

Fairgoers to the 2022 Clay County Fair for a fork! powered by SMU will have 28 new foods

to enjoy during their visit September 10-18, including five that have been named as finalists for the sixth edition of the "The World's Greatest County Fair Food" Contest. "In our visitor surveys,

fairgoers tell us one of the top reasons they attend the

Fair is for the food," said Fair Manager Jeremy Parsons. "This list of unique new foods will only add to our reputation as a nine-day foodie festival."

"The World's Greatest County Fair Food" Contest will be judged by a panel of local celebrity judges on Saturday, Sept. 10 at 2:30pm on the Northwest Bank Stage with one vendor taking home the coveted title of "The World's Greatest County Fair Food."

The finalists (and vendors) are as follows:

·Roasted corn (Ormic Concessions) – Prepared in the traditional style of south Texas, the corn is roasted in the husk. After roasting, the husk is peeled back and choices are added: butter, mayonnaise, red chili sauce or powder and grated Mexican Cotija cheese. Most prefer the "con todo" option - "with everything!"

· Lasagna Griller (Girl'd Cheese) -Italian sausage, a yummy ricotta mixture, gooey mozzarella and marinara sauce all grilled into a crisp sandwich. No need

· Berkshire Bacon Ball on a Stick (Side Door Concessions) A bacon meatball made with Berkwood Farms bacon and stuffed with a homemade bacon cheese, wrapped with two pieces of bacon, smoked, dipped in bbq sauce, and on a stick. Deep Fried Deviled Eggs (Iowa Egg Council)

- A Midwest classic with a crispy twist! Panko breaded egg whites with a pickled yolk sauce that would make grandma proud. Served six pieces per order and enough sauce to cover 'em all.

Brisket Nachos (Gobblestop Turkey Shop)-Nachos with cheese covered with slow cooked smoked brisket and topped with some more nacho cheese, BBQ sauce and jalapenos if you'd like.

In addition to "The World's Greatest County Fair Food," there will again be the "People's Choice" Award. Fairgoers can sample the five finalists and cast their vote at any of the Fair's information booths from Saturday, September 10 through Wednesday, September 14. The winner will be announced on Thursday, September 15 during the Fair.








Author Linda McCann is coming to the Milford Memorial Library on Wednesday, September 14, at 6:30pm.



View From The Bench by John Adams, Jr.

Big Game Preview-2022

It's Cy-Hawk week, one of the best weeks in the State of Iowa for college football fans as we talk smack to each other about who's going to get the football bragging rights for this season. As my Hawkeye friends (yes, I have a few) like to remind me, Iowa owns a six-game winning streak over Iowa State and Cyclone head coach Matt Campbell has never beaten the Hawks. Aside from the 42-3 drubbing Iowa put on ISU in 2016, the other five games have all been very competitive and largely decided by Iowa State turning the ball over 11 times during that stretch while Iowa has had an incredible zero turnovers vs ISU since 2015. This game is always hard to predict for me in my column because due to early deadline with the Labor Day Holiday, I will not have seen either team play yet, and I also tend to pick with my heart, which as you have just read, has not worked out well recently!

This year's game features what should be two very good defensive units with offenses who have a lot of question marks. Iowa's defense, which features pre-season All-Americans Jack Campbell and Riley Moss will try to disrupt and confuse firstyear starting quarterback Hunter Dekkers. I feel like ISU has the edge on the line with more experience on their offensive line then Iowa has on their defensive line, but the Hawks are loaded at linebacker and in the defensive backfield. Dekkers has a solid receiving group, led by Xavier Hutchinson and Jaylin Noel and will get a boost from Colorado transfer Dimitri Stanley, who has had a great fall camp. To me, this matchup of ISU's offense vs. Iowa's defense is pretty much a toss-up, but I give a slight edge to the Hawkeye defense with two pre-season All-Americans and a bunch of experience.

Iowa's offense, as I wrote about two weeks ago, was very pedestrian in 2021. Quarterback Spencer Petras will have to be better in 2022, but that won't be easy against an ISU defense that is led by pre-season All-American Will McDonald. Iowa's receiving group has been hurt by transfers and injuries, and heading into their season opener vs South Dakota State, they were down to just four scholarship receivers. Petras will lean heavily on pre-season All-American tight end Sam LaPorta but will need help from his inexperienced running backs and fairly young offensive line. ISU has solid linebackers, led by threeyear starter O'Rien Vance, and their defensive backfield should be very solid with returnees Anthony Johnson and Beau Freyler leading the way. To me, this is also close to a tossup, but will give the edge to the ISU defense as I just don't feel like Petras is capable of taking over a game.

Special teams has been an area where Iowa has dominated this series, especially last year when pre-season All-American punter Tory Taylor constantly pinned the Cyclones deep in their own territory with his booming punts. Both teams will be breaking in new place kickers, while ISU will also have a new punter. I give the big edge to Iowa in this category, as Taylor is a game-changer with his big leg.

As you can tell, this game, at least on paper, is pretty evenly matched. Until Matt Campbell can prove that he can beat Kirk Ferentz and the Cyclones can force at least one Iowa turnover, it's hard for me to pick my Cyclones. I believe we will have another close game, but look for Iowa to win the turnover and field position battle on their way to a 21-17 victory.





The spray paint will come off of your lawn after just a couple of cuts. The paint on the driveway is semi-permanent and will not come off of your driveway, for what we anticipate, at least a couple of years, unless you want to power wash it off.

Here are four tips to make the 2022 harvest run smooth and

about 30 percent moisture and will dry down depending on the temperature. General weather average field dry down: • September - 4 to 5 points per

week

• October - 2 points per week

• November – 1 point per week This year, much of the corn will mature in early September allowing for fast moisture loss by early October.

2. Check the bin floor – The bin

floor should be clean and at least 8 inches of space between the floor and the fines under it. When it is filled with fines, the airflow is reduced and often more uneven. Check for insects in the fines, especially Indian meal moths that will plug the floor with webbing from their cocoons. If the space is too tight or the insects are present, clean them out. This might mean pulling the floor, which is a big job.

3. General maintenance – Use a good silicone caulk to seal the bin to the foundation and any small leaks, so that the air goes through the grain. Check the electrical system to make sure everything works from fans to spreaders. Start the burner on the heaters to be sure they will start. If fans have belts, make sure they are tight and in good shape. Also, check to make sure the stalks are strong and plan the harvest to get as much into the bins and reduce field loss.

4. Cool the grain – Early harvests don't lend themselves to cooling the grain as night temps might remain high. As soon as the night temps are below 40 degrees, the fans need to run to get all of the grain below 40 degrees to keep through the winter. It only takes 1/10 of a cfm to cool a bushel of grain in 24 hours. A 1hp fan can cool 2,000 bushels a day. A 10hp fan can cool 20,000 bushels a day.

This year looks like an early harvest start, so get prepared and please keep safety in mind.
