Lauderdale County Commission Chairman Danny Pettus said the commission also sent a recent letter to the office governor's in support of the project.

Doug Seagle, a civil ngineer and north engineer Alabama design manager for the professional services firm Volkert Inc., told members of Volkert the Shoals Metropolitan Planning Authority in

June that a feasibility study of the College Street extension been completed. A public meeting was scheduled for August 22 at the Burrell Slater School Gym to discuss the results of the study. It was not a public input meeting.

During a public meeting in December, the consultants presented three options for the bridge:

• Alternative 1 runs from Gunwaleford Road to West College Street, costing \$9,110,175 and

averages 4,028 vehicles.

• Alternative 2 travels from Coffee Road to West College Street, costing \$11,097,659 and averages 2,375 vehicles.

• Alternative 3 runs from Coffee Road to West Irvine Avenue, costing \$15,496,046 and averages 2,250 vehicles.

According to Volkert two-lane officials, a road would be most feasible, but would have a lane for pedestrians and bicyclists.

The posted speed limit would be 35 mph.





There is now a \$7,500 credit for EVs (Electric Vehicles) placed in service before 2033. Now, only EVs assembled in North America qualify for the credits. The credit will be reduced by an additional 50% if the vehicle's battery is not principally sourced from North America. "North America" for this purpose comprises seven countries, including the United States, but NOT including Canada. Batteries will probably come from Mexico!!
- A loss of jobs for Americans.

To get the credit the prices are capped at \$55,000, assuming MSRP, for sedans and capped at \$80,000 for trucks, SUVs and vans.

The current average price of an EV sedan is \$66,000. In addition, the credit is not available to citizens filing jointly

with adiusted gross income (AGI) of \$300,000 or more; Not available to citizens filing as head of household with AGI of \$225,000 or more; Not available to other filers with AGI of \$150,000 or more. Subject to further regulations and guidance, the qualified taxpayer acquiring an may transfer the credit to the selling dealer. The dealership, if it is a corporation, will pay less in taxes!

The law does impose a 15% minimum tax on 'book income' for corporations with profits over \$1 billion effective for tax years 2023 and beyond. Book income is the amount of income corporations publicly report on their financial statements to shareholders. This book income often does not reflect economic reality and can result in a firm appearing profitable while paying little or no income tax

Congress's Joint Committee on Taxation estimates that only 150 corporations would be subject to the proposed tax! Will those 150 cover the cost of the new law?!



What is an Annual Notice of Change?

Dear Savvy Senior,

Last year I received a "notice of change" letter from my Medicare provider. Should I expect another one this year, and what should I do with it?

Medicare Rookie

Dear Rookie.

The letter you're asking about is actually referred to as the Annual Notice of Change (or ANOC), which is a letter you receive from your Medicare Advantage or Medicare Part D prescription drug plan in late September. (People with only a Medigap plan don't receive these because Medigap plans do not have benefit changes from year to year). So yes, you should expect to receive another letter next month.

The ANOC gives a summary of any changes in your plan's costs and coverage that will take effect Jan. 1 of the next year. The ANOC is typically mailed with the plan's "evidence of coverage," which is a more comprehensive list of the plan's costs and benefits for the upcoming year.

You should review these notices to see if your plan will continue to meet your health care needs in 2023. If you are dissatisfied with any upcoming changes, you can make changes to your coverage during fall open enrollment, which runs from Oct. 15 to Dec. 7.

Here are three types of changes to look for: Costs: If you have a Medicare Advantage plan, find out what you can expect to pay for services in 2023. Costs such as deductibles and copayments can change each year. For example, your plan may not have had a deductible in 2022, but it could have one in 2023. A deductible is the amount of money you owe out-of-pocket before your plan begins to cover your care. Another example is that your plan may increase the copayments you owe for visits to your primary care provider or specialists.

Coverage: If you have an Advantage plan with rescription drug coverage check to see if your doctors, hospitals, and other health care providers and pharmacies will still be in network for 2023. You have the lowest outof-pocket costs if you go to providers and pharmacies that are in your plan's network. If you see an out-of-network provider, your plan may not cover any of the cost of your care, leaving you to pay the cost out-of-pocket. You should also contact your providers directly to confirm that they will still be accepting your plan in the coming year.

Drugs: If you have prescription drug coverage, look through the plan's formulary, which is the list of drugs the plan covers. Formulary changes can happen from year to year, so make sure the medications you're taking will be covered next year, and that they're not moved to a higher tier which will affect your copay. If you see any changes that will increase your costs, you may want to select a different drug plan that covers all of your medications. If the formulary is incomplete, or you do not see your drug(s) on the list, contact the plan directly to learn more.

If you have not received an ANOC by the end of September, you should contact your Medicare Advantage Plan or Part D plan to request it. This notice can be very helpful in determining whether you should make any changes to your coverage during the fall open enrollment. Reading your ANOC can also prevent any surprises about your coverage in the new year.

Shopping, comparing and enrolling in a new Medicare Advantage or Part D plan during the open enrollment period can easily be done online at Medicare's Plan Finder Tool at //Medicare.gov/find-a-plan.

Or, if you don't have a computer or Internet access, you can also call Medicare at 800-633-4227 and they can help you out over the phone. Your State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP), which provides free Medicare counseling, is also a great resource to help you make any changes. To find a local SHIP counselor, visit ShipHelp.org or call 877-839-2675.




Dear Dave, How do you know if a will or a trust is best for you? Monica

Dear Monica,

This is a great question, especially since August National Make-a-Will Month. The first thing you should do is take a serious look at your needs, your wishes and your overall life and financial circumstances.



Florence was surveyed for the Cypress Land Company in 1818 by Ferdinand Sannoner and named for the famous capital of Tuscany. The county seat of Lauderdale County, it was first incorporated in 1826. Located at the foot of Muscle Shoals, it became a thriving agricultural and commercial center with light industry and significant religious, educational, and medical institutions. During the Civil War, Florence was occupied by both armies at various times. The Tennessee Valley Authority with Wilson and Wheeler Dams contributed to further economic development. further economic development.

How to Obtain an Electronic **Proof of Insurance Card**

You can keep rummaging through your glove compartment. Or you can choose a better option: a digital insurance card.

Proof of insurance — that small, usually perforated ID card that arrives in the mail along with your insurance declaration — is designed to be slipped into

your car's glove compartment. But it can just as easily slip your mind. If it does, and you're stopped for even the most minor infraction, the consequences could run to hundreds of dollars in fines. In many instances a digital insurance ID card can be substituted for the paper card, but you might want to check with your local Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).



Who Needs to See My **Insurance ID Card?**

There will be times when an insurance ID card is needed - whether in paper or digital form.

DMV: You'll need to provide it every time you renew your license plate.

Police: No matter the reason, if stopped you need to show license, registration — and that little ID card. Without it, you're likely to receive a stiff fine.

Claimants: After an accident, both the other person involved and the officer on the scene will want to see your insurance ID.

Are There Substitutes for the ID Card?

Unfortunately, nothing can take the place of that little ID card — not your declaration page, not even your most recent insurance payment receipt. Just about everywhere in the country, the law requires that you carry proof of insurance in the vehicle you're driving and are able to present it to authorities when asked.

How Can I Get My Insurance ID Card?

The State Farm® Mobile App, which provides an electronic insurance card, was created especially for those who are prone to file away insurance ID cards along with their insurance declaration — or else overlook them both in the mail pile by the front door. first My Casey was LeSieur. I always had boyfriends, because my sisters, who were five years and eight years older than me, had boyfriends. Casey was my first boyfriend before I went to second grade. Douglas McDaniel was my boyfriend in second grade and maybe third grade too. I remember I liked holding my boyfriends' hands and sometimes kissing them. Douglas lived on First Avenue, but Casey didn't live in what was considered our

boyfriend two long blocks of 1st and 3rd Avenues. These blocks were closed in by Oak and Justice Streets. These blocks had the best black homes in Hendersonville (N.C.). There were a few brick houses, but ours was wooden with a tin roof. I knew everybody. Just beyond, white people lived on 4th Avenue. Those houses were a little better some brick, some wooden. We interacted with a few families on 4th Avenue. I remember playing with a family of girls there. We played store. They would open one window in their kitchen, and standing on their porch, we would order real food and pay play money. That's how we got lunch or a snack when playing at their house. 5th Avenue (in that same two block stretch) had nice big, brick houses. We knew the names of families. They these were lawyers, owned the furniture shop downtown, taught at the high school and such like. We knew them, but I didn't play with them. My siblings and I ended up playing ball with or cheering with them as the first black cheerleaders in our high school. This was my side

The year my husband, Kevin, graduated from all-black Memphis Mitchell High school, that school produced several engineers, preachers, chemists, a professional athlete, some politicians, etc. Later graduating from that same school, Kevin's siblings became an IRS manager, a Marine Captain Recruiter, a property manager, and a 20 year professional basketball player who is now coaching at his Alma Mater. Ămazing accomplishments have come from the Walker Homes community.

Recently, Kevin's neighborhood has become more run down, but a lot of the same families are still there, at least the grandparents. Not too long ago, Kevin got a Regional Manager work assignment in Memphis at a plant about two miles from his mom's

All of expressed trepidation and warned Kevin about going okay that he came over through the neighborhood and that I tromped over near the Memphis plant saying that it was rough and dangerous. 





- On Sept. 2, 1987, the trial of Mathias Rust, the 19-year-old pilot who flew his Cessna plane into Red Square in May 1987, begins in Moscow. Rust had become an international celebrity after he flew completely undetected

through Soviet airspace. Rust claimed that he was merely trying to promote world peace.

- On Sept. 3, 1783, the American Revolution comes to an end when representatives of the United States, Great Britain, Spain and France sign the Treaty of Paris. The signing signified America's status as a free nation, as Britain formally recognized the independence of its 13 former American colonies.
- On Sept. 4, 1957, Ford Motor Company unveils

the Edsel. One reporter called it "an Oldsmobile sucking a lemon." In addition, at highway speeds, the famous hood ornament had a tendency to fly off and into the





Medicare Minute Medicare Part B

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$233 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$233 filed on Part B each year and, after the deductible is met, you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you receive.
