By ANN SCHWARTZ Twenty-two United States Armed Forces veterans and active duty soldiers take their own lives each and every day. Vicki Tank Randall, a Brainerd High graduate and former Miss Brainerd, was staggered and shocked in April 2020 when her son, Cody Randall, 28, took his own life while on duty with the Army in Alaska.

"He was busy, he had a supervisory job and was stationed far away so we didn't see him often," Vicki shared in an interview. "We had no idea things were as bad as they were."

Alcohol use, dark Alaskan winters and depression combined to make Cody one of the victims of suicide.



She was also an outstanding speech student in high school and knows the technical aspects of giving a talk that moves people. However, it was only recently that she was able to tell Cody's story.




Sadly, the crisis continues for so many families, leaving them in dark despair. Crises happen all hours and the Nest is there for families in their time of distress.


