Wilson Dam **Roads Close**

SHOALS-Wilson Dam Rd and Reservation Rd. leading to Wilson Dam are closed once again. The roadway across the dam will be closed for about two months according to a release from Scott Fiedler, TVA's Media Relations Director. The road should reopen October 15 at

Aderholt Leads First Step of Funding for Much-Needed Project in Sheffield

WASHINGTON—Congressman Robert Aderholt (AL-04) released a statement last week announcing grant in the amount of \$2,000,000 for work toward a longanticipated railroad overpass in downtown Sheffield.

"Trains consistently block the railroad crossing,

for days, provoking major traffic delays. Travelers are re-routed from the crossing to longer routes and first responders are hindered in arriving to emergencies," Aderholt stated. "This overpass relieve the stress of the

Medical Testimony Is Required In An **Injury Case**

In every case we know that an accident happened, and we know how it happened. We know what the medical treatment was, who did it, and where it was done.

The severity of an injury really determines the value of a personal injury case. Obviously, there are other factors that drive the value up or down. Most personal injury lawyers would agree that the victim of a drunk driver is likely to get more money. Often the perception that someone was on their cell phone or otherwise distracted can drive a verdict higher.

Injuries come in all different kinds from a catastrophic injury such as the loss of a limb or paralysis to bumps, cuts, and bruises. The monetary value to a large degree corresponds to the extent of the injury.

There are defenses to liability such as contributory negligence meaning that the person that got hurt was in some way at fault also. If there is a strong defense, the value of the case decreases.

In cases where there is medical treatment, the courts will not allow, by and large, an ordinary person to testify about their injuries unless and until a physician testifies that the injuries were caused by the accident that the lawsuit is about. In other words, you can have the accident report showing how the accident happened on one side and on the other side a stack of medical records showing what the treatment has been. Without a doctor's testimony to bridge the two, the medical treatment doesn't come into court unless a doctor says it was both caused by the accident and necessary for the treatment of the injuries.

Insurance companies are really using this requirement to not pay claims. Unless the medical records are really clear and the injuries are severe, insurance companies often elect not to pay or pay a very small value.

One of the problems that we see is that the court system has for many years allowed doctors the privilege of testifying by deposition and excusing them from having to come to court to testify. That privilege does not extend to physician assistants and nurse practitioners (PAs and CRNPs). We are seeing and will continue to see more treatment by nurse practitioners and physicians assistants. These professionals are certainly entitled to act as expert witnesses and testify to causation and treatment in the vast majority of cases; however, they have to testify live in court.

Medicare Minute Medicare Part B

Before we begin talking about Medicare Part B I would like to clear up something that was in last week's article concerning Medicare Part A. As I stated in the article Part A has a deductible of \$1,556 per benefit period. I also stated that if you paid into Medicare for 40 quarters that Part A was free to you. I was referring to the fact that you would not have to pay a premium to Medicare for Part A, not that it would exclude you from paying the deductible.

Medicare Part B is the part of Medicare that is billed when you receive services as an outpatient by a Medicare approved provider, such as your primary care physician (PCP) or specialist. Although a visit to your doctor is the primary way that you will use Medicare Part B, it also covers many other services. We will discuss the other services in next week's article.

If you are turning 65 in 2022, Medicare Part B will have a premium of \$170.10/mo. Because there is a premium attached to Medicare Part B this coverage is optional. This means you are not required to enroll in Medicare Part B. There are two important things to remember about Part B being optional. First, if you opt out of Part B you will have no coverage under Medicare for your outpatient services. Second, if you decide at a later date to enroll in Part B there can be a late enrollment penalty applied that will last as long as you live and have Part B. There are exceptions to the late enrollment penalty that we will discuss in future articles.





2022 will be the FLWBFL event on September 24-25.





PAY OFF THE MORTGAGES? NOT SO FAST...

Dear Dave,

My husband and I are retired. I receive a small pension, and we are both on Medicare and Social Security. We have about \$25,000 left to pay on our mortgage, along with a second mortgage of \$18,000. These are our only debts. We also have a nest egg of \$30,000 set aside, and a small annuity that's worth about \$20,000. Would you recommend paying off our mortgages with our savings?

Dear Jane, If you know me at all, understand how much I'd love to see everyone in control of their finances and living debtfree. But being broke, even in a house that's paid for, isn't a good idea. Believe me, I understand. The idea paying off the house and everything is awfully tempting. But if you two did that, you'd be left with very little. To me, that's a scary thought when your small pension—along with Social Insecurity and Medicare—are all

have coming in.

No offense, but your nest egg is kind of small to begin with, so I don't think I'd be raiding it right now. On the other hand, if you'd told me you had \$400,000 or \$500,000 saved up, I'd tell you pay off the house and second mortgage today.

If you're not doing this already, I'd advise you two to start making and living on a regular monthly budget. Give every dollar a name on paper before the month begins, because if you don't, your money will control you instead of you controlling it. Make sure you're living on less than what's coming in, and hopefully you can devise a plan to have the house and other debt paid off in a few years.





Ways to Pay for Long-Term Care Without Insurance or Savings

Dear Savvy Senior,

What types of financial resources are available to help seniors pay for long-term care? My 86-year-old mother will need either an assisted living facility or nursing home care in the near future, but she doesn't have long-term care insurance and her savings are minimal.

Searching Daughter

Dear Searching,

The cost of assisted living and nursing home care in the U.S is very expensive. According to the Genworth cost of care survey tool, the national median cost for an assisted living facility today is over \$4,600 per month, while nursing home care runs more than \$8,100 per month for a semi-private room. (See //Genworth.com/aging-and-you/ finances/cost-of-care.html to look up costs in your area.)

Most people pay for long-term care (LTC) - which encompasses assisted living, nursing home and in-home care – with either personal funds, government programs or insurance. But if your mom is lacking in savings and has no LTC insurance to cover her costs, here are your best options to look for funding.

Medicaid (not Medicare): The first thing you need to know is that Medicare (the government health insurance program for seniors 65 and older and those with disabilities) does not cover long-term care. It only provides limited short-term coverage, up to 100 days for skilled nursing or rehabilitation services after a three-day hospital stay.

Medicaid, however, (the joint federal and state program that covers health care for the poor) does cover nursing home and in-home care. But to be eligible for coverage, your mother must be very low-income. Her countable assets can't be more than around \$2,000, including investments. (Note that most people who enter a nursing home don't qualify for Medicaid at first but pay for care out-of-pocket until they deplete their savings enough to qualify.)

There are also many states that now have Medicaid waver programs that can help pay for assisted living. To get more information on Medicaid coverage and eligibility, call your state Medicaid office (see Medicaid. gov). You can also check your mom's Medicaid eligibility at ${\it Medicaid Planning Assistance.org.}$

Veterans benefits: If your mom is a wartime veteran, or a spouse or surviving spouse of a wartime veteran, there is a benefit called Aid and Attendance that can help pay toward her long-term care.

To be eligible, your mom must need assistance with daily living activities like bathing, dressing or going to the bathroom. And her yearly income must be under \$15,816 as a surviving spouse, or \$24,610 for a single veteran after her medical and long-term care expenses. Her assets must also be less than \$138,489 excluding her home and

To learn more, see //VA.gov/geriatrics, or contact your regional VA office, or your local veterans service organization. Call 800-827-1000 for contact information.

Life insurance: If your mom has a life insurance policy find out if it offers an accelerated death benefit that would allow her to get a tax-free advance to help pay for her care.

Or consider selling her policy to a life settlement company. These are companies that buy life insurance policies for cash, continue to pay the premiums and collect the death benefit when she dies. Most sellers generally get four to eight times more than the policy cash surrender value.

If she owns a policy with a face value of \$100,000 or more and is interested in this option, get quotes from several brokers or life settlement providers. To locate some, use the Life Insurance Settlement Association member directory at LISA.org.

To look for these and other programs in your area that can help pay your mom's long-term care, go to PayingForSeniorCare.com and click on "Find Financial Assistance for Care.'

IN THE EARLY DAYS OF SMARTPHONES, you had to possess fairly advanced knowledge to perform your own smartphone backups or restore data to a new phone. After restoration, you had to spend the rest of the day re-

downloading and signing into your apps such as Facebook and Snapchat, reset your various ringtones, and move your app shortcuts to your home

screen. Things are so much more simple now, yet clients still ask me on a daily basis how to move their data from one phone to another.

For Android users, the great

SMARTPHONE BACKUP AND RESTORATION

by "The Computer Skeptic"

news is that it's likely that your phone is already backed up to the cloud. You can easily check that by opening your settings, then scrolling down to a heading that includes "backup." On my Samsung, it's under "backup and restore." On other brands, it may be worded differently. Once you're in that area, look for "Google Drive." Click that and all will be revealed. Google generously offers 15GB of free backup space for your phone. If you've exceeded that amount, you will have to

either delete stuff from your phone or pay for more storage. You can purchase 100GB of storage for \$1.99 per month. You can also give family members 100GB of storage at no extra charge.

Once your stuff is safely backed up, you can rest easy knowing that you can move your stuff to a new phone if it becomes necessary. When you turn on your new Android for the first time, you will be asked to enter to Gmail username and password. The phone will then ask if you

wish to restore your old data. The process may take hours to complete if you have lots of data

iPhone users have a similar feature in iCloud but Apple is much more stingy with its cloud storage. iPhone users only receive 5GB of iCloud storage. If you have more than 5GB of stuff on your phone your stuff is not being backed up and bad things will happen if you drop your phone into the ocean. You can purchase 50GB of additional storage for \$0.99 per month and share that storage with 5 family members. To check the backup status, simply go to Settings, then click "iCloud,"

If you're trading your iPhone for another iPhone, Apple makes it really easy to transfer everything. You simply turn on your new phone, enter your Apple ID and password, and the new phone will ask if you want to transfer your stuff from your old phone through an easy and clever process of QR codes and BlueTooth.

The bottom line is that backing up and restoring your phone is a breeze compared to the old days of manual backups. Your first priority is to make sure your phone is, in fact, backing up, long before you drop it into the ocean so get on that right away.






