Lunch was a highlight of the day. We were given a choice of three wraps - veggie, smoked turkey, or chicken Caesar. I chose the smoked turkey and was very happy with it. Instead of the usual tortilla wraps, they used delicate crepes to wrap the meat, lettuce, red onion, and roasted red pepper mayo and it was amazing - what a wonderful idea. The meal started out with a chilled melon and berry soup that was yogurt based and absolutely incredible - I think everyone left wanting more of that soup - I know I did! We finished off lunch with delicious cookies or brownies. So good!

After lunch we gathered for a wine tasting in the Finger Lakes Wine Center. We were treated to six different wines to taste. Four were Sonnenberg's own wines that they only sell on the property - you can't find them anywhere else and they are very good. The other two were from other Finger Lakes Region wineries - a Hot Pepper wine that really surprised me and a watermelon wine that was the perfect ending to the wine tastings. I enjoyed all six wines.

After the wine tasting, some went back to wandered the grounds and explore gardens they missed before lunch and others sat to chat and enjoy being out on such a gorgeous day. The bus left to head home about 3:30 and we were back in Albion by about 4:45. It was such a nice day - a good time was had by all.

I highly recommend visiting Sonnenberg Gardens in Canandaigua - a true local treasure, for sure, and so easy to get to - not far at all!

The vehicle was determined to have been previously reported stolen out of Allentown, Pennsylvania. The operator was eventually located on foot and taken into custody. Alexis Orta-Rolon, 39, was arrested and charged with Criminal Possession of Stolen Property-Motor Vehicle in the 4th degree, Criminal Mischief in the 4th degree, Menacing in the 3rd degree, Obstruction of Governmental Administration in the 2nd degree, Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle in the 3rd degree, and Failure to Obey A Traffic Control Device. Alexis Orta-Rolon was also determined to have an active Arrest Warrant out of the Village of Albion for Criminal Mischief in the 4th degree after a disturbance call in May of 2021. Orta-Rolon was transported to the Orleans County Jail to be arraigned in CAP Court. The following day after Alexis Orta-Rolon's release from the Orleans County Jail, he was arrested and charged with Criminal Contempt in the 2nd degree-Disobeying a Court Mandate after an Albion Police Sergeant observed him actively violating an Order of Protection.

On June 24, 2022 the Albion Police Department arrested Geronimo Hernandez-Garcia, 41, after a traffic stop on West Academy Street. Hernandez-Garcia was charged with Aggravated Driving While Intoxicated, Driving While Intoxicated-First Offense, Failed to Yield Right of Way, Moved From Lane Unsafely, Drinking Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle. Hernandez-Garcia was released on Uniform Traffic Tickets and is scheduled to appear to in the Town of Albion Court at a later date.

The Albion Police Department also made eight warrant arrest/executions, three petit larceny arrests, two sex abuse-related arrests, three traffic-related arrests, and seven miscellaneous felony, misdemeanor and violation-related arrests in the months of May and

Crusty Mac and Cheese

Serves 4-6



- 1 pound elbow macaroni
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/8 teaspoon ground white pepper
- 1/2 cup chicken stock
- 3/4 cup heavy cream
- 1/2 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1/2 tablespoon hot sauce
- 1/2 tablespoon Creole mustard
- 1 1/4 cup Cheese Wiz®
- 8 ounces sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1. Preheat the oven to 350 F. Grease a 2-quart baking dish.
