

Need Help Paying for Medicare?

The <u>Medicare Savings Programs</u> can help with Medicare costs, like your monthly Part B premiums and sometimes also Part A and B coinsurance and deductibles.

If your gross monthly income is less than \$1,549 for an individual or \$2,080 for a couple, you may be eligible for this program.

The **Extra Help Program** helps pay some of your Medicare Part D drug plan costs.

If your gross monthly income is less than \$1,719 for an individual or \$2,309 for a couple, and your assets are less than \$15,510 for an individual or \$30,950 for a couple, you may be eligible for this program.

These figures are based on the federal poverty limits and are subject to change.

Just because Mr. Powell disagrees with Ms. Berger's idea that Jesus would support socialism doesn't make her idea absurd. A word or two about socialism. Socialism, like any other political/economic system, has many variations but all socialisms share a basic idea. The idea that the mechanisms of global society (not just your own nation) should serve the common good above all else. People over profits. Some socialists believe the best way to accomplish this is public control of the economy- to put the government, representing the people, in charge. Some socialists think the best way is private control in the form of democracy in the workplace such that all the workers control the money and decisions in the business, not a few fat cats at the top. Most socialists believe in some combination of the two.

Many Christians have felt that the application of Jesus' teachings is socialism. They believe in Christian Socialism. Martin Luther King Jr. and Bishop Desmond Tutu are two better-known examples. In fact, Mount Morris' own Francis Bellamy was a Christian Socialist clergyman. Jesus wasn't a socialist of course because socialism as a theory didn't exist yet. But a great deal of what Jesus taught, and how his early followers lived, coincides with socialist thinking. Similar in practice to Christian Socialism is the Social Gospel that was influential at the beginning of the 20th century.

Mr. Powell includes lots of quotes from the Bible in his letters yet I don't see very many quotes from Jesus himself. But the reader doesn't need me or Mr. Powell. Read the Gospels yourself. Read the Sermon on the Mount. Read Jesus' many parables. Read what Jesus said about greed and selfishness. Read the parable of the Good Samaritan and tell me Jesus would be against society (in the form of democratic government) helping others when their friends and families can't. Read the book of Acts to see how Jesus' early followers lived communally and then see if Jesus would be opposed to socialism.

I, Mary LaPoma, Collector of Taxes for the Mount Morris Central School District, have duly received the tax roll and warrant for the collection of taxes. Such taxes may be paid in person during regular business hours or night drop at Five Star Bank (Mount Morris branch), or by mail to Tax Collector, Mount Morris CSD, PO Box 189, Warsaw, NY 14569-0189.

Taxes may be paid on or before September 30, 2022 without penalty. On all taxes received from October 1 through October 31, 2022, there shall be added a 2% penalty. No taxes will be accepted by the District after October 31, 2022. Livingston County will accept payments from November 15 through November 30, 2022 with a 3% penalty. Unpaid school taxes will be relevied with the town and county taxes in January, 2023 with an increased rate of interest.






New Grants & Public Information Coordinator
