Kiwanis Supports Local Projects

The Milford Kiwanis group was pleased to present a check to Aubry Knudtson and Zach Steffes, youth representatives from St. Joseph's Church in Milford and St. Mary's Church in Spirit Lake to support the Lakes Food Project. Representatives from the project, Teresa Goehring, Asher Knudtson, Zach Steffes, Jenny Dykema, Catherine Straus, and Lily Miller, shown below, presented the idea to the Milford Kiwanis.

The Lakes Food Project assembled and packed nearly 170,000 meals to send to Poland. Because of the war in Ukraine, 4.9 million Ukrainian refugees have sought safety in Poland, strapping the food supply for millions of people. What started as an idea of some local youth of sending 30,000 meals has more than quadrupled to 168,000 meals. All the costs have been raised, including the shipping, trucking, and administrative fees. A community effort was conducted on August 10th and included 3 shifts of 175 people in each shift. This effort will not only feed the people of Poland and Ukraine, but it brought together the Lakes Area community, schools, and churches and developed good leadership in our youth. Milford Kiwanis is proud to be a financial contributor to this much-needed effort and is happy to report that several local Kiwanians were able to attend the line and help assemble meals for this great cause!




Celebrate and Learn Hispanic and Native American Cultures at the Fair








The YIP initiative was created in 2010 to empower and challenge area youth to identify community needs and build a sense of social responsibility while teaching the next generation the importance of community giving.





Hawkeye Football Preview

It's hard to believe that the college football season is less than two weeks away; while I hate to see summer ending, it is always exciting to have football just around the corner, and it should be another fun year for college football fans in the State of Iowa. This week I will take my attempt to predict the season for the Iowa Hawkeyes, with my Iowa State Cyclones column coming in our August 30th edition. I am not always correct with my picks, but I was pretty dang close with Iowa last year as I predicted the Hawks would finish 10-3 and play in the Citrus Bowl; they ended up with a great 10-4 season, that included a 10-2 regular season before they fell to Michigan in the B1G Championship game and then had a close loss to Kentucky in the Citrus Bowl.

The Hawks enter the 2022 stretch with high hopes of another successful season. Much of Iowa's fortunes will depend on how junior QB Spencer Petras develops. Petras had a very pedestrian 2021 season, where he showed an incredibly strong arm but also battled inconsistency, throwing for 10 touchdowns with nine interceptions while completing just 57% of his passes. Petras will have some quality receivers to throw to this season with Keagan Johnson, Arland Bruce and Nico Ragaini all returning. As usual, the Hawks have a great tight end in senior Sam LaPorta, who led Iowa in receptions last year with 53. Iowa has some question marks at running back with Tyler Goodson departing a year early after rushing for 1,254 yards, but Gavin Williams showed some nice glimpse in spot-duty last season, as did Leshon Williams. Iowa's line will definitely miss All-American center Tyler Linderbaum, who was another Hawkeye First Round NFL Draft pick, but the rest of the line should be improved from last season with three returning starters.

Iowa's defense was dominant in 2021, holding opponents to just 19.3 points per game while having an impressive +12 turnover margin. The strength of Iowa's defense will be their defensive backfield, which picked off a staggering 25 passes last season. This group is led by All-B1G selection cornerback Riley Moss and strong safety Kaevon Merriweather. Iowa's linebackers are also some of the best in the nation with Jack Campbell, Seth Benson and Jestin Jacobs all back after impressive 2021 seasons. Joe Evans returns to anchor the defensive line, and had a great 2021 season with seven sacks, but Iowa will need some youngsters to step-up as they lost some key starters in this unit. Iowa's special teams are led by All-American punter Tory Taylor. Taylor was arguably the best punter in college football last season as he constantly flipped the field for the Hawks, punting 80 times for an amazing 46.1-yard average. It's not often that a 10-win team punts 80 times, but Iowa used Taylor as a weapon last year and it worked to perfection. The Hawks will have to replace All-B1G kicker Caleb Shudak, who was very accurate with a strong leg, making 24-28 field goals last year, and All-B1G returner Charlie Jones, who transferred to Purdue.

Iowa's schedule in 2022 is not an easy one, especially in B1G play as the Hawks will have to play B1G East powers Michigan and Ohio State this season. The key to Iowa's success will rely heavily on whether Spencer Petras has improved since last year, and can he lead the offense to more then 23.4 points per game? The Hawkeyes defense and special teams will once again do their part, but Iowa can't depend on having the kind of game-changing performances that bailed out their offense game after game last year. If Iowa can be even average on offense, they should be in for another very good season. While I think Petras and the offense will be better then 2021, I don't think the Hawks will be as good at turning teams over or as dominant in the special teams area. I look for Iowa to finish the year with a 9-4 record that includes a victory in the Las Vegas Bowl.


