Headed towards Duluth? There is construction in Cromwell

Information from MNDOT
Traveling from the Brainerd Lakes Area to Duluth, be ready to slow down in Cromwell.

The \$3.1 million project on Hwy. 210 is well underway. Trucks and local traffic, check for detours. Hwy. 73 is detoured.

Motorists passing through the city of Cromwell will encounter one-lane traffic controlled by a temporary

stoplight. Once you get through town, you will drive on a pleasantly new road on Hwy. 210.

Improvements with this project include:

- Twelve-foot driving lanes and 10-foot parking lanes will be maintained on Hwy. 210 from Hwy. 73 to Burnett Road.
- New storm sewer and curb and gutter to collect and

convey stormwater runoff.

- New sidewalk along Hwy. 210 and along the west side of Hwy. 73 adjacent to the Cromwell High School.
- New lighting along Hwy. 210.

Andy Dostal, the construction project supervisor, said: "There have been some challenges with construction, but we have been able to work through them. Once complete, the reconstructed highway will be new above-

and-below ground. The safety improvements and new lighting will be an asset for the community. We appreciate the public's patience as we complete the work."

MnDot says: "Construction on Hwy. 210 and Hwy. 73 in Cromwell is underway with detours. Traffic can travel through Hwy. 210 via a single lane controlled by a signal, but there is no access to Hwy. 73. Please view the local detour and the truck

detour on the project website here: <http://www.dot.state.mn.us/d1/projects/hwy-210cromwell/index.html>. Trucks are strongly encouraged to check routes before traveling through Cromwell."

More MnDOT info: "The public is invited to attend MnDOT and the contractor's weekly update meetings on Thursdays at 11 a.m. at the construction job trailer located at Carlton County's salt shed at 1372 Hwy. 73 in

Cromwell.

Kathleen Saelens turns life around and helps families in crisis

She started out as a teen mother, forced to drop out of high school. She ended with a master's degree and the ability to help countless families in crisis.

Kathleen Saelens of Grand Rapids just retired from the

Salvation Army Rapid Rehousing program. She helped many families find a place to live – including families from Aitkin County.

"I grew up in poverty," Kathleen explained.

She lived 30 miles in the country and had no transpor-

tation to get to the "special school" that pregnant teens were forced to attend when she was young.

Later, she got her diploma and went on to get a master's degree. She worked with counseling those in need, try

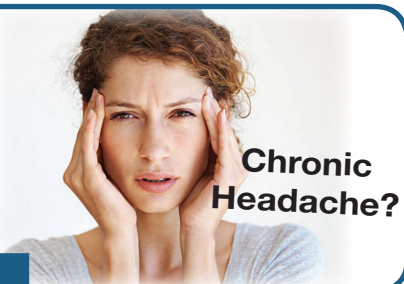

Lakes Area Music Festival's 14th Annual Season Kicks Off July 30-31

The Lakes Area Music Festival opens its 14th annual season on July 30 and 31 with "Tribute to the Earth." Saturday's concert begins at 7:30 p.m. and Sunday's event is at 2 p.m. - both in the new Gichi-zibi Center for the Arts, located in Brainerd. This orchestral concert, led by music director, Christian Reif, includes Jean Sibelius' masterful Second Symphony, and the world premiere of a new work by Peruvian American composer, Jimmy

López-Bellido. López-Bellido's "Pago a la Tierra" (tribute to the earth) is based on an ancient Andean ritual of thanksgiving for nature's bounty, and it serves as a fitting commemoration of the music and culture to come at this year's festival. "The Lakes Area Music Festival has always been committed to masterworks of the past - people like Mozart, Beethoven, and others," said festival artistic director, John Taylor Ward, "And we

now have the opportunity to put a classic like Sibelius alongside a work that point to the future of our artform, performed for the very first time locally." Ways to prepare now for hunting

Hunting season will be here before you know it and it's not too early to prepare:

- Get your hunter's safety certification if you're new
- Buy ammo now to avoid missing out on seasons
- Scout spots; look for paths and potential food sources
- Avoid the wait, buy your license and stamps early. Deer licenses go on sale Monday, Aug. 1.
- Plan your hunt dates

Bear hunters: Remember to buy your license, check regulations

Did you enter the lottery for a bear hunting license? The DNR has mailed postcards to lottery winners. You can also check the DNR website to see if you were selected. The deadline to purchase a bear license is Monday, Aug. 1. Surplus licenses will be available at noon Thursday, Aug. 4. Bear baiting begins Friday, Aug. 12, and the hunting season is Thursday, Sept. 1, through Sunday, Oct. 16.

Apply for the Camp Ripley hunt

Deer hunters can apply for the fall archery deer hunt at Camp Ripley near Little Falls through Friday, Aug. 19. This year, the three-day hunt will happen on Oct. 28-30. A total of 2,500 permits will be made available. The bag limit is two and bonus permits may be used to take antlerless deer.

The archery hunt at Camp

Ripley is an annual event. The DNR coordinates the hunt in collaboration with Central Lakes College Natural Resources Department, and the Minnesota Department of Military Affairs, which manages the 53,000-acre military reservation.

Take a kid deer hunting

Here's a way to introduce youth to deer hunting — special youth deer hunts. These hunts take place in several state parks, and in the Rydell National Wildlife Refuge, on various dates in the fall. Adults must accompany youth during these hunts. Apply for special youth deer hunt permits through Friday, Aug. 19, and keep in mind there is a limited number of permits for each hunt. These special youth deer hunts are different from the statewide youth deer season, which takes place Oct. 20-23 and does not require an application.

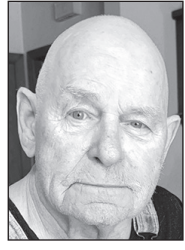

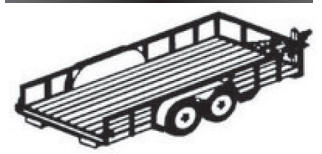

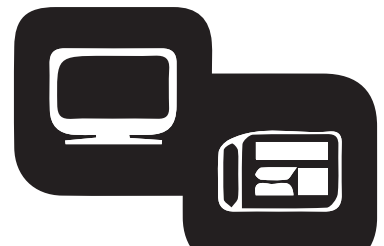
