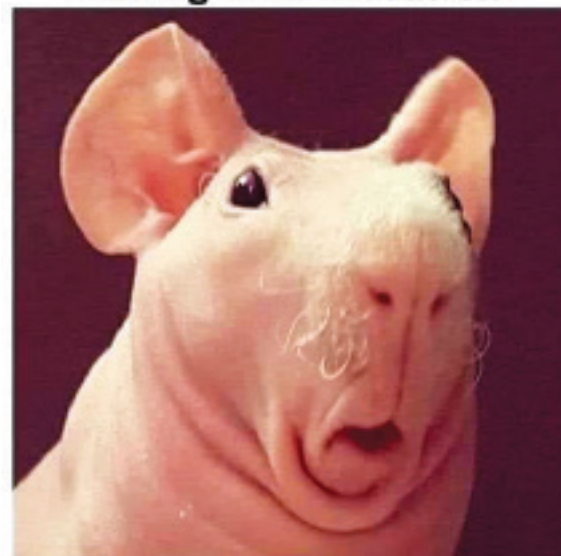

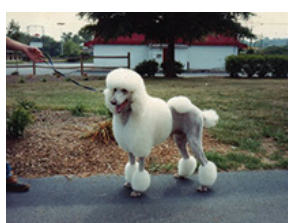

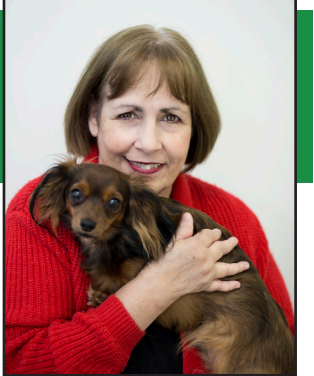

In the early morning hours last year, a man traveling through Danville on his way home to a city in North Carolina saw a beautiful husky on the side of the road. No houses were in sight and the man put the dog in his car, thinking he would make a good companion for his other dog.

Over an hour later, he arrived home and found that his dog did not get along with the stray he had picked up. He got back in his car and drove the dog back to Danville. He called the after-hours emergency number and asked an employee to meet him at the shelter. One did and the dog was put inside the shelter.

Only a few hours passed before a frantic owner called to report his missing husky. We were happy to tell him we had received a dog matching that description. Can you imagine what would have happened if the man who found the dog had kept him? The dog would never have been reunited with his rightful owner.

This past weekend, a man let his elderly dog out to use the bathroom. She wandered a few feet out of his yard and someone in a black SUV stopped and picked her up. Only through thousands of people seeing the post about her (an anonymous donor was going to donate \$1,000 to us to pay for her return) was she brought back. No reward was given; the black SUV was seen returning. The dog was thrown out into the yard.

If you have picked up a stray animal and have chosen not to take it to the public animal shelter in the locality it was found, there are legal requirements to consider.

Virginia Code 3.2-6551 requires any individual who finds a companion

animal and retains it to contact the public animal shelter that serves the locality where the companion animal was found. Specific information is required, including the location where the companion animal was found, a description, and contact information. The same requirements are in effect for rescue groups and other releasing agencies. Violation of this may result in a civil penalty.

It is also important to remember that the law never gives clear ownership rights to an individual who has found an animal and decides to keep it.

In 2021, homebased rescues received 6,947 strays and returned 280 to the owners (4%). Private shelters received 3,877 strays and returned 583 to the owners (15%). Public shelters received 57,919 strays and returned 21,055 to the owners (36%).

In this day of social media and taking strays out of localities, public animal shelters remain the best hope of reuniting a lost pet with the owners.

Toleware

Toleware was popular in New England and nearby areas in the 1700s. Collectors today identify the existing pieces by similarities in the shapes and painted decorations on newly discovered pieces.

Two paint colors were used as the base coat to protect the tin from rust; black or red was used in Pennsylvania, but only black was favored in parts of New England.

Pennsylvania makers usually made a straight spout and a handle with an extra piece to reinforce the curve in the handle. New England makers favored a simple curved handle. The body was a lighthouse shape, and tinsmiths made a gooseneck spout. Yellow, green, red and white flowers and leaves were stenciled on as decorations. The tinware lost favor when copper and silver plate became more available because tin often rusted. But some of the small utensils, such as cookie cutters and funnels, remained in use.

Q: I have many fond memories of a toy clock I played with in the 1960s and was surprised recently to find that old toy in a bin from my parent's garage. It was made by Fisher-Price Toys and is called the Tick Tock Clock. How much is it worth?

A: The bright red Fisher-Price Wind-Up Teaching Clock you are talking about was made from 1964 to 1968. It was made to look like the front of a schoolhouse, complete with a teacher welcoming children in the front door and a school bell at the top of the toy, near the bright yellow handle. When you wound it up, it played the Grandfathers Clock Song. The clock face had big numbers, images of the sun and moon, and the clock hands moved around as the song played. It taught motor skills and how to tell time. In good condition, the clock sells for around \$60.
